Summary:	BP 3460 The Superintendent or designee shall keep the School Board informed about the district's financial condition.				
Financial Implications:	On May 19, 2025, the Board of Education approved the allocation of \$50,000 for the construction and electrical work of instructional spaces related to reconfiguration and program development of Special Education self-contained programs K-8. These funds were moved from the general fund to a capital project fund called SPED Construction. This work has been completed. Administration is now requesting to rename the project to Rural Housing Capital Funds and use the remaining amount of \$42,542.26 for Rural Housing maintenance work.
