# iReady Winter 2026 Overview



- Allows for comparison and trends analysis from the Fall 2025 data points to this mid-year check point, as well as Winter to Winter comparison to last year.
- Benefits and complexities of any assessment should always be considered when engaging in data review:
  - Each test is one data point, a current snapshot
  - Progress toward standards, outside of the curriculum based measures
  - Norm referenced, comparing student performance to national norms

# Overall Quadrant School Performance: MATH



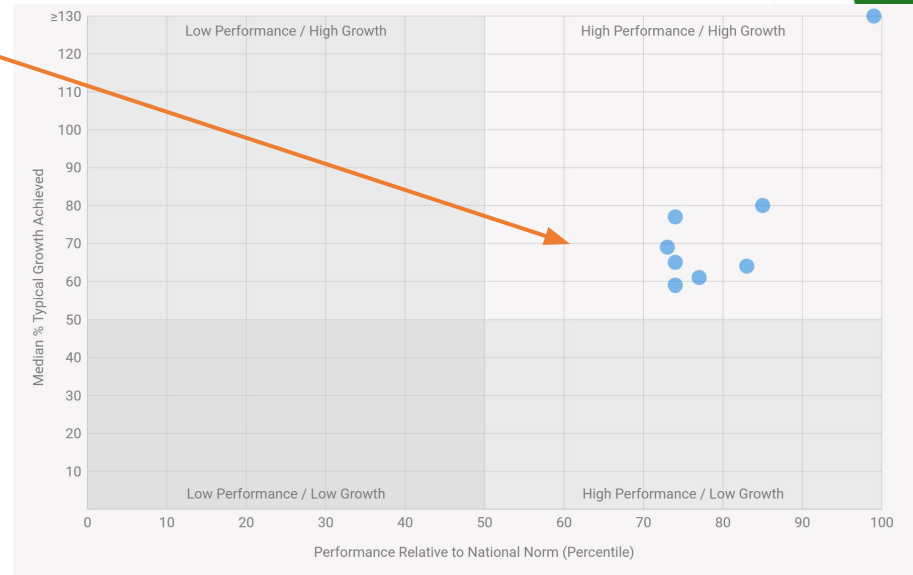
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Median progress to Typical Growth is 50%+ in winter or 100%+ in spring, with performance above the national median.

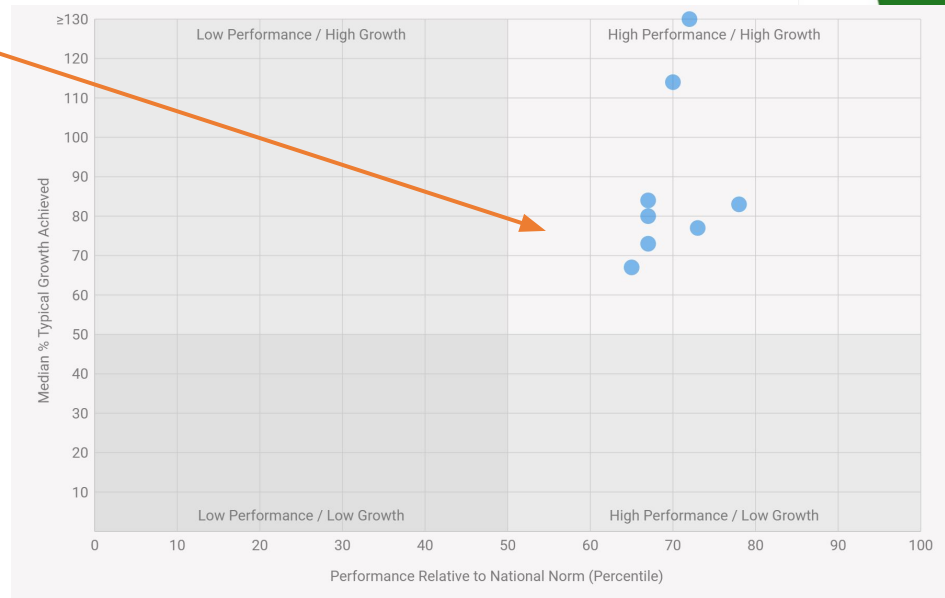
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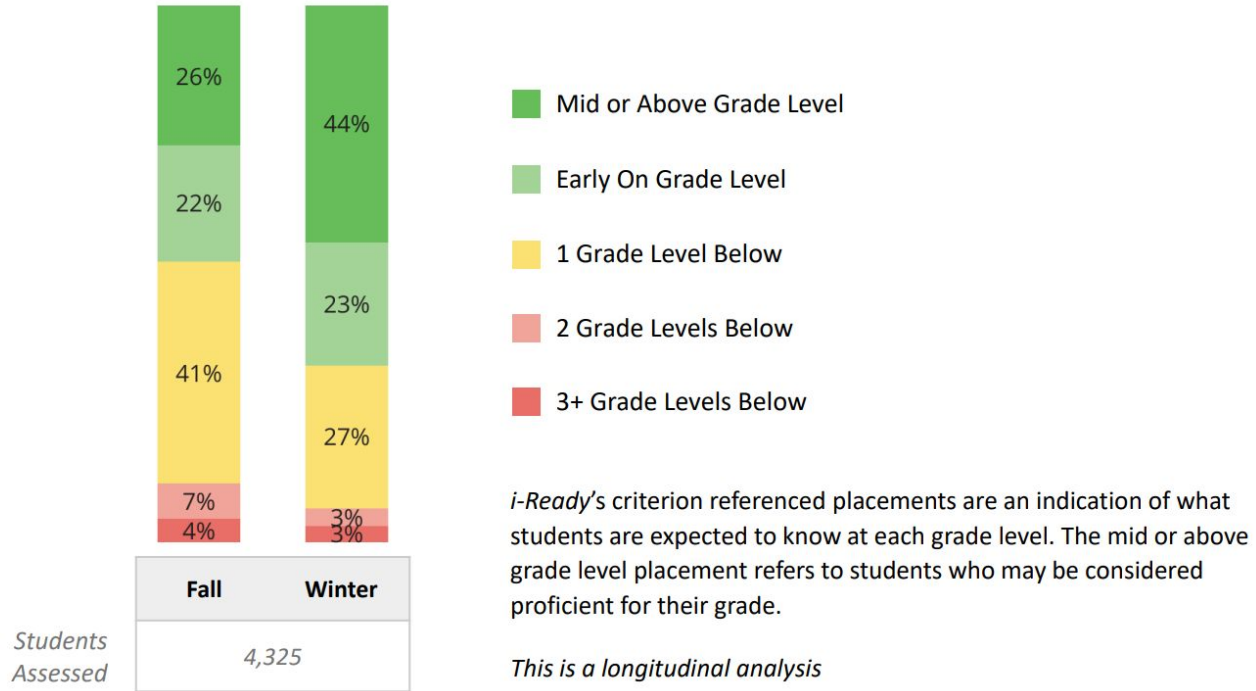

