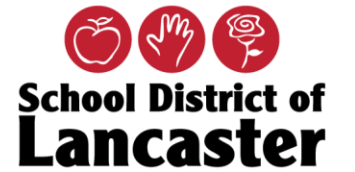

Title	Dress and Appearance
Code	325
Status	Review

Purpose

Whereas a professional appearance has a positive impact on the workplace environment, all district employees are expected to act as role models by adhering to the established dress standards guidelines. The dress standards contribute towards promoting a professional image, helping to establish and maintain respect and credibility. The guidelines shall be considered the minimum expectations.[\[1\]](#)

In addition to maintaining proper hygiene, all clothing and body ornamentation must not be offensive and must be free of any printed material advertising tobacco, alcohol, or prohibited drug products or may be offensive. Offensive is defined as obscene, indecent, sexually explicit, advocates or symbolizes sexual acts or conduct, prohibited drug use, associates with an extremist group, gang affiliation or activity, or advocates prejudice or discrimination prohibited by Board policy, federal, state or local law ordinance. [\[3\]](#)

Employees' hairstyles should not cause a safety or health hazard.

Employee dress and appearance must not disrupt the educational process, interfere with the maintenance of a positive teaching/learning climate, or compromise reasonable standards of health and safety.

Employees shall be responsible to wear the district employee identification badge in accordance with established district procedures.

Authority

Administrative, professional and support employees set an example in dress and appearance for students and the school community. Employees' dress should reflect their professional status and encourage respect for authority in order to have a positive influence on the district's programs and operations.

The Board has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming requirements, within law, for all district employees to prevent an adverse impact on the educational programs and district operations.[\[1\]](#)

The Board directs compliance with Board policy and law prohibiting discrimination, including but not limited to protections addressing:[\[2\]](#)[\[3\]](#)

1. Protective hairstyles, including but not limited to hairstyles such as locs, braids, twists, coils, Bantu knots, afros and extensions.
2. Religious creed including head coverings and hairstyles historically associated with religious creeds.

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or designee will develop administrative guidelines that define appropriate and inappropriate dress for employees.

The building principal or immediate supervisor is authorized to interpret and enforce this Policy. The principal or immediate supervisor may approve alternate dress for special events.

Consequences for Violations to Staff Dress Code

Repeated violations will be subject to progressive discipline as outlined in Policy 317, Conduct/Disciplinary Procedures.

Purpose

To ensure accurate, transparent and legally compliant financial reporting for the school district, the district's financial accounts must be fully documented within the annual district audit and applicable state audits.

Authority

The Board shall contract with an independent, certified public accountant to conduct an annual district audit in conformance with prescribed and legal standards. The completed audit shall be presented to the Board for its examination and approval.[\[1\]](#)[\[2\]](#)[\[3\]](#)[\[4\]](#)

The Board recognizes the importance of the public's right to access the public records of the district, including public financial records. The public has the right under law to inspect and procure copies of the annual financial audit conducted by the district's accountants and any state-level financial audit.[\[2\]](#)[\[5\]](#)[\[6\]](#)[\[7\]](#)

Delegation of Responsibility

The district must submit an annual financial report to the Pennsylvania Department of Education by October 31 each year.[\[8\]](#)[\[9\]](#)

The Superintendent and Board Secretary shall annually, by December 31, submit a signed statement to the Pennsylvania Department of Education certifying that the financial statements of the school district have been properly audited pursuant to law and that in the independent auditor's opinion, the financial information submitted in the annual financial report is materially consistent with the audited financial statements.[\[8\]](#)

If the financial information submitted in the annual financial report was not deemed materially consistent with the audited financial statements, the district shall submit a revised annual financial report no later than December 31. [\[8\]](#)[\[9\]](#)

Title	Data Governance - Storage/Security
Code	830.1
Status	Review
Adopted	December 19, 2023

Purpose

The district is required to collect, create, store and manage data and information. Accurately maintaining and protecting such data is essential for efficient district operations, legal compliance, confidentiality and upholding trust with the school community.

This policy addresses the Board's commitment to respecting the privacy of student, family and employee data through sound data governance related to the integrity and security of the data collected, maintained, stored and managed by the district.

