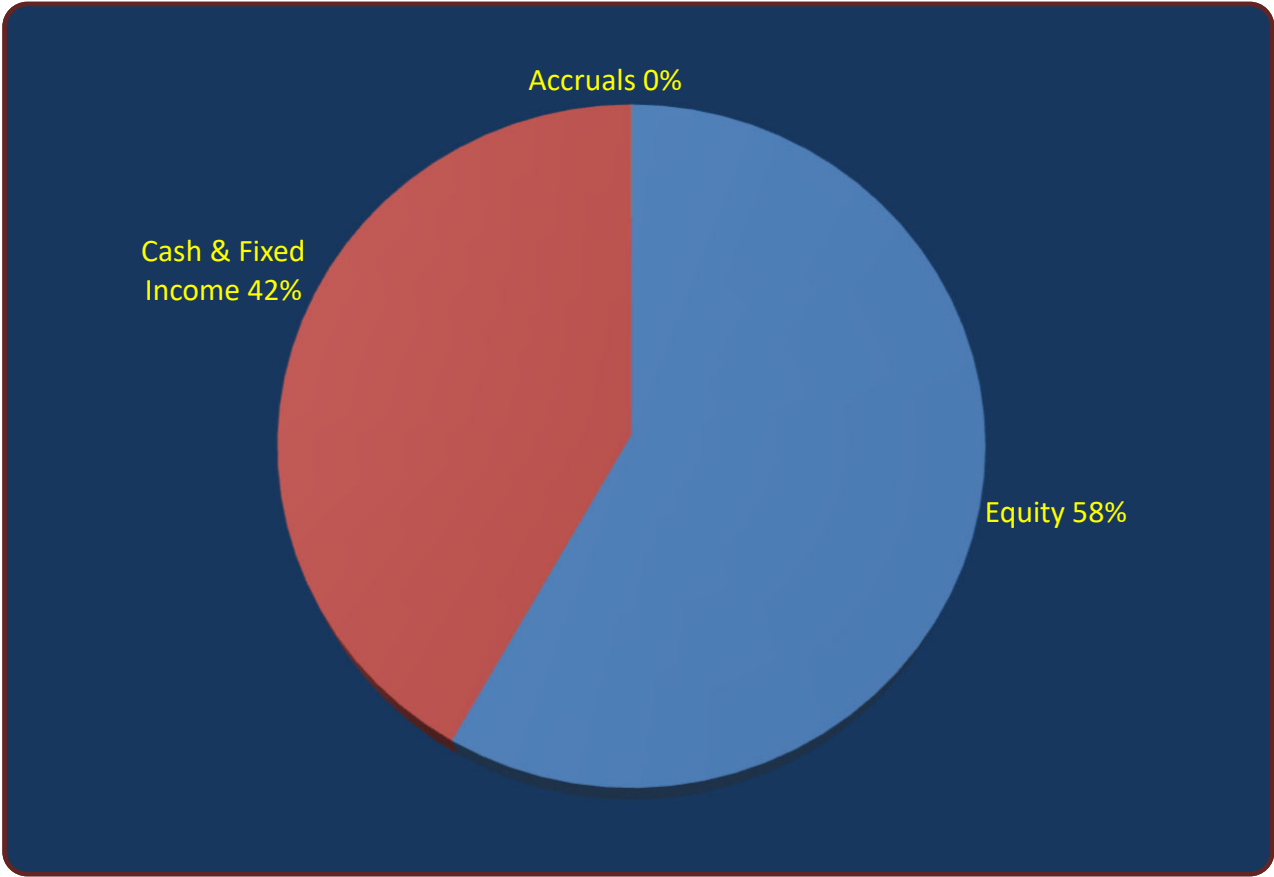

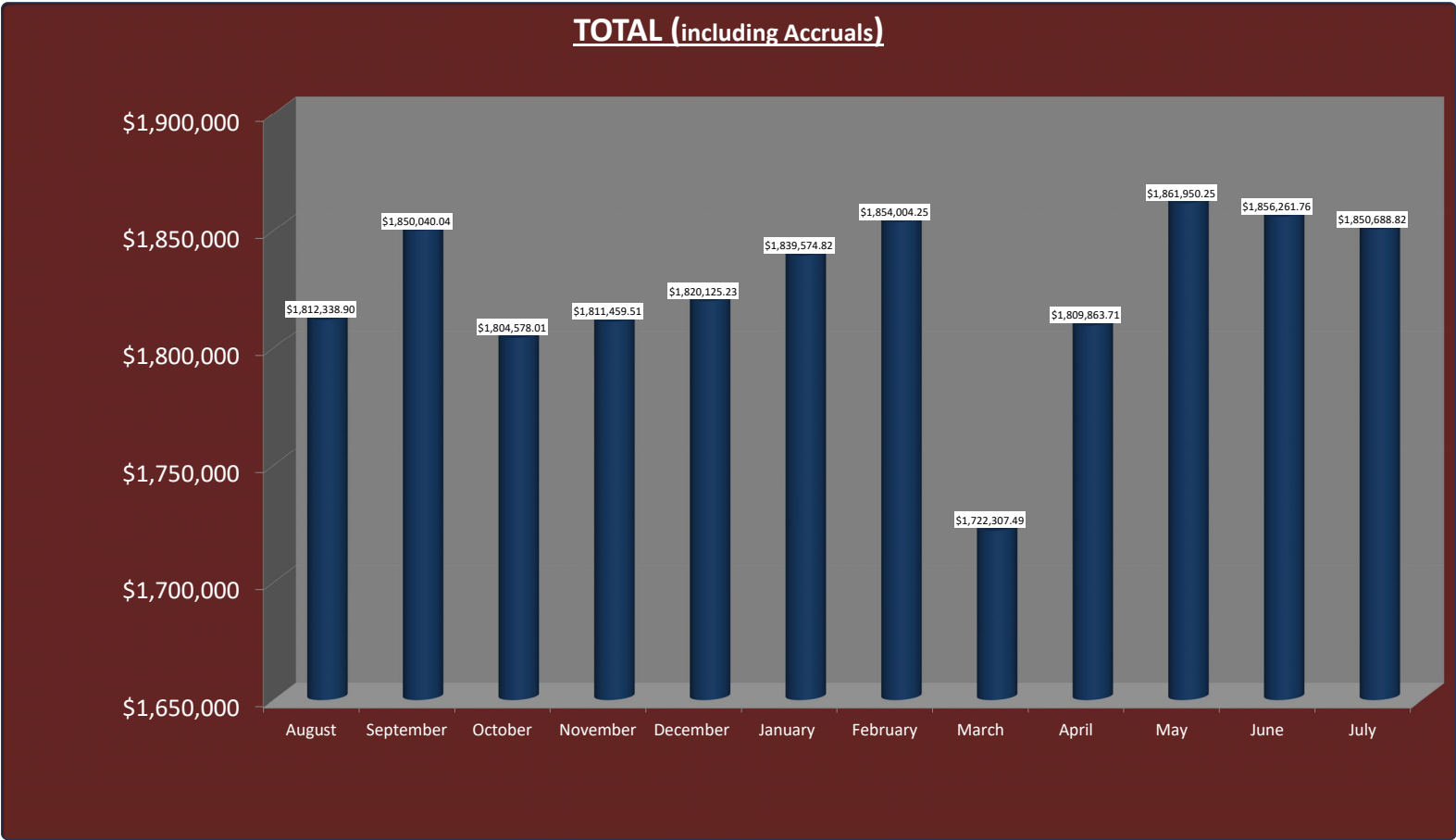

ASSET ALLOCATION