Placement Distribution, Fall 25-26 to Winter 25-26





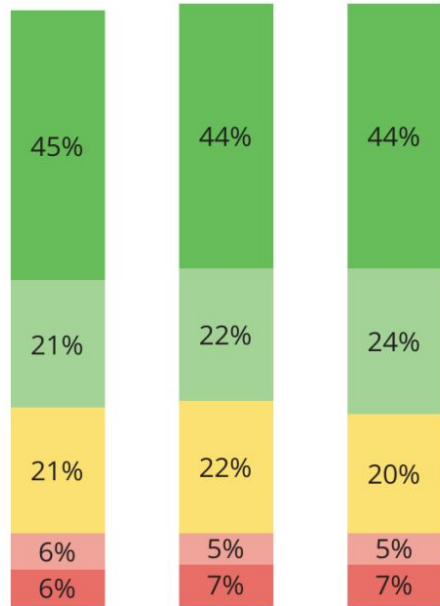

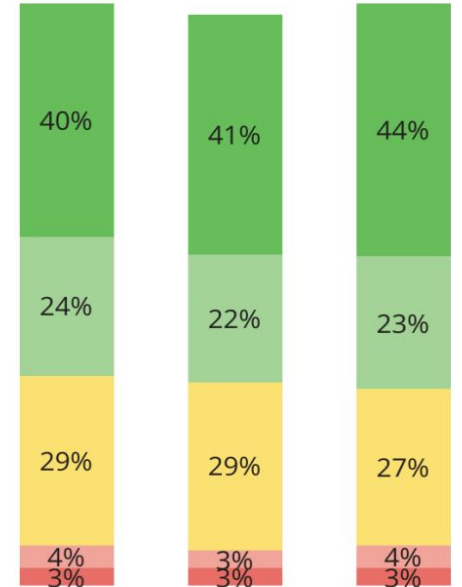

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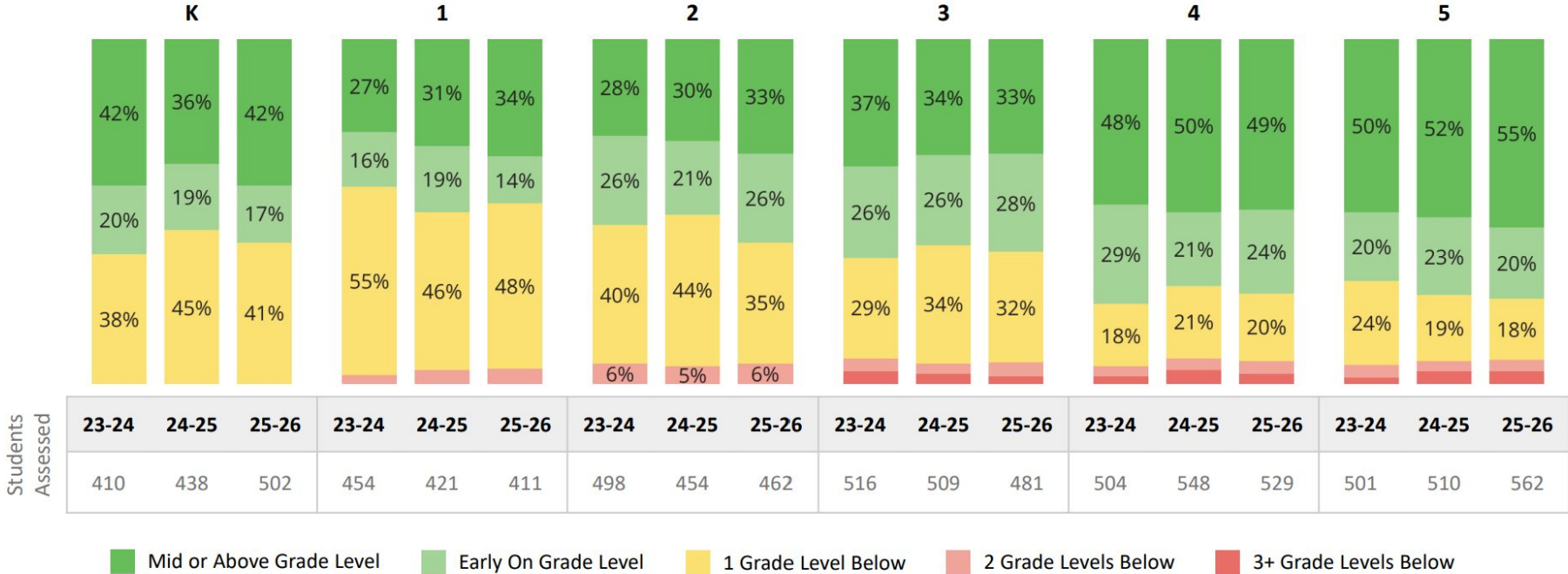

The **National YTD** population includes 10,170,345 students who completed a Diagnostic from November 16 to January 30. This data may not be representative of the student population.