Authority

The Board recognizes the importance of establishing and maintaining a system of data governance that addresses district staff responsibilities and complies with federal and state laws and regulations regarding data storage, security and records management. The district's data governance system shall meet or exceed industry and/or government standards for data protection and privacy of personal information.[\[1\]](#)[\[2\]](#)

The Board directs that the creation, collection, retention, retrieval and disposition of district records shall be governed by Board policy and the district's Records Management Plan and Records Retention Schedule.[\[3\]](#)

The Board directs notifications of a breach of the security of the district's computerized data system involving an individual's personal information to be conducted in accordance with law and Board policy.[\[4\]](#)[\[5\]](#)

Definitions

Confidential Data/Information - information regarding of which law, Board policy or contract prohibit disclosure or which may be disclosed only in limited circumstances. Confidential data includes, but is not limited to, personally identifiable information and other personal information regarding students, employees and district residents.[\[6\]](#)[\[7\]](#)[\[8\]](#)

Critical Data/Information - information that is essential to district operations and that must be accurately and securely maintained to avoid disruption to district operations.

Data Governance - the district's comprehensive system to ensure the integrity of data created, collected, stored, secured and managed by the district.

Encryption - the use of an algorithmic process to transform data into a form in which there is a low probability of assigning meaning without use of a confidential process or key.[\[9\]](#)

Personal Information - includes an individual's first name or first initial and last name in combination with and linked to any one (1) or more of the following when not encrypted or redacted:[5][9]

1. Social Security number.
2. Driver's license number or state identification card number issued instead of a driver's license or alien number.
3. Financial account number, credit or debit card number, in combination with any required security code, access code or password that would permit access to an individual's financial account.
4. Medical information, meaning any individually identifiable information contained in the individual's current or historical record of medical history or medical treatment or diagnosis created by a health care professional.[9]
5. Health insurance information, meaning an individual's health insurance policy number or subscriber identification number in combination with access code or other medical information that permits misuse of an individual's health insurance benefits.[9]
6. A user name or email address, in combination with a password or security question and answer that would permit access to an online account.
7. Any student record considered private as outlined in Board policies 216 and 216.1.[7][10]

Personal information does not include publicly available information that is lawfully made available to the general public from federal, state or local government records or widely distributed media.[9][11]

Records Management Plan - the system implemented by the district for the storage, retention, retrieval and disposition of all records generated by district operations.[3]

Records Retention Schedule - a comprehensive listing stating retention periods and proper disposition of records.[3]

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent shall establish a committee tasked with developing and monitoring the procedures needed to implement this policy. Participation will include, but not be limited to, the Offices of Technology, Data Analytics and Strategy, Finance, Operations, and Talent and Employee Engagement.

All individuals who are granted access to confidential and/or critical data/information are required to keep the information secure and are prohibited from disclosing or assisting in the unauthorized disclosure of such data/information.[5]

The committee will ensure that this policy and the accompanying administrative regulations are reviewed on an annual basis and updated as necessary.[1][2]

Guidelines

The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations related to data storage and security procedures.

Unauthorized Access and Storage of Data

The district prohibits unauthorized storage of confidential and/or critical data/information of the district on a personal electronic device, personal email account or other personal platform. District staff and service providers shall use district-controlled accounts and platforms to securely access, store or transmit confidential and/or critical data/information of the district.

Service Providers

Service providers retained or contracted by the district shall comply with law, Board policy, administrative regulations and district procedures regarding data security and integrity of data containing confidential and/or critical data/information of the district.[3][5]

The district shall ensure that the agreement or contract for service with a service provider who may have access to confidential and/or critical data/information reflects appropriate data security provisions.

Consequences

Failure to comply with law, Board policy, administrative regulations or procedures regarding data governance and security may result in the following disciplinary measures and possible pursuit of civil and criminal sanctions:[12][13][14]

1. Employees may be disciplined up to and including termination.
2. Volunteers may be excluded from providing services to the district.
3. The termination of a business relationship with a service provider.

Title	Head Lice
Code	209.1
Status	Active

Purpose

The Board is committed to maintaining a healthy environment for students and staff. To fulfill that commitment, the Board establishes this policy to provide guidelines for the prevention and control of head lice in students.

Guidelines

At any time during the school year, the school nurse may examine a student for head lice. If nits are present, the student may remain in school. If live lice are identified, the following procedures shall be implemented:

1. The student will be excluded from school until treatment is concluded.
2. The parent/guardian will be immediately contacted to pick up the student. If the parent/guardian cannot be contacted or come to school to pick up the student, the student will be returned to class and will be sent home as usual with a School District of Lancaster notification form stating the need for treatment before returning to school.
3. The school nurse will provide information to the parent/guardian regarding treatment.
4. The school nurse will examine the student's siblings and other close contacts.

