Directors' Reports

Superintendent Report: Another school year is in the books. I am very pleased with the accomplishments of our staff and students. I am looking forward to the 2024-2025 school year. Planning for the next school year is underway, and staff recruitment to fill positions is ongoing. Matt Jacques has accepted an employment opportunity that will be closer to his home for family purposes. Thank you Matt for your 4 years of service, professionalism, and dedication! Thank you Deb Zelinski for your 25 years of service, I wish you all the best! Thank you Dawn for your 43 years of service. Thank you Meghan Lane for getting the GSRP agreement across the finish line. I want to extend a thank you to our Business Office Staff and Department Directors for their dedication and diligence over the 2023-2024 school year. There will be a Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB) scheduled for October 24-27 at the Lansing Center in Lansing, Michigan. Registration opens in July, please let me know if you're interested so I can have Tracy register you and reserve rooms. I would like the GOISD Board Members to start attending this conference on years that we don't attend AESA. This would be a good professional learning and team-building opportunity. The MASB Superintendent Rater Reliability Training will take place on August 29, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. located at the Bergland Office.

Financial Report:

It has been a busy time preparing this year's amendments and proposed budgets for next year. We have been working with the Department Heads and using our best judgment to forecast the budgets for next year. The 2024 Tax Rate Request forms were submitted to the local taxing agencies. Approval for this request will generate over \$3.7 million dollars in property tax revenue this year. SchoolsOPEN received our data file from REMC and has started reviewing the files and processes. The single federal funding audits are complete for the GOISD and Watersmeet. The preparation for fiscal audits will start once budget hearings have finished. Patty and I presented Carole Robl with the Golden Apple Award at this year's staff appreciation picnic. Carole's commitment to the business office team is evident every day!!

General Education Report:

The year-end report has been started. On May 22, we dedicated the classroom library makeover project in the classroom and it was a successful event. Student made bookshelves were still being finished due to Real Work running out of material. 100 students participated in the May Mental Health Awareness Challenge. 45 middle and high school students submitted artwork for the Poster Challenge. The REMC Print shop will print these posters and hang them in GOISD Schools and Office Buildings. Teams rolled out classroom challenges to promote mental health and wellness participate in the GOISD Podcast. I advocated the funding for students within the GOISD and secured over \$2500 for supplies for the local districts to be distributed to the students for care packages to take home for the summer. Students and staff attended the end-of-year Teaching PowWow in Watersmeet. I would like to extend a thank you to Rich White. Career and Technical Education Report:

GOISD Summer Youth Programs took place the week of June 10th. Programs included Woodworking, Tech, ESports, Welding, Cooking and Wilderness experience. Thank you to our Sponsors! Student Credentials and CNA Pinning Ceremony took place. 187 students completed CTE programs during 23-24 school year. 95 Industry recognized credentials were earned. 318 Work-Based Learning Experiences. A funding subcommittee gathered to review the 61a1 State categorical funding stream.

Special Education Report:

MAASE is working on a para-educator curriculum that includes certification at the end of training. Modules can be completed as a group or independently to attract and retain these vital positions with consideration for upward movement once certified. MAASE has increased the SLIP conference for center-based administrators to two days, increasing participation. This will provide an excellent opportunity for those with similar positions to network. I would like to thank the Board for allowing me to have a voice at the state level regarding special education in advocacy and professional learning. We have worked diligently towards improving the assessment and improvement of how we have provided special education services. This would not have been possible without the support of the GOISD Board of Education. Our students and staff had an outstanding school year and accomplished many wonderful and exciting activities. We implemented many new learning resources in our classrooms to promote student success and learning.

Early Childhood Report:

Our summer programming has started, and the children are starting to enjoy the outdoors. Four students joined the summer work-based learning beginning July 8 and ends August 8, Monday – Thursday 8:00 am – 2:00 pm. Two GSRP classrooms from Ironwood School District and the ECSE have moved to LLECC. Our rates will increase effective July 1, 2024, due to the stabilization grant ending and the center accruing additional costs. A flat rate of \$225.00 a week, \$45.00 per day. We’ve lost 7 children due to the rate increase, aging out, and moving. Currently 45 children are enrolled, with a full wait list for the infant room. We are hoping to provide free breakfast, lunch and snacks for all children from a Federal Grant. IHS will provide and deliver the food.

REMC Report:

Read to Ride-assisting UP Kids with the program for ages 6-14, running May 13-August 15. Discovery Education has been renewed. REMC1 staff retreat July 9-10. StarLab Training will be offered to both CCESD and GOISD, August 6, 9:00 am – 12:00 pm. ETC School. August 8, 8:30 – 12:30, Baarkell Elementary. Invest UP, MiWorks, and SiStem, and REMC1 assisting with business field trips for teachers with local manufacturing companies.
