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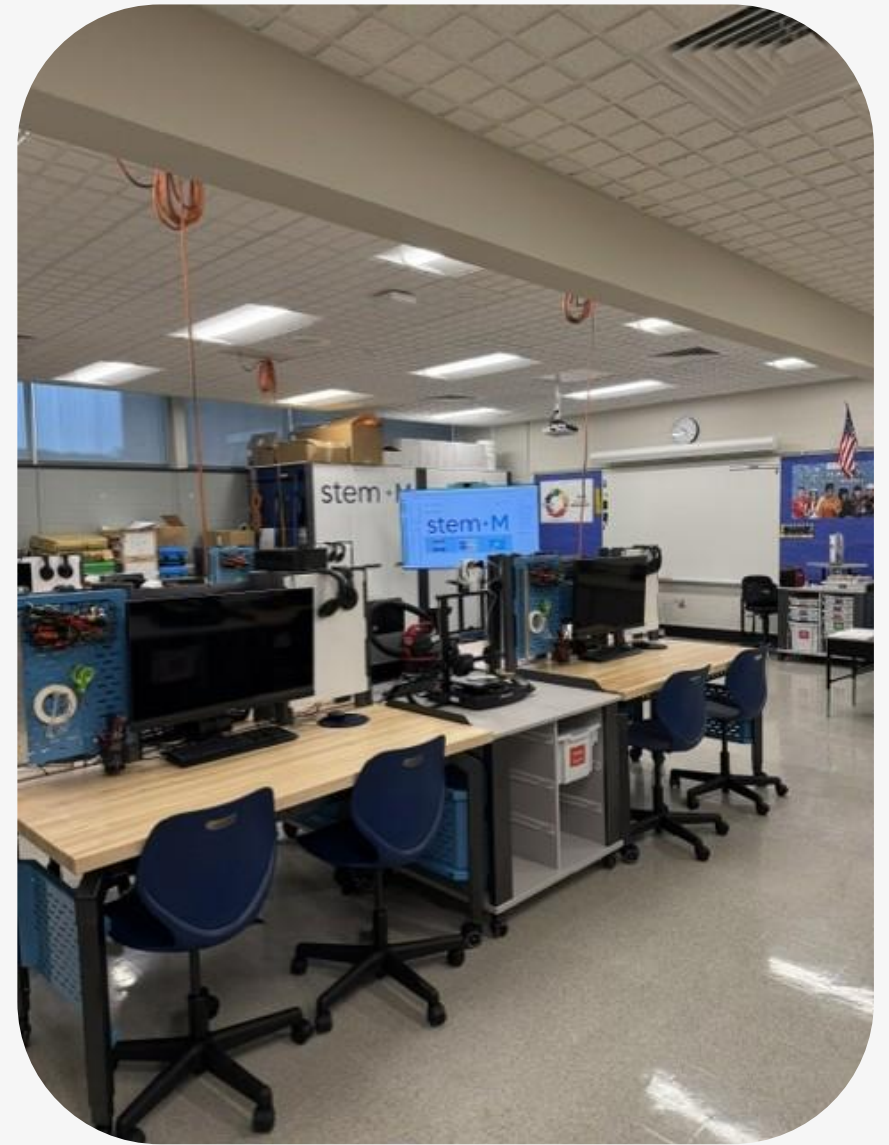

Timeline

October 2025

- The Offices of Teaching & Learning and Student Services met to discuss collaboratively integrating the Career Education and Work Standards (CEW) into the K–12 curriculum.
- A districtwide CEW Committee was established.

January 2026–April

- The CEW Committee began meeting monthly.
- Through these meetings, the committee identified inefficiencies within the district's existing systems and evaluated four college and career readiness platforms: Smart Futures, Naviance, SchoolLinks, and Xello.

May 2026 - Present

- The committee identified Xello as the preferred platform and began preparing a recommendation for Board approval.