Readmission

After treatment has been completed and all live head lice have been removed from the head, the following procedures shall be implemented:

1. The student shall not attend classes until examined by the school nurse.
2. The parent/guardian shall accompany the student to school.
3. If upon examination the student is found to have live head lice, the student will be denied admission. If nits are present the student may remain in school.
4. After the student has been cleared to return to classes, the nurse may continue to check for head lice or nits because of the risk of reinfestation. The student will be checked as often as deemed necessary by the nurse.

As the student's education is of the utmost importance, no student will be excluded from school for more than two (2) weeks for head lice, unless some means of alternative program is provided. The student may return to school as soon as treated, but only three (3) days will be counted as excused absence.

Act 34 Resolution for Construction of a Consolidated Elementary School



Act 34 Resolution

The School District has determined that improved school facilities are required for the pupils of the School District and has authorized preliminary steps to plan for proposed new construction of the Consolidated Elementary School (the “Project”). The Pennsylvania Public School Code, including amendments made pursuant to Act 34 of 1973 (the “School Code”), requires that a **public hearing be held prior to the construction of**, or the entering into a contract to construct, a new school building or a substantial addition to an existing school building. In accordance with the School Code, a public hearing is required to be held in connection with the project. The School Code requires that a notice of such public hearing be advertised at least twenty (20) days before such hearing and that certain information be made available at such hearing and that certain financial information be available for inspection by interested citizens during the period of such advertisement.

A public hearing will be held in Lincoln Middle School, on September 22nd at 5:00 pm

INTRODUCTION OF PROJECT

School Facilities, District-Wide

The District-Wide School Facilities include fourteen buildings that serve elementary-age students, five buildings that serve middle school students (including Martin which is a K-8 building), and the JP McCaskey and East buildings that serve high school students. Hamilton Elementary School is one of the fourteen traditional elementary schools that serve kindergarten through fifth grade students in the District.

Hamilton Elementary School is located at 1300 Wabank Road, serving students on the west side of Lancaster City and Lancaster Township.

Condition of School Facilities, District-Wide

The District's facilities are in varied condition. All the District's buildings were surveyed and evaluated prior to commencing with this project to determine each facility's condition. The buildings' conditions were evaluated and rated by an architect, structural, and MEP engineer. Community input was sought, and the buildings were rated from the buildings with the highest level of need to those with less need. Through this process it was determined that Hamilton Elementary School's building, building systems, accessibility, and programmatic layout have been outlived, and the building needs replacement to meet today's academic requirements. Currently this school utilized two modular classrooms for special education instruction.

NEED FOR PROJECT

Consolidated Elementary School

Originally designed in 1963, Hamilton Elementary School has not received a comprehensive addition or renovation since 1987. The school's mechanical, plumbing, and electrical systems are outdated, and the fire alarm and life safety systems are obsolete.

The existing facility would require extensive renovations to include the installation of a sprinkler system, replacement of the heating system, installation of cooling and fresh air systems, improvement of the thermal envelope, replacement to the electrical, security and communication systems, creation of secure entry, separation of shared community and educational spaces, improved separation of parent and bus drop-off and pick-up zones, inclusion of small and large group instruction space to provide proper environments for support programs, and increased storage.

The replacement of Hamilton Elementary School will provide equity in educational program space, code compliance and building systems comparable to other recently renovated buildings in the District.

ALTERNATES CONSIDERED

Multiple options were explored with the Phase 4 District-Wide Facilities Study Update to address the needs of the District overall including:

- Option 1 Renovate remaining buildings requiring upgrade, maintaining existing grade configurations.
- Option 2 Maintain the grade structure in all schools, maintain all neighborhood schools, renovate or replace based on existing building conditions.

Following a community input process, the Board elected to proceed with Option 2 for future projects in the District which maintains grade configurations and neighborhood schools.

Based on the existing building and educational adequacy evaluation for Hamilton ES, the recommendation was made to replace the school since renovation costs would be similar to replacement. The site allows for the new school to be built on the open field area of the site and leave the existing building in use until the new one is complete. The students do not have to be displaced while construction is occurring.