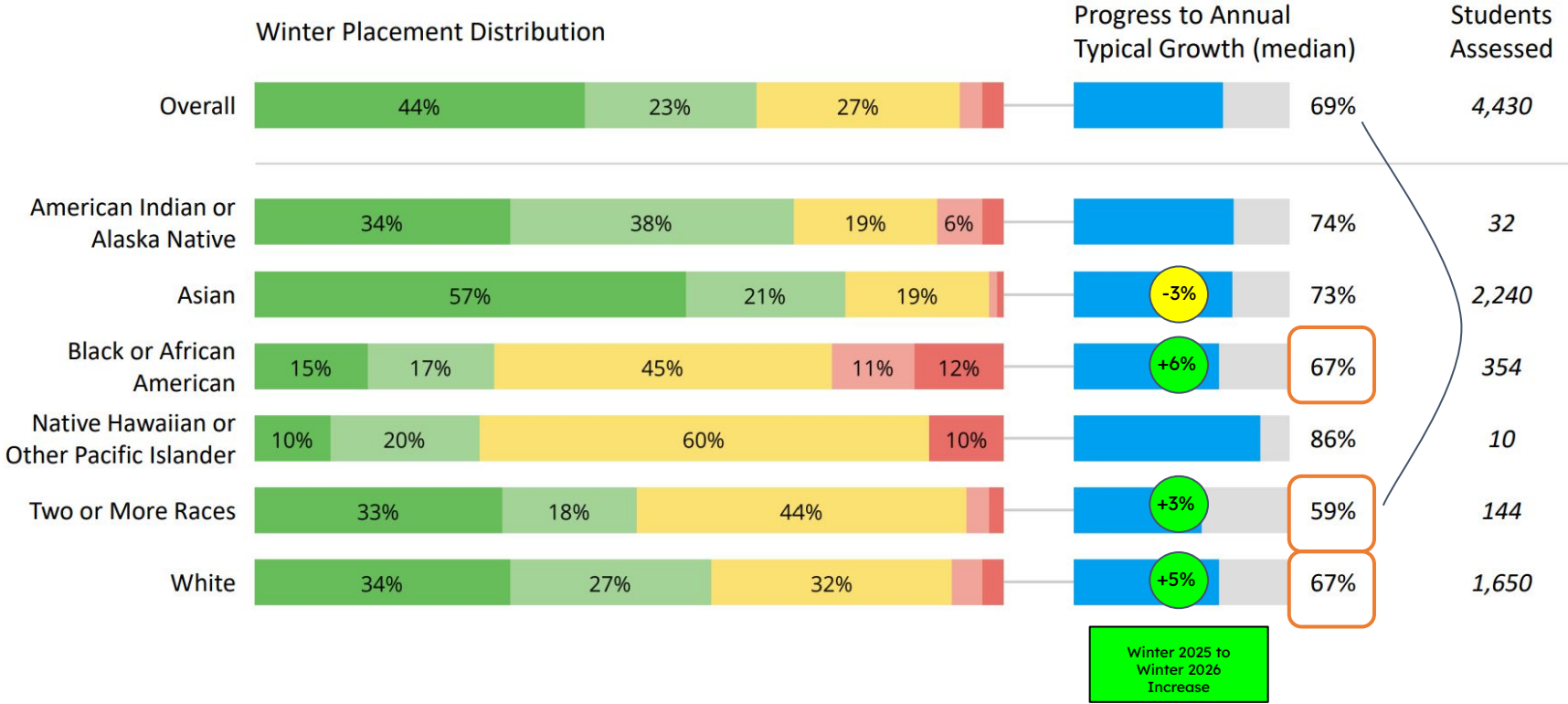

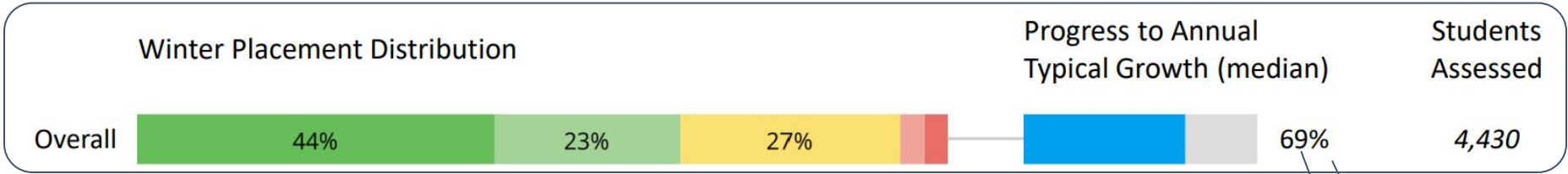

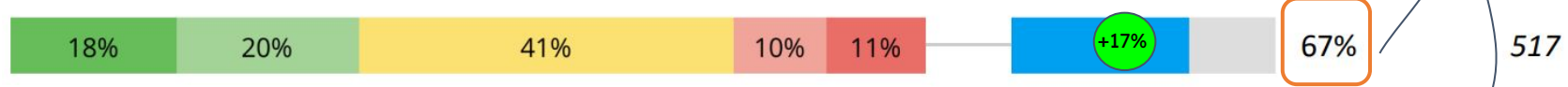
## Relative Placements and Growth by Hispanic or Latino

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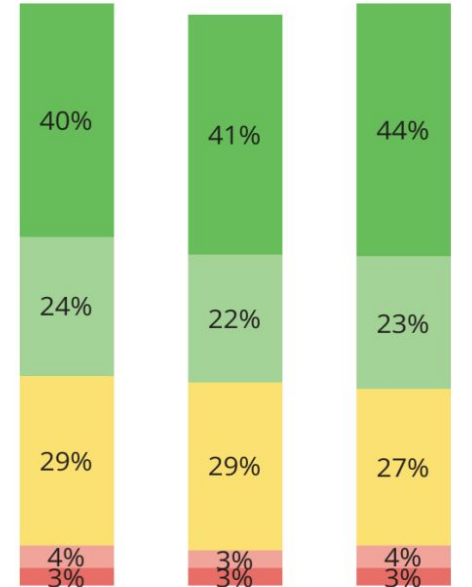
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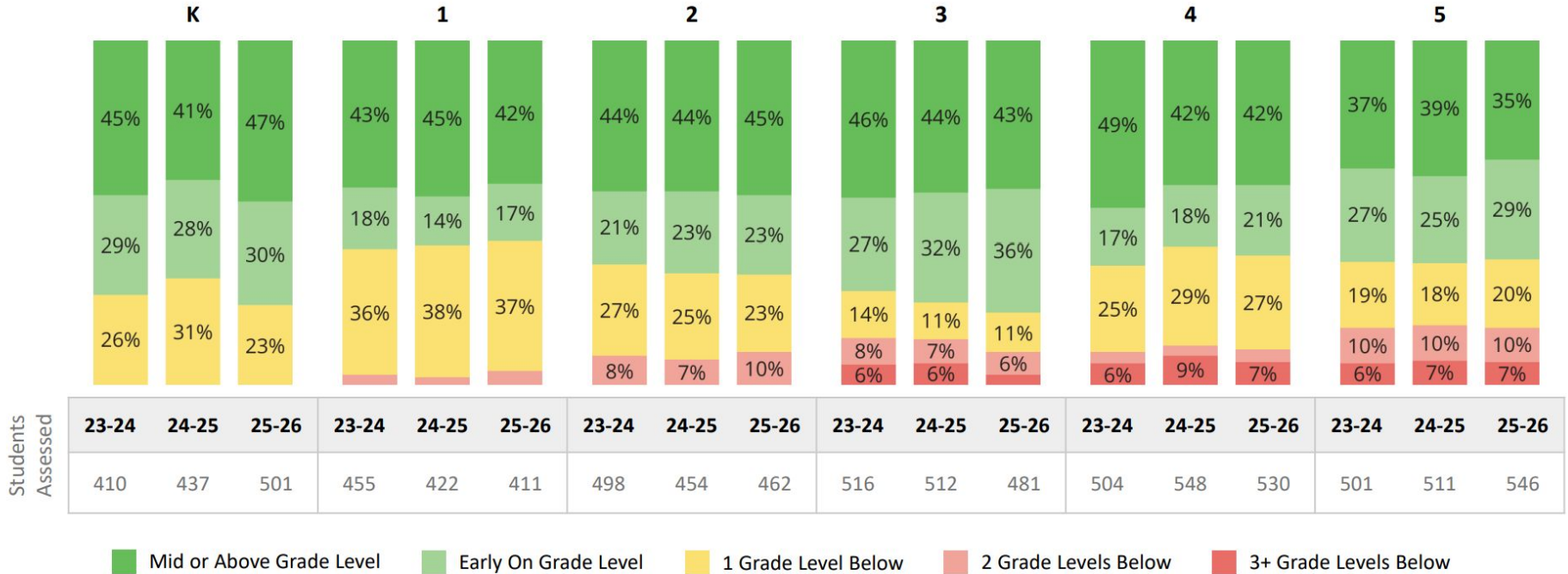
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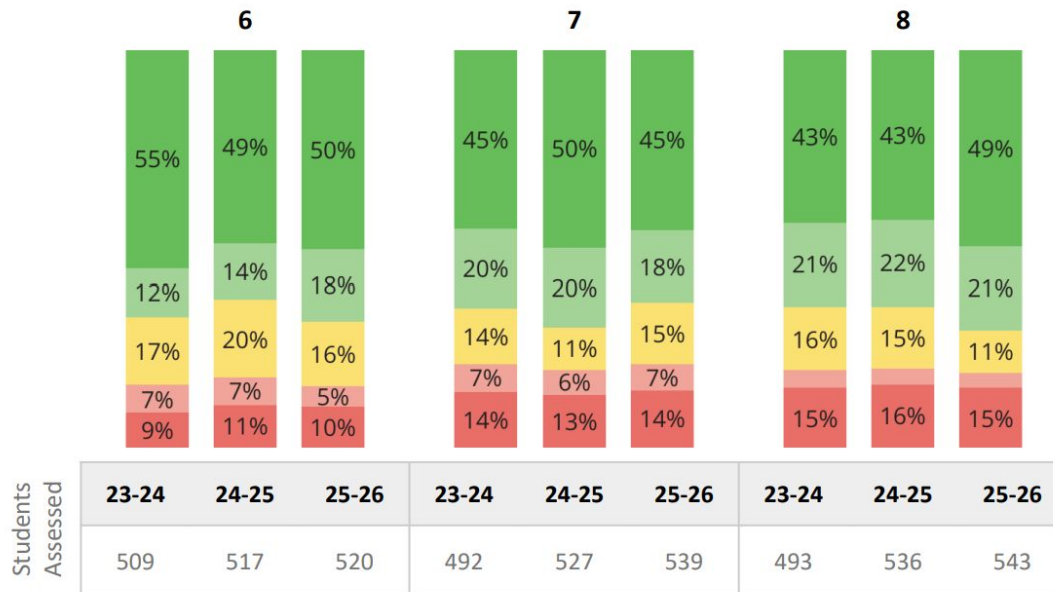