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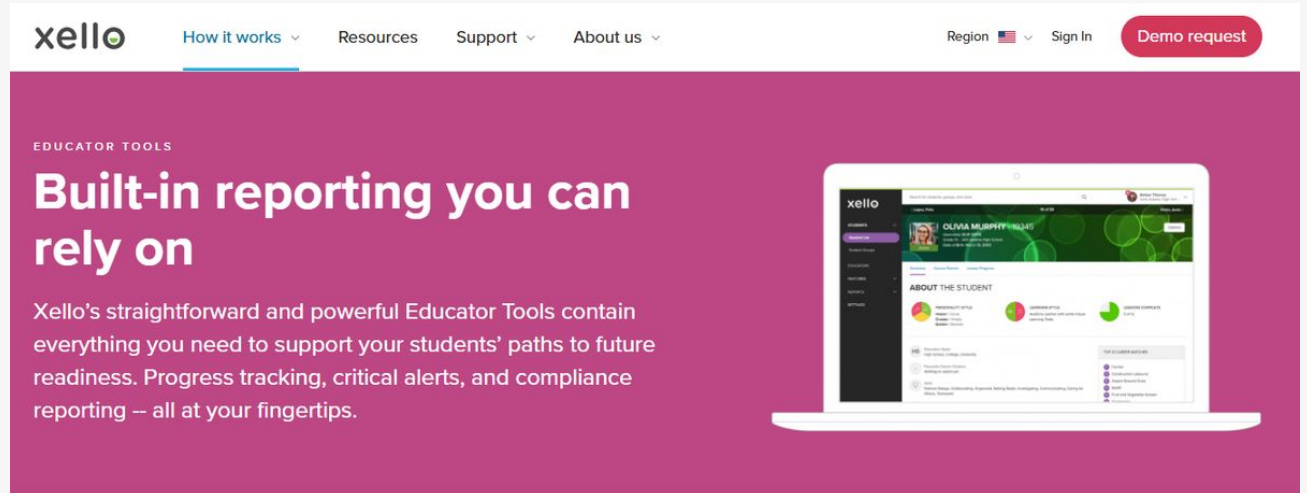

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English Language Development and Pennridge

- An **English Learner (EL)** is a student who has been identified as needing support to develop English language proficiency.
- **English Language Development (ELD)** is a federally mandated program in which school districts are required to identify English Language Learners (ELs) and provide appropriate language **instruction** and **supports** to ensure **access to grade-level content**.
- **WIDA** (World-Class Instructional Design & Assessment) **ACCESS** is the **annual state-required assessment** that measures English Learners' progress in **listening, speaking, reading, and writing**, helping schools **determine** language-**support** needs and readiness to exit English language development services. English language growth & academic progress is tracked over time using **multiple measures**.