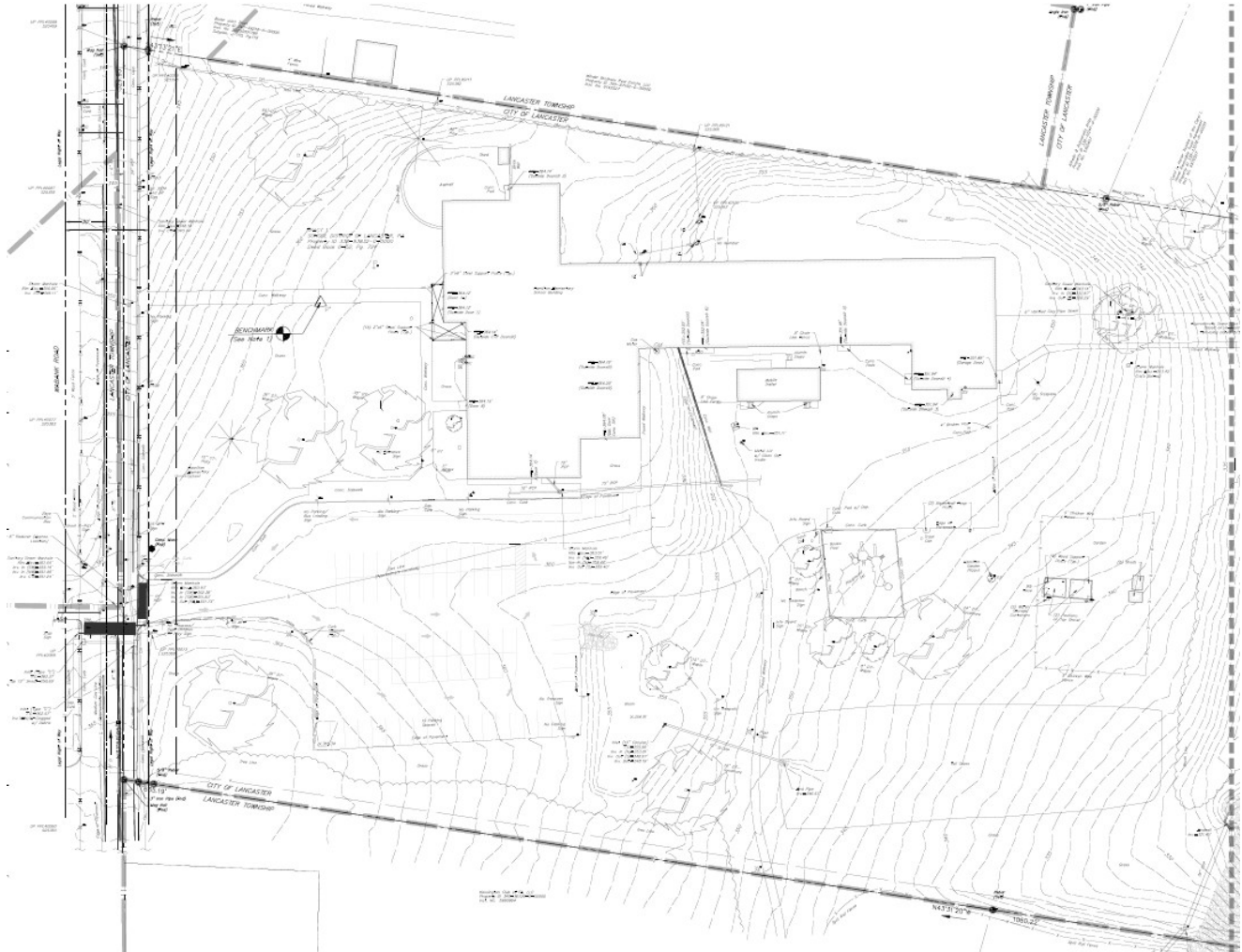
DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

The project includes the construction of a new three-story classroom wing and a one-story unified arts wing school building totaling 88,030 square feet. The school building will be constructed with steel frame construction and masonry infill walls. The exterior of the building is proposed to be masonry and metal panels to limit future maintenance. The roofs are flat to allow for rooftop mechanical equipment and the potential for solar panels. The proposed roof material is EPDM. The building design includes large exterior windows to introduce natural light into all the learning spaces within the building.