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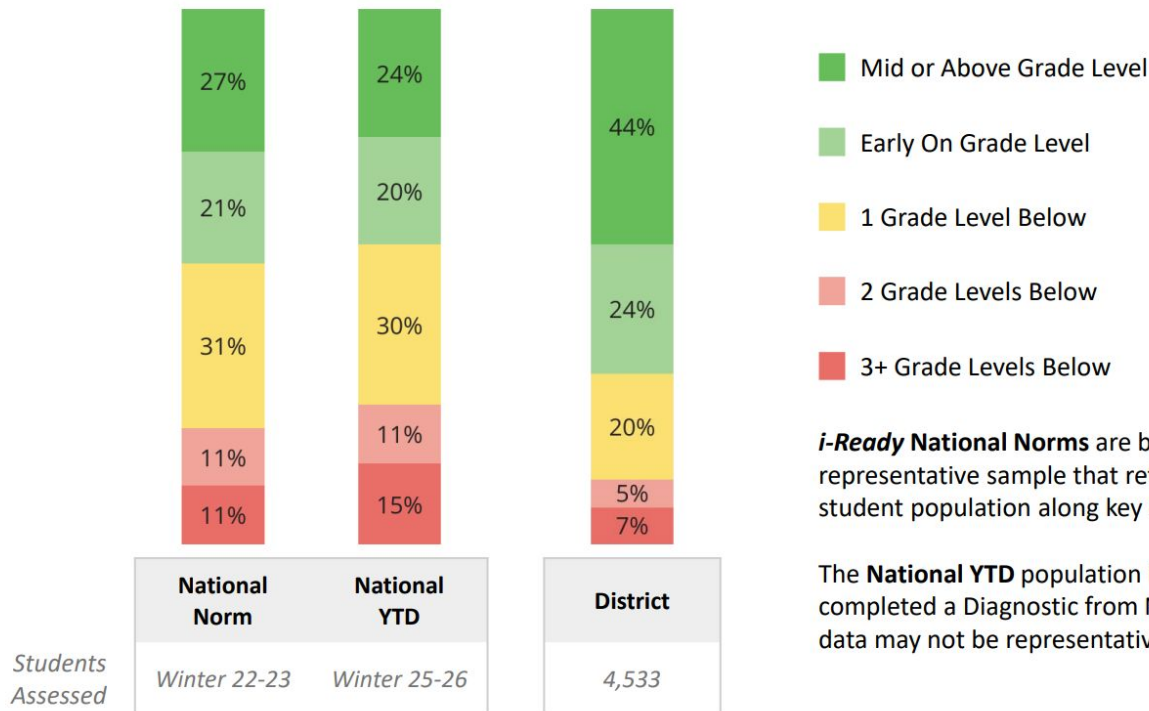
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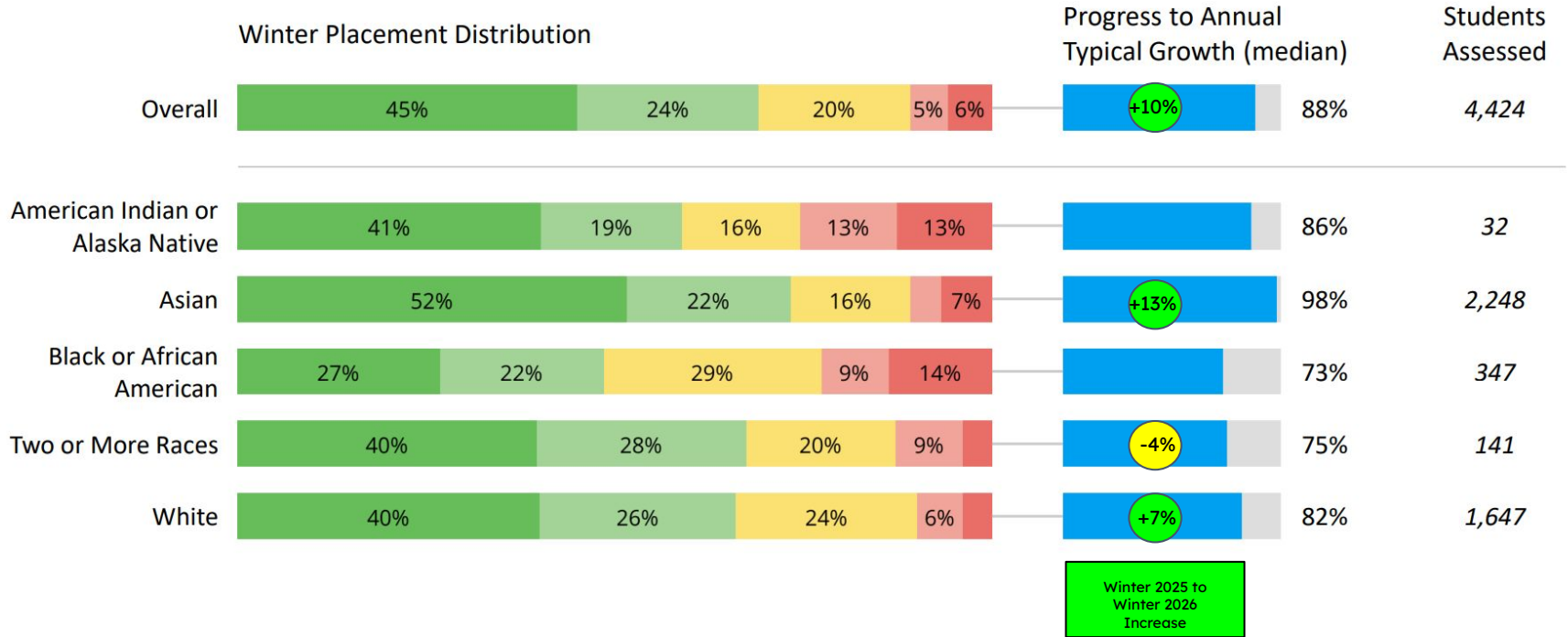


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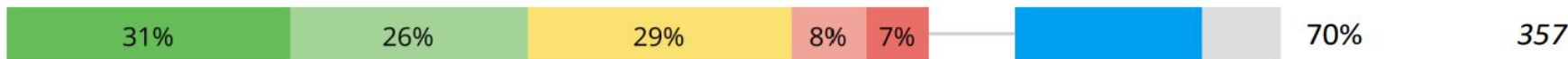
Winter Placement Distribution

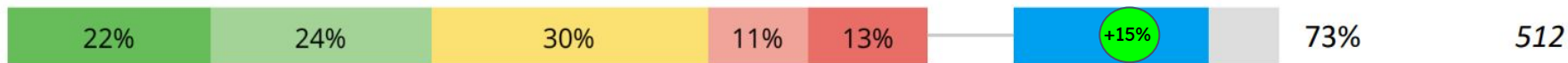
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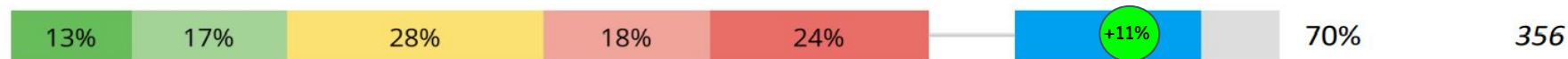
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## Relative Placements and Growth by Economically Disadvantaged

# Layers of a “Data Dig”

Coordinated systems of data analysis and discussion support for our instructional decisions.