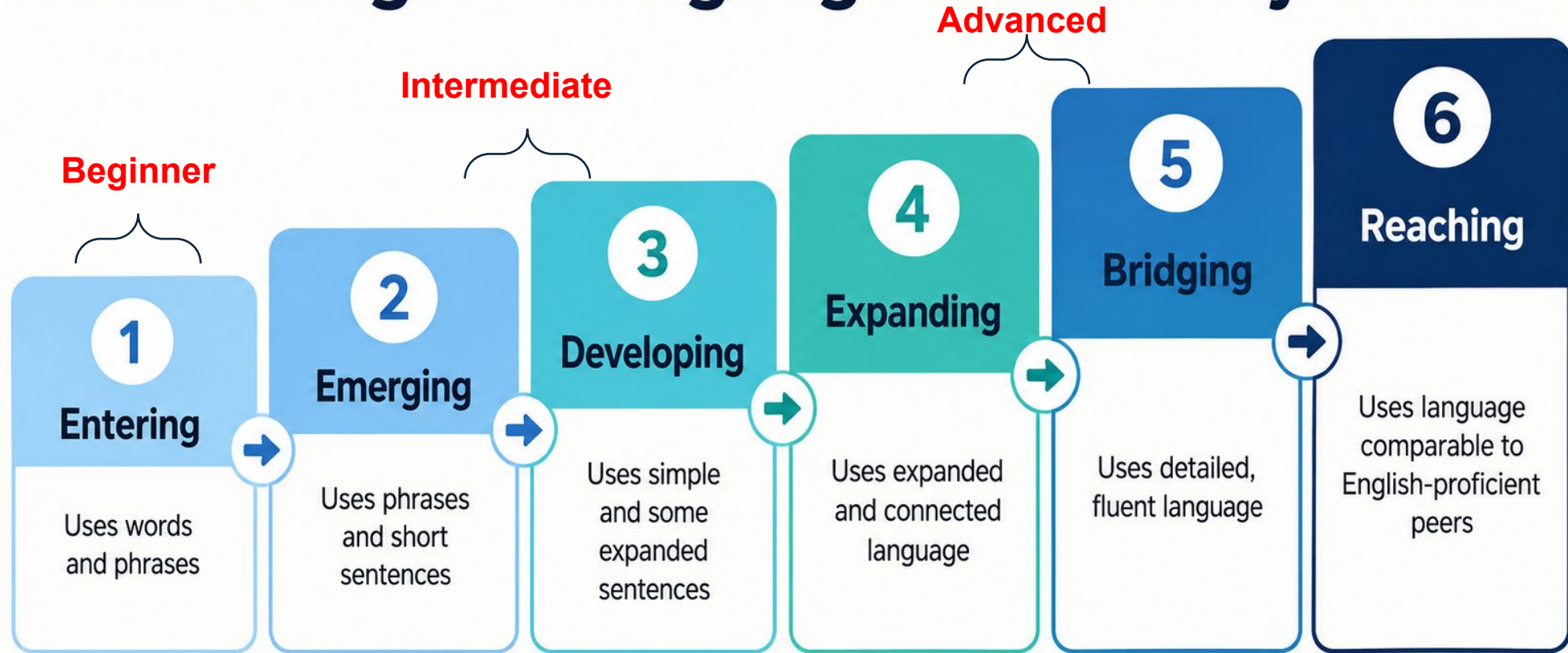
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WIDA English Language Proficiency Levels



Progress is measured across Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing.



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English Language Development Programming

- ELs receive specialized **ELD instruction with an ELD Specialist** and also participate in **grade level academic courses** and classrooms.
- ELs **level of support** is determined by their **language proficiency level**
 - **Elementary:** Designated ELD Block during RELA Small Group Instruction & WIN
 - **Vista Higher Learning: Get Ready! Soar (approved 8/17/26)**
 - Being a Reader Designated ELD during RELA Small Group Instruction
 - Summit K12: WIDA-aligned Benchmarking & Personalized Learning Plans
 - **Secondary:** ELD courses (Academic Literacy 1-3 & ELA/ELD 1 & 2)
 - Vista Higher Learning: Get Ready! 6-8 and Get Ready! 9-12
 - National Geographic Inside (Grades 6-8) and Edge (Grades 9-12)
 - Summit K12: WIDA-aligned Benchmarking & Personalized Learning Plans

*All programming is available in **paper/pencil format** aside from the benchmark assessments*



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English Language Learners At Pennridge

- Pennridge currently serves ~**200 English Learners** (ELs) across all 11 school sites, **K–12**, representing **29+ home languages**.
- Our EL population is linguistically and culturally diverse. **Spanish** is the largest home language at **66%**, followed by **Arabic (6%)**, and **Russian (4%)**.
- **SLIFE: Students with Limited and/or Interrupted Formal Education (2%)**

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Support of Multilingual Families

Our goal: Ensure multilingual families have equitable access to information, resources, and opportunities to engage in their child's education by building partnerships that connect families with academic, technology, and community resources.

