Tdap/MCV4 Clinic Summary

The City of Laredo Public Health Department partnered with the Health Services Department to visit all middle schools and offer the Tdap & MCV4 vaccines which are required for incoming 7th graders.

- Students were allowed to receive their vaccines without a parent or guardian present if consent was given by parent.
- Students pending vaccines will be provided a referral to take home and parents will receive a phone call from the school nurse to explain requirements for next school year.

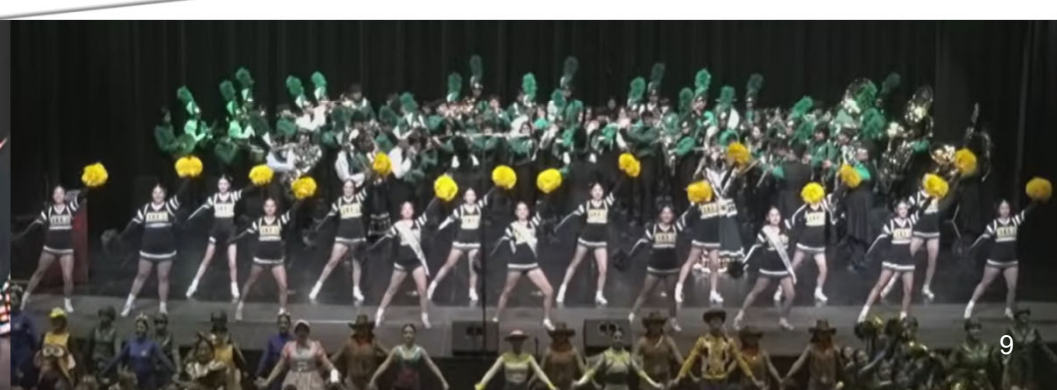
