**LIST II: CLASS OF 2022**

There were 35 students on List II on 6/3/2022 (650 students in the class). Of those 650, 4 have yet to graduate.

**LIST III: CLASS OF 2022**

There were 5 students on List III on 6/3/2022 (650 students in the class). Of those 650, 3 have yet to graduate.

**TRANSITION: CLASS OF 2022**

There were 13 students entering into transition programs on 6/3/2022 (650 students in the class). Of those 13, 13 have yet to graduate.