- Translation and interpretation services
 - School signage, iPads readily available at front office & nursing
 - District-wide Translation Protocol
 - Training provided to district-wide office staff & teachers
 - Multilingual communication tools, including TalkingPoints, in person interpretation
 - 85% of ML families received communication through TalkingPoints in 25-26
- Resources and supports that help families navigate the school system
 - In-person support with registration (supplies, community resources)
- Family engagement opportunities designed specifically for multilingual families
 - ELD family connection events



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Support of Multilingual Students

Every ELD student is assigned a case manager (ESL specialists) who:

Supports Academic Success

- Communicates and collaborates with all staff who work with the student (Shares WIDA scores, language proficiency information, and relevant background information)
- Helps students navigate new school routines and expectations
- Attends meetings and collaborates with teams supporting the EL
- Co-plans with teachers to provide scaffolds and access to grade-level content
- Monitors grades, classroom performance, and overall progress

Supports the Whole Student & Family

- Consistent point of contact who connects families with school and district resources, including nursing, transportation, social work, nutrition services, attendance, and technology
- Helps families understand and navigate school systems and resources

Builds School & Community Connections

- Encourages participation in sports, clubs, activities, and other school opportunities
- Supports students in exploring career and technical education opportunities & helps students connect their interests to post-graduation plans and goals



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Monitoring Student Progress & Support

We **track** students through **multiple data points**, no single measure.

- **WIDA ACCESS & ELD Benchmarks** = English language growth
- **District benchmark and growth data** = Content area academic growth
- **Classroom performance & grades** = Daily application of classroom skills/objectives
- **Teacher observations and feedback** = Academic language & functioning
- **PSSA/Keystone results** = Performance on grade-level standards

Considerations When Interpreting EL State Assessment Data

- **Limited assessment accommodations:**
 - **ELA PSSA/Keystone:** First-year ELs may be exempt; translated directions
 - **Math/Science:** Students are not exempt; a Spanish version is available, along with allowable accommodations
 - **Language and content demands:** demonstrate grade-level knowledge while continuing to develop English
- **Reading and writing demands:** difficulty accessing or expressing their knowledge in English
- **Student background and experience:**
 - Literacy level and prior educational experience
 - Students with Limited or Interrupted Formal Education (SLIFE)
 - Familiarity with standardized testing & technology demands
 - Transient student population