Tier 1, all student data, is analyzed at the classroom, grade level, building and district level.

Intervention groupings and plans target students who benefit from Tier 2 and Tier 3 supports.

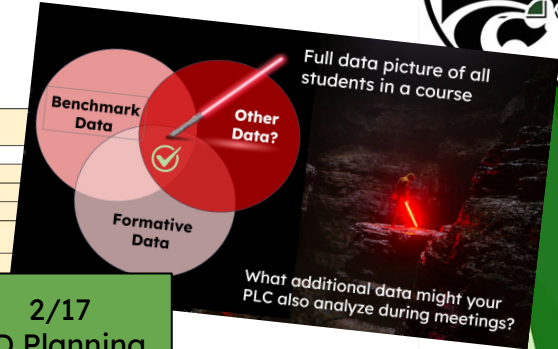
# Digging a Little Deeper

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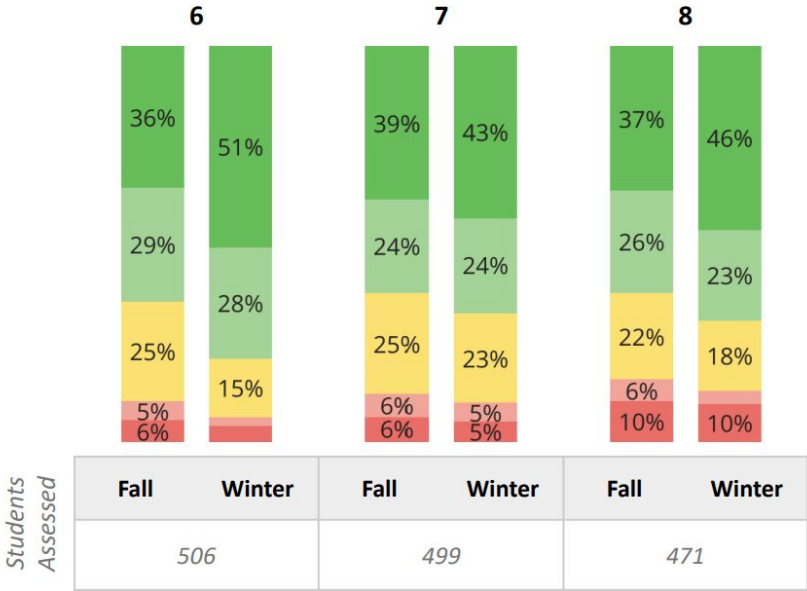


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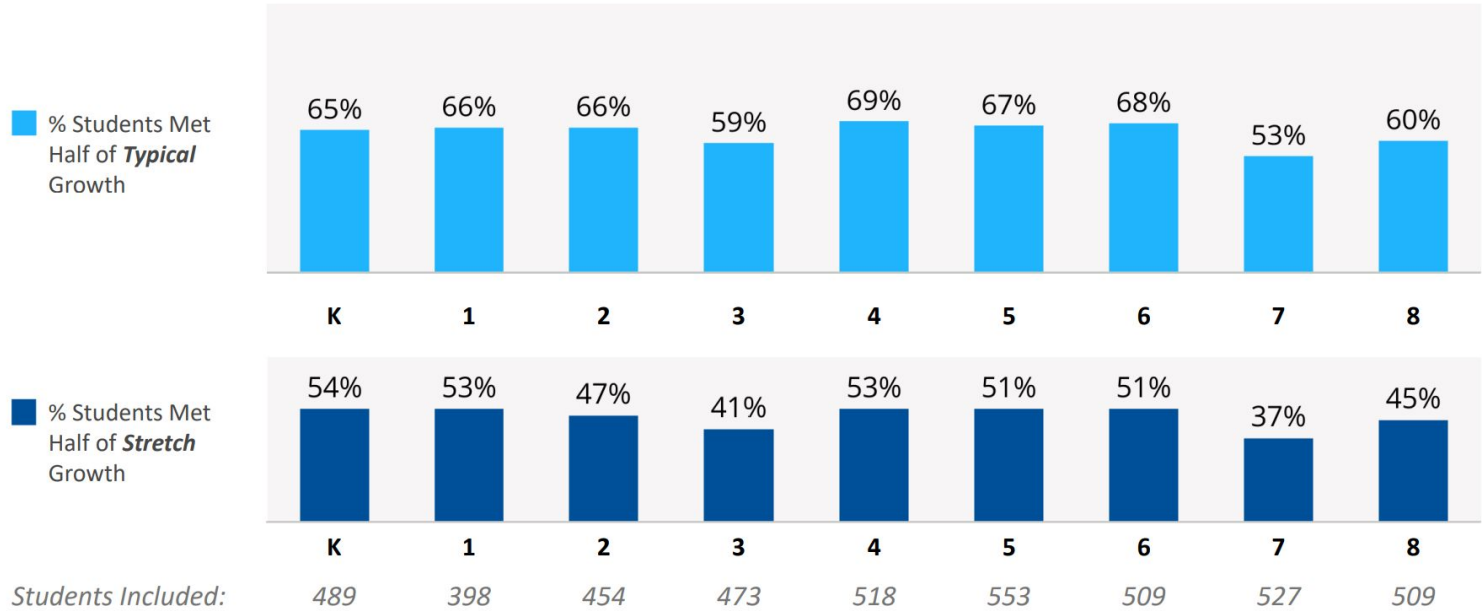
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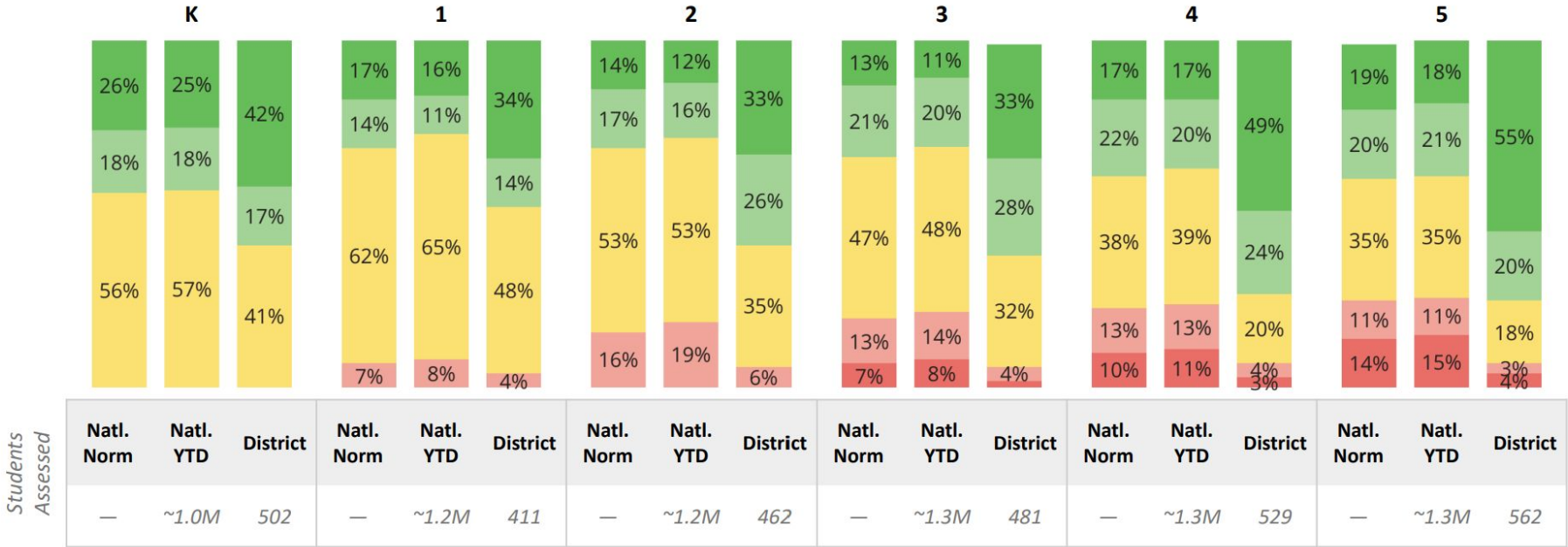
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% Students Who Met Half of Typical and Stretch Growth



