Agenda Topic: Behavioral Threat Assessment & Management Law Update

Presented by: Jason Reinecke, Assistant Superintendent of Human Services

Summary of Issue:

The GHAPS Behavioral Threat Assessment & Management (BTAM) Guidelines offer school staff a systematic, team-based approach to assess the risk of violence and address dangerous behavior through an integrated intervention plan. This tool provides documentation of the incident, an assessment of the present threat to the school, and an intervention plan template. The intent of this tool is not to determine whether a threat was made, but rather if the student poses a threat at this moment in time and to reduce the risk that a violent act will be carried out. The primary objective of a threat assessment is to provide help for the student and to ensure positive outcomes for the student and community.

Trent Carithers, Director of Safety & Security, will present the Board with an overview of the assessment tool and information on upcoming changes to the related state law.