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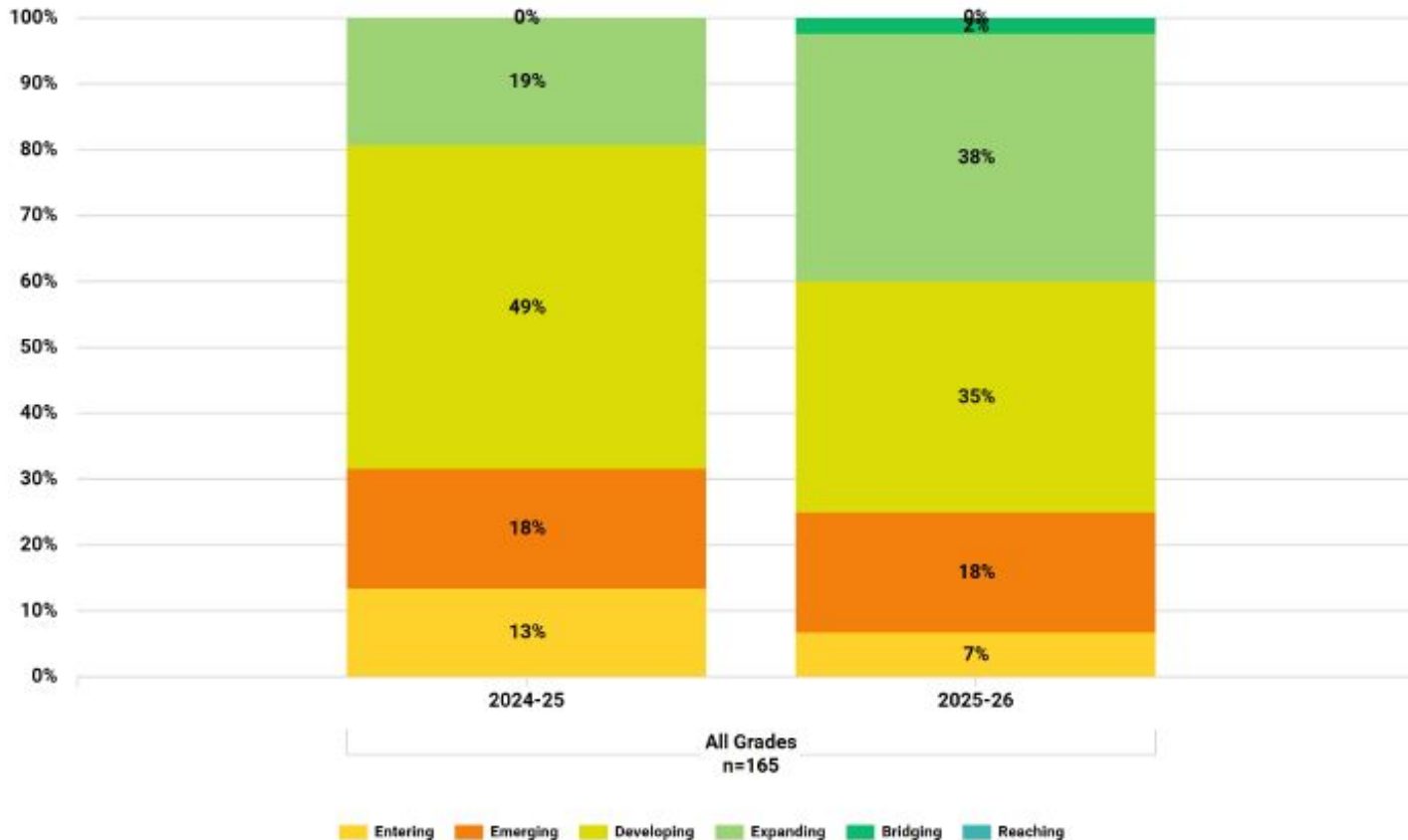