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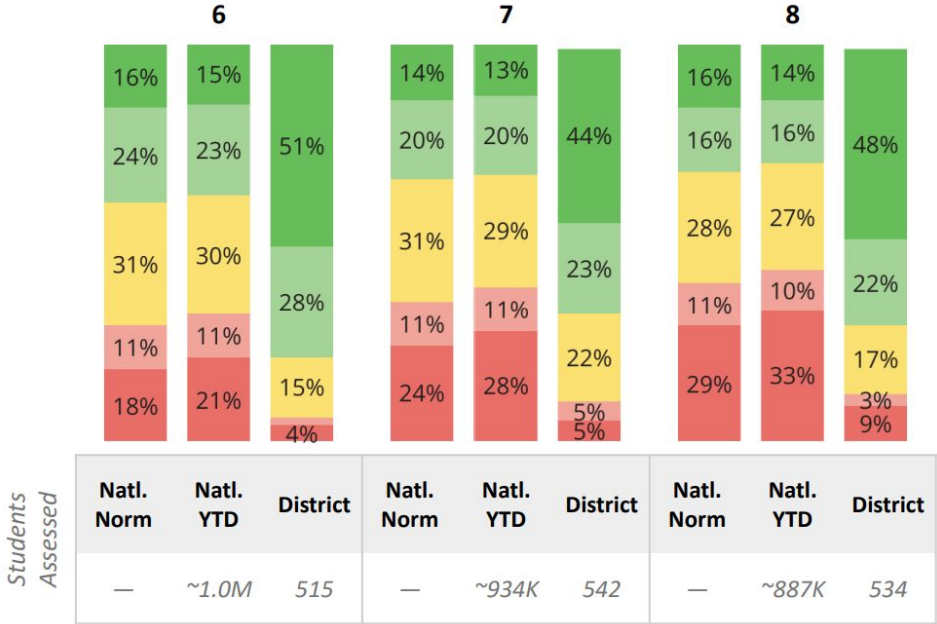

**Natl. YTD:** National Year-to-Date Winter 25-26

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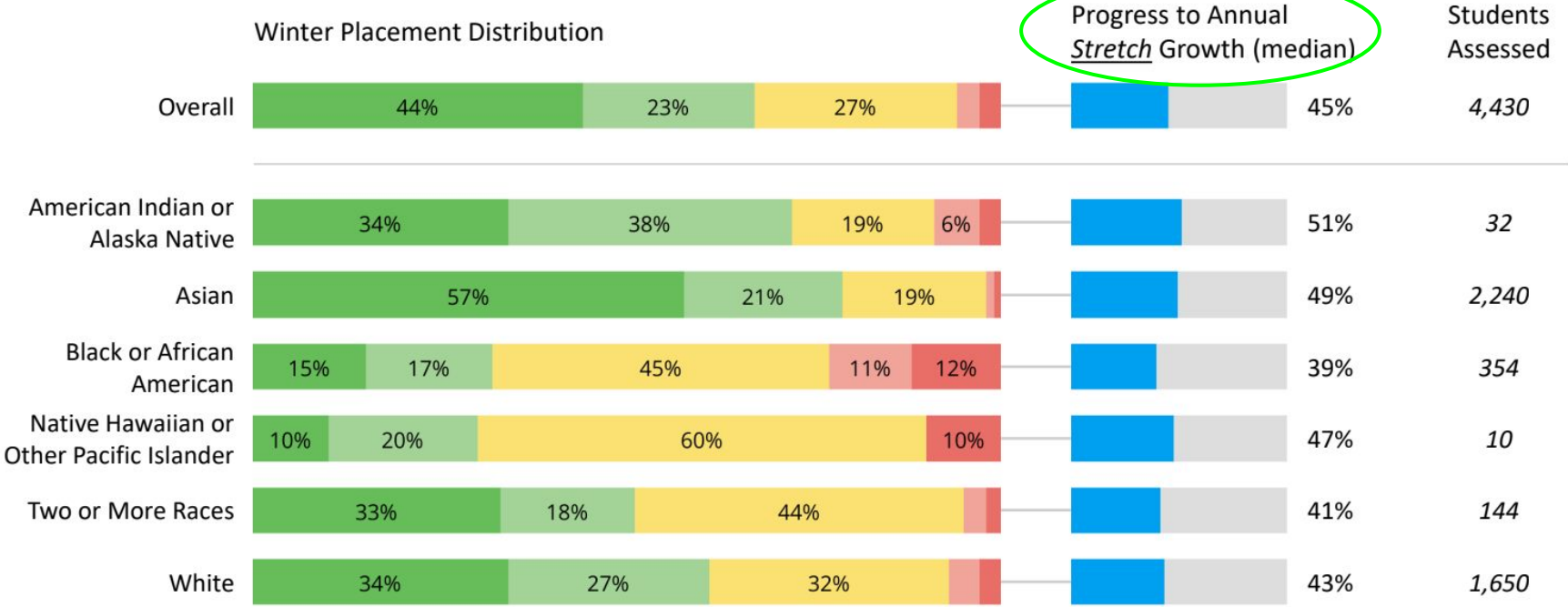


