Directors' Reports

Superintendent Report: Superintendent Tulppo, Board Members; Cathy Schamion, Marti Wegner, Jim Ojala, and Executive Assistant Tracy Franti had a successful trip to MASB (Michigan Association of School Boards) workshop in Lansing. Superintendent Tulppo has been attending local board meetings to present the GOISD service report.

Financial and Grants: Tammy and the Business Office Staff continue to assist our local districts with the conversion process. There is extra work across the board in the business offices, but everyone seems to be managing and we are all excited about the new system. November 30th is the deadline for submitting the Final Expenditure Reports for most of our federal grants and a few of our state grants. The Business Office staff process & certify FERs for Watersmeet and Ewen-Trout Creek as well. The fiscal year end audits and the FIDs for the GOISD, Watersmeet and Ewen-Trout Creek were submitted before the November 1st deadline. We also assisted Bessemer with their FID Submission this year.

Career and Technical Education Report: Changes were needed to our account for E-rate discounts through USF. Thank you to Becky Pantti and Josh Hiner for working with the State to make sure it is now set up correctly. Ashley submitted a proposal to upgrade the Ontonagon CTE building/facility to the newly formed Special Projects Workgroup and GOISD Building & Grounds Committee. OHM Advisors completed a walkthrough of the building and will develop a plan for the Board to consider for upgrades and additional space for a construction program serving OASD, ETC, and Watersmeet students. Ashley attended the OCTE Fall Update on October 30th in Lansing. An opportunity to formally work with Celena Mills, OCTE State Director and share feedback regarding potential new Perkins legislation and CTE program options.

A student in Mrs. Sprague's nursing program expressed interest in becoming a surgeon as a career and was allowed to job shadow two full days of surgeries with Dr. Braucher, Surgeon at Aspirus Grand View.

Early Childhood Report: The GSC hosted Halloween events in each county. Our Lady of Peace Church hosted a Trunk or Treat after the parade. We had a huge turnout of parents that attended the parade. Paula went into the daycares in Ontonagon as well as the GSRP class. Meghan attended the ECAN (Early Childhood Administrators Network) in Mount Pleasant October 14th-16th, to network plans to better support our classroom teachers. We are seeking applications for Child Care Aides at LLECC. We are advertising our GSRP programs in both counties to serve more children. The GSRP is partnering with MSUE in the knapsack program. Both the Gogebic and Ontonagon County GSRP staff participated in a High Scope training on October 25th and will participate in another High Scope training on December 11th. The GSRP program was rated the number one preschool program in the nation! Our team members are competing in a "Door Decorating" event.

Instructional Services Report: The Instructional Services Department analyzed the progress and identified next steps regarding the Literacy and Math Commitments at our recent GOISD Professional Development Day, on October 25th. We would like to team with Early Childhood to extend and expand. Travis attended the Fall Education Conference on Learning Together. Dr. John Hattie, keynote speaker; and his team of education experts presented the topics Artificial Intelligence, Interventions, Data Management, Assessment, Student and Teacher Wellness. Our staff in Ironwood implemented an IAS Intensifying Literacy Intervention. The intervention protocol that had such a positive impact on the student learning and growth that they were asked to present at the annual MiMTSS (Michigan Multi-Tiered Systems of Support) Conference. Newly rebranded, District Improvement Committee met for the first meeting of the year last. The Committee will be seeking input from staff on potential areas for growth, working with the Strategic Plan. Co-chaired by Megan Hagen and Travis Powell, this Committee also represent many areas where multiple departments collaborate for the better of the GOISD.

Special Education Report: Departmental Structuring-Heidi, Director of Special Education; Rebecca Samson, Supervisor of Special Education; Mark Switzer, Center-Based Program Principal; and Elizabeth Billie, as the Technical Assistance Monitor; providing educational services, programming, and compliance across the Gogebic-Ontonagon counties.

The core principle of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) is to provide a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) in the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) for eligible students. The process includes three main activities: Student Record Review, Staff Interviews, and Parent Focus Group. A goal is to provide effective communication to ensure equitable access, connecting families to programs, and services. A Special Education Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) Meeting was held on November 6th. David Sim (Copper Country ISD) presented parents on the Limitless Potential statewide marketing campaign. Early On & Early Childhood Special Education had seven referrals in October, bringing the total number of referrals for the 2024-2025 school year to 13. Mark and our Crisis Support Team were on site and available to provide support with the loss of a student.

Student Health & Wellness Services: Student Health & Wellness met on October 25th. A joint training session about the new evaluation tool with the Instructional Services Department. The team reviewed departmental needs, established priorities, and generated a work plan. Three priorities are, Refining Crisis Response, Developing guidelines/Clarification of Services, and Coordination of Services with Community Partners-Create Continuum. Megan was able to arrange a support team for GOISD and ETC to implement a crisis support plan with the loss of a student. Megan thanked the GOISD Administration, Heidi, Mark, Logan, and staff for their presence, support of staff, and swift communication. The District Improvement Committee came together November 7th. We have a diverse group with representation from all departments, varied roles, and a mix of team experience. An unanticipated HRA fund was used to purchase additional AED's and supplies for our local districts.

REMC Report: REMC.Org is offering Personal Development Courses, REMC Educator PD with SCECH. 13+ Google Gemini is now FERPA compliant and available for free (basic version) and a paid version in you Schools Google Education Workspace. Superintendents, REMC1 (through the MISEN USF consortium) has submitted interest for all our members in participating in the USF funder Cybersecurity Pilot program. Inventory and machine counts will begin in preparation for upcoming equipment refresh needs.