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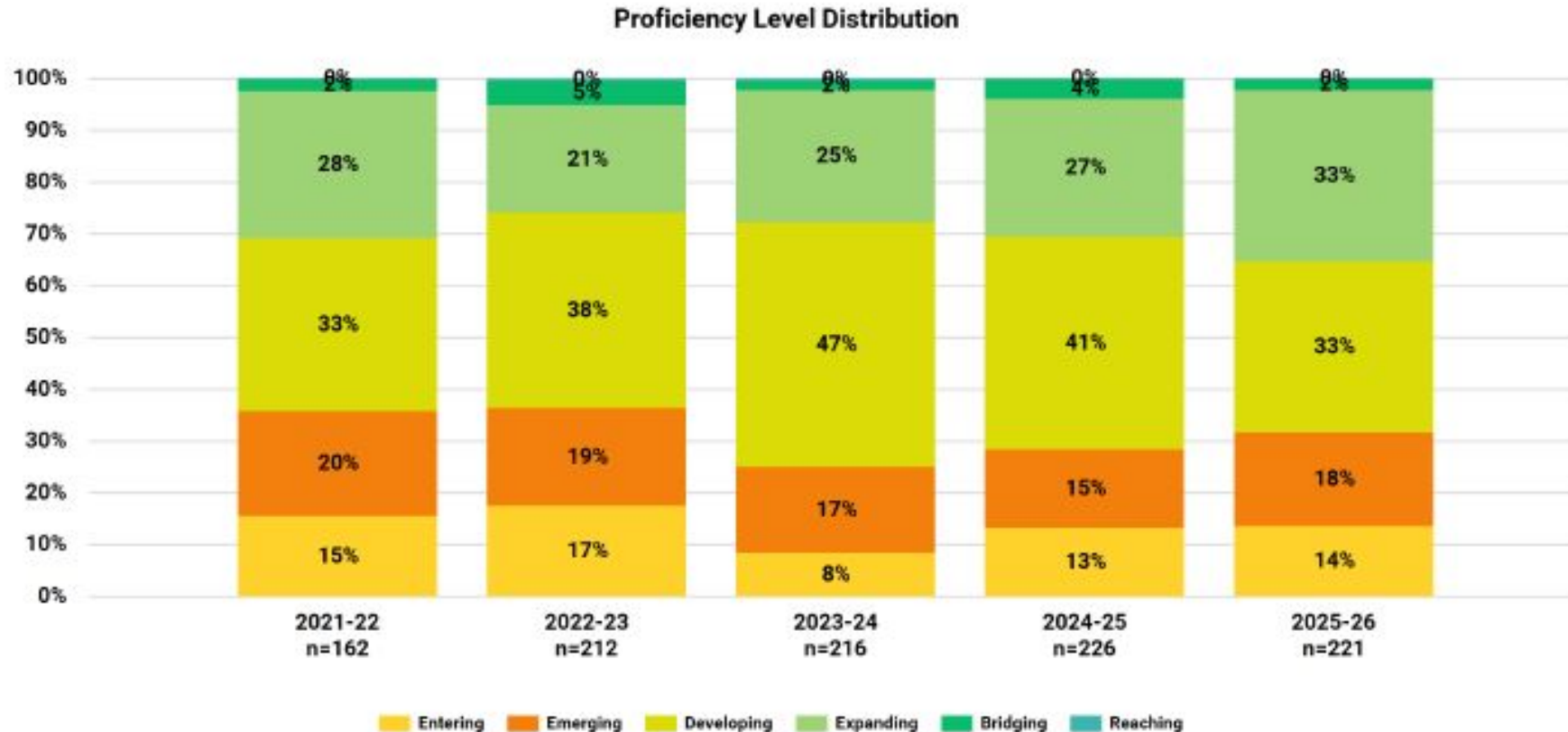
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WIDA ACCESS Composite Scores (All Grades)

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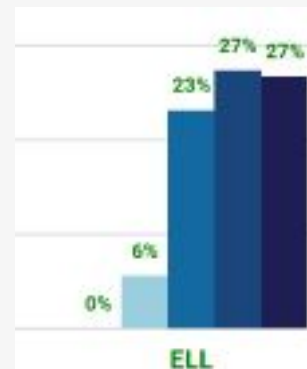

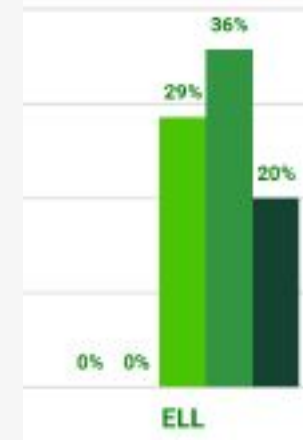

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EL Growth to Target Data WIDA ACCESS

- **Growth to Target** shows whether an English Learner made the **expected amount of progress** toward English proficiency during the year.
- Each student has an individualized WIDA growth target, and the data show whether the student met or exceeded that expected target. Importantly, students who did not meet their target may still have made meaningful progress; they simply did not reach the full amount of growth expected for the year.

Grade Span	Students Met Target
Elementary	36.6% (37/101)
Middle School	13.5% (5/37)
High School	16.1% (5/31)
District Overall	27.8% (47/169)

- **47 students** demonstrated sufficient progress to meet their individualized growth expectations.
- **28% or nearly 1 in 3** ELs met their growth target
- Typical trend as younger ELs often make larger gains as they develop foundational English, while secondary students face increasingly complex academic language demands.