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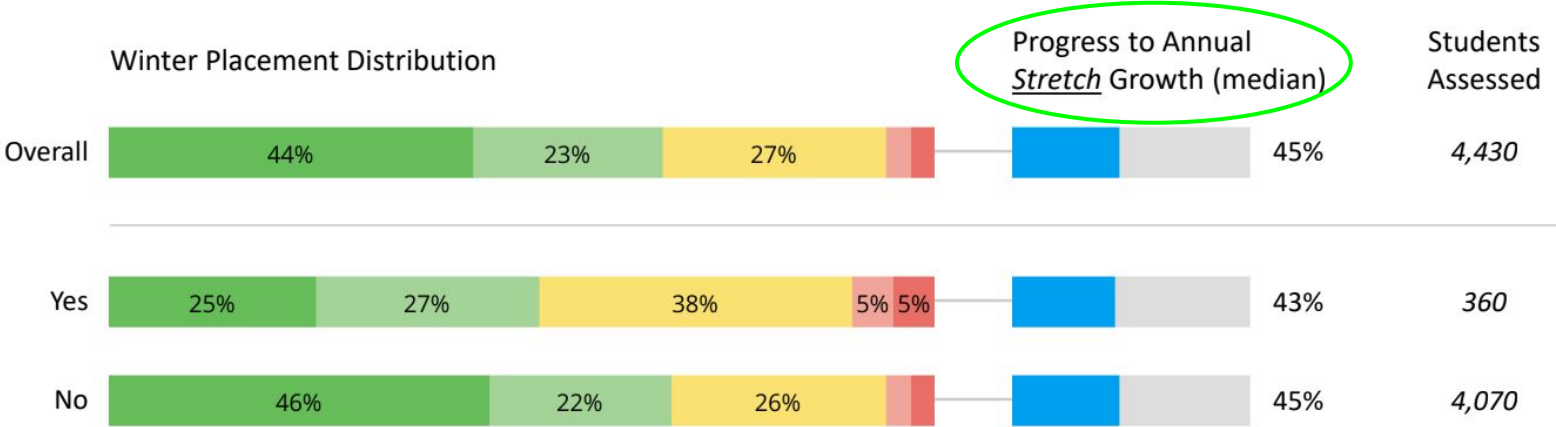
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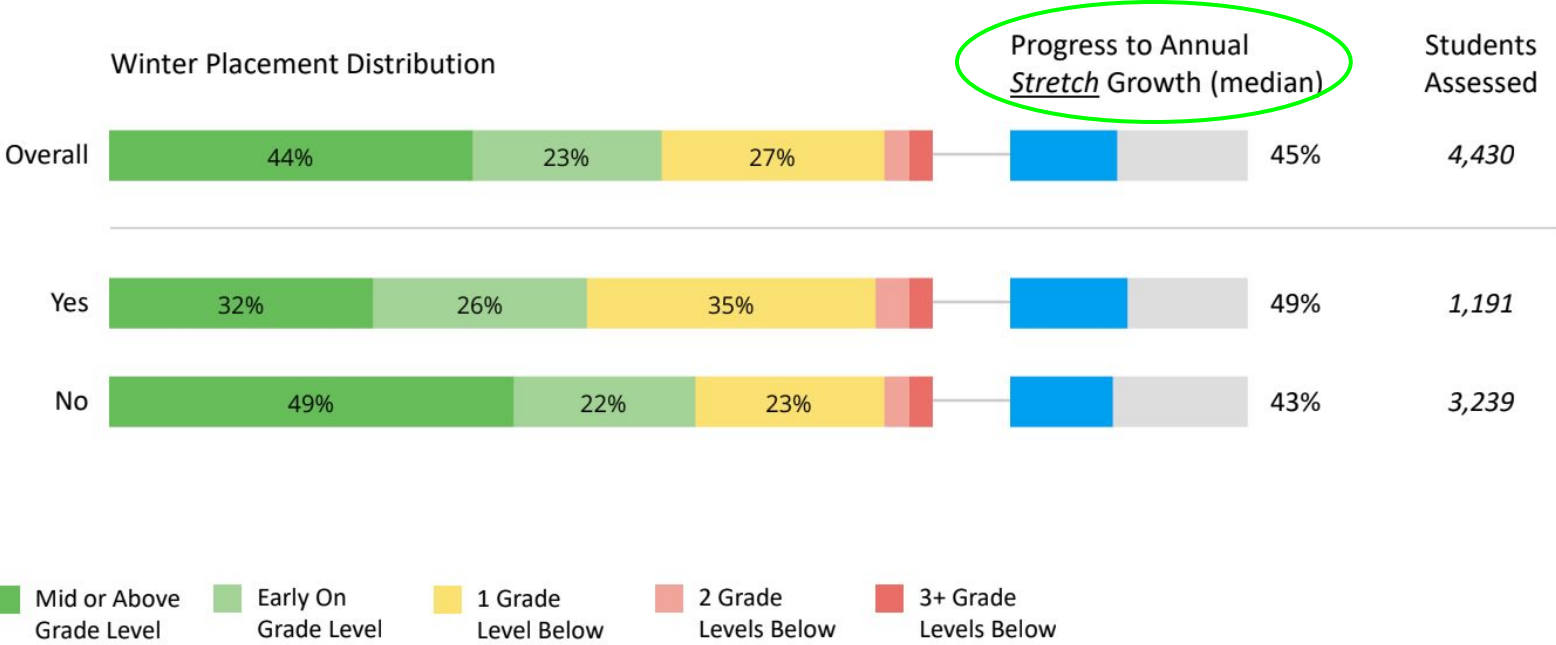


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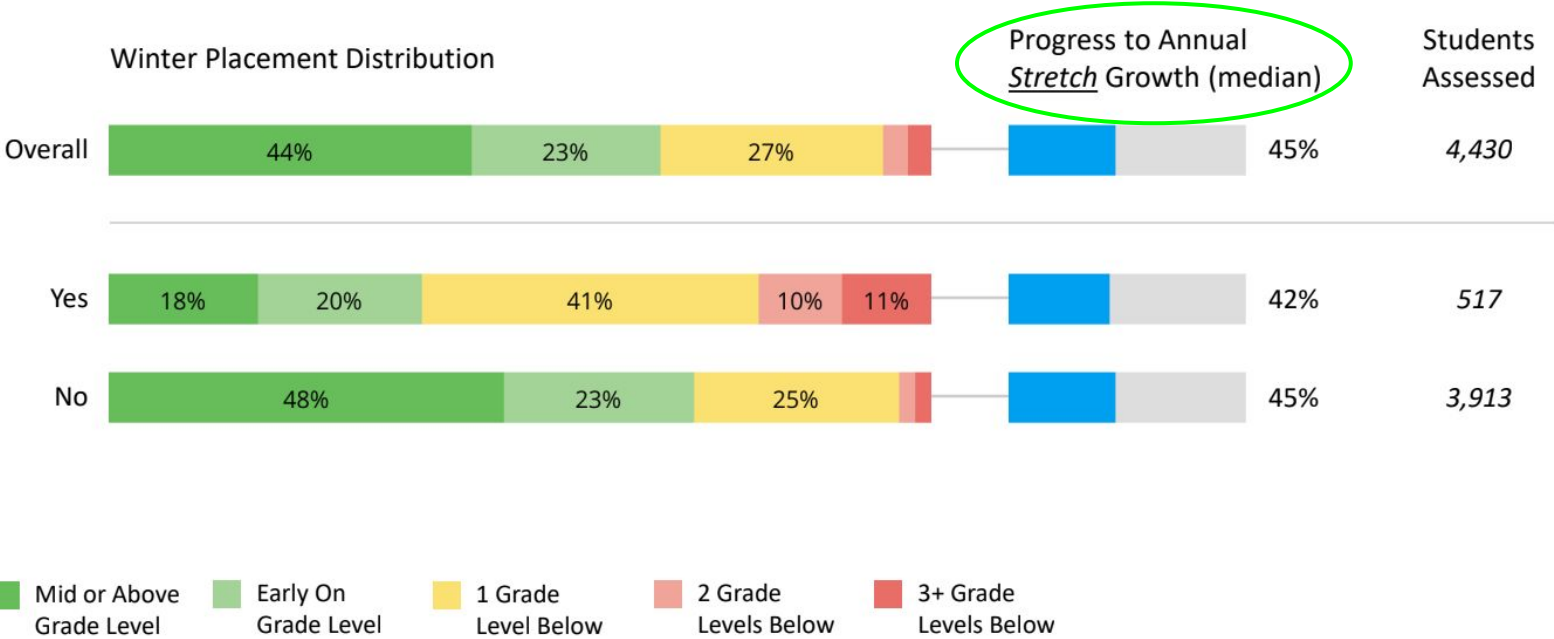