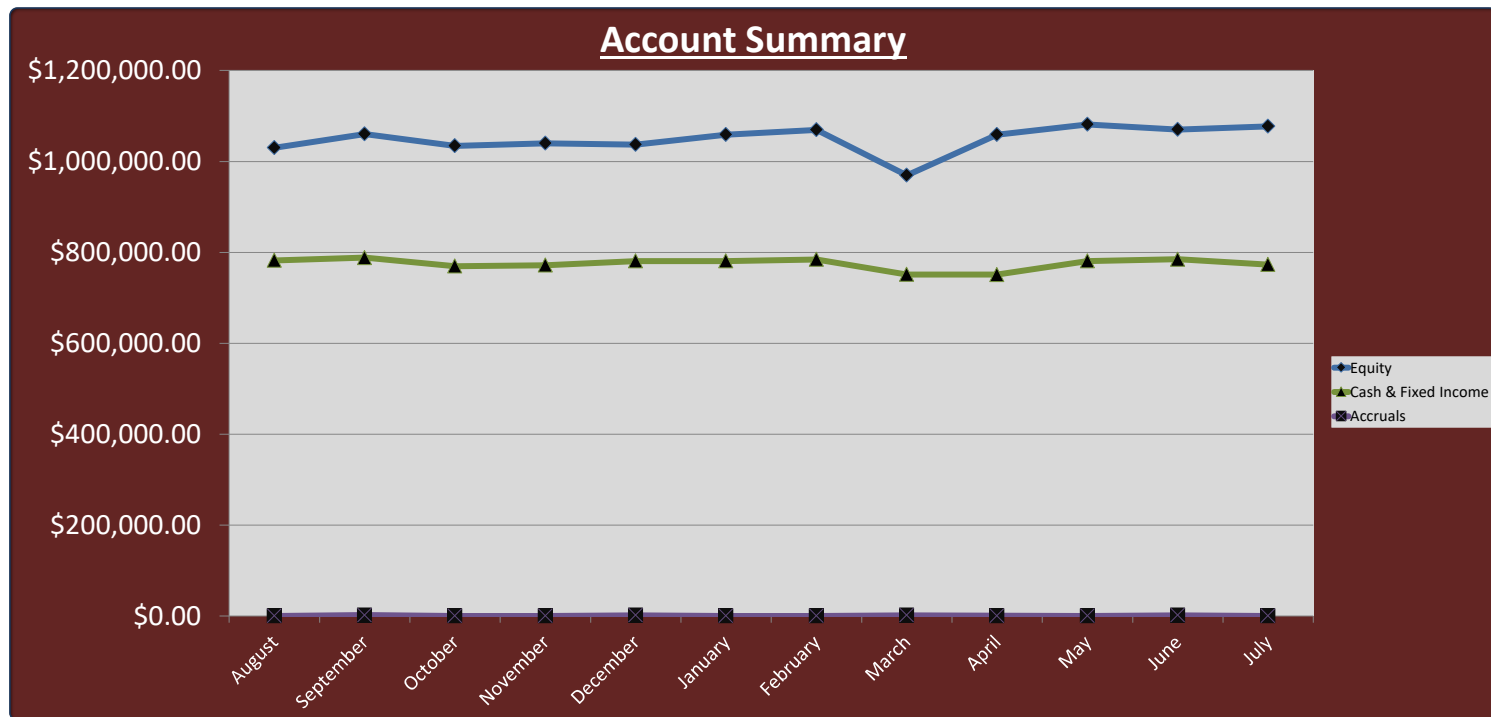

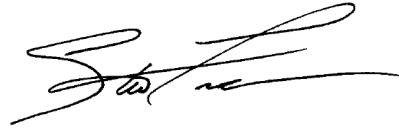

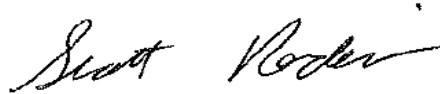