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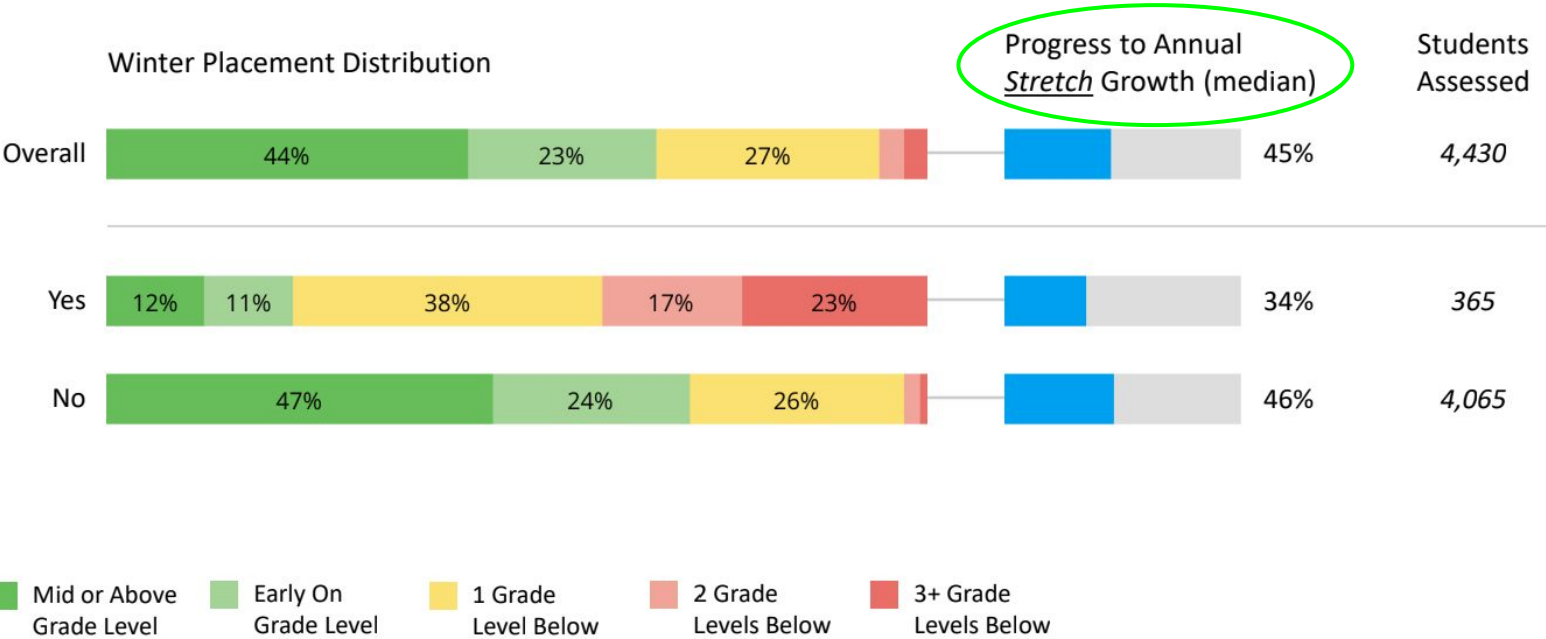
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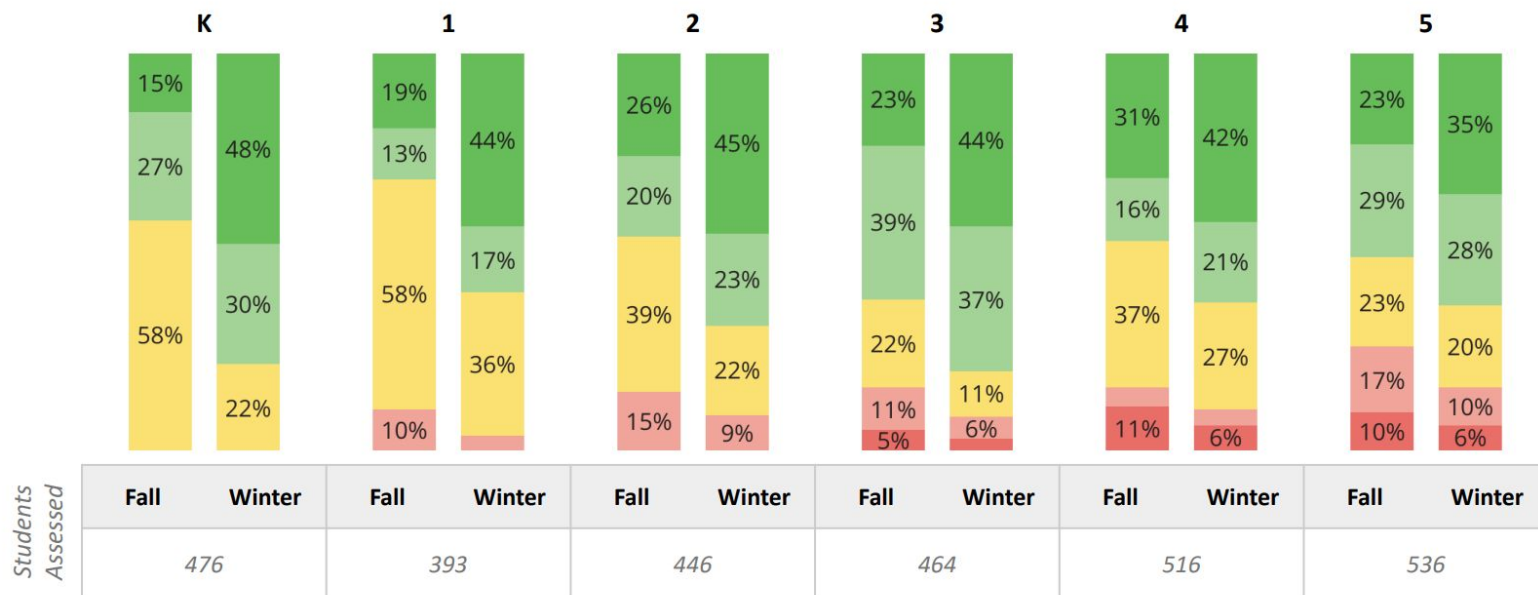