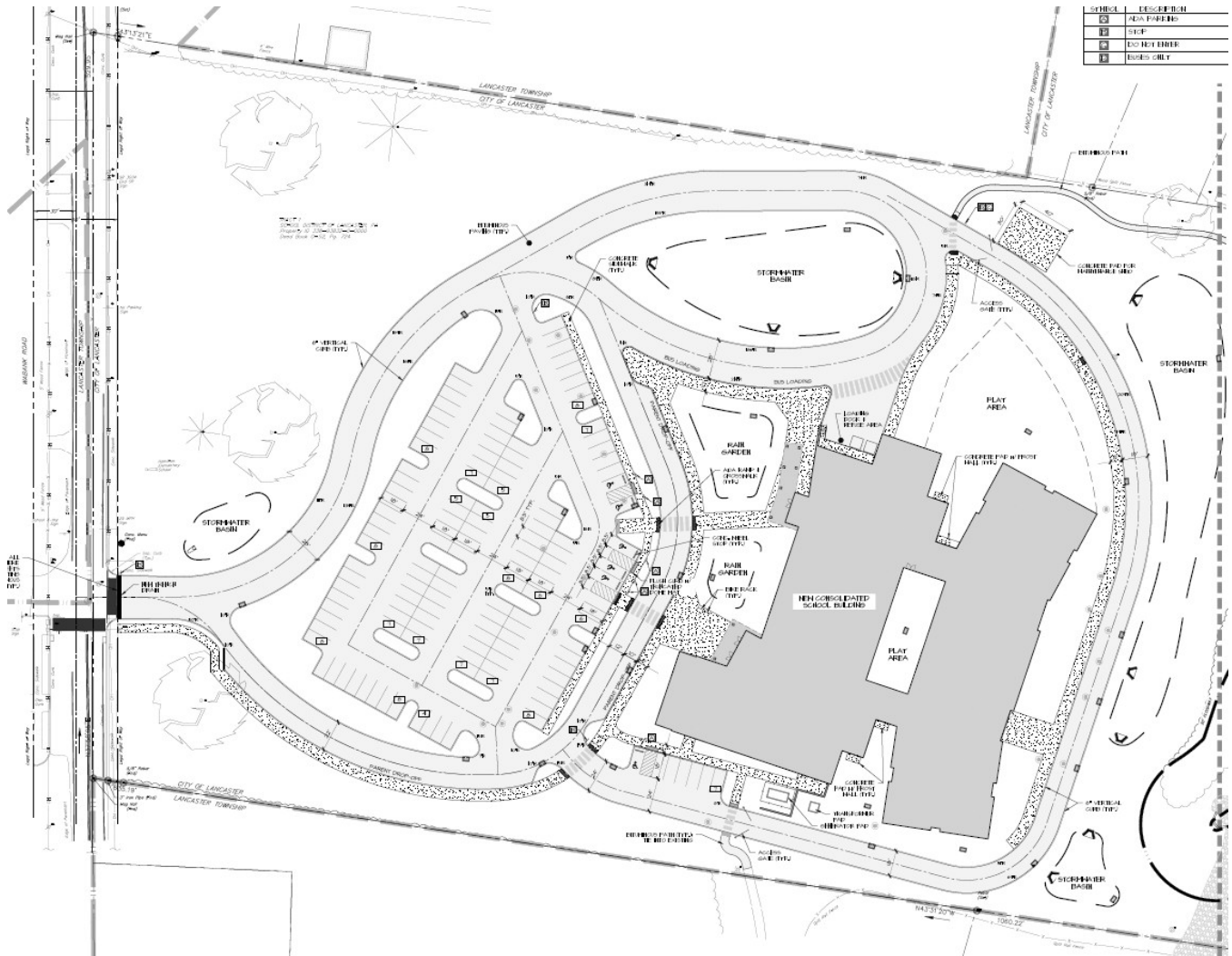
High efficiency mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems will be installed in the new building, improving energy use over the existing building, and meeting today's code requirements. The building will be fully sprinklered to meet life safety requirements.

The layout of the building clusters grade levels around shared learning spaces. These shared learning spaces are intended to serve small groups or individual learning support and promote collaborative learning. The media center is located at the center of the classroom wing as a central function. The gymnasium /auditorium, cafeteria, nurse, and administrative areas of the building are in a separate wing, allowing for off hour use for school community activities.

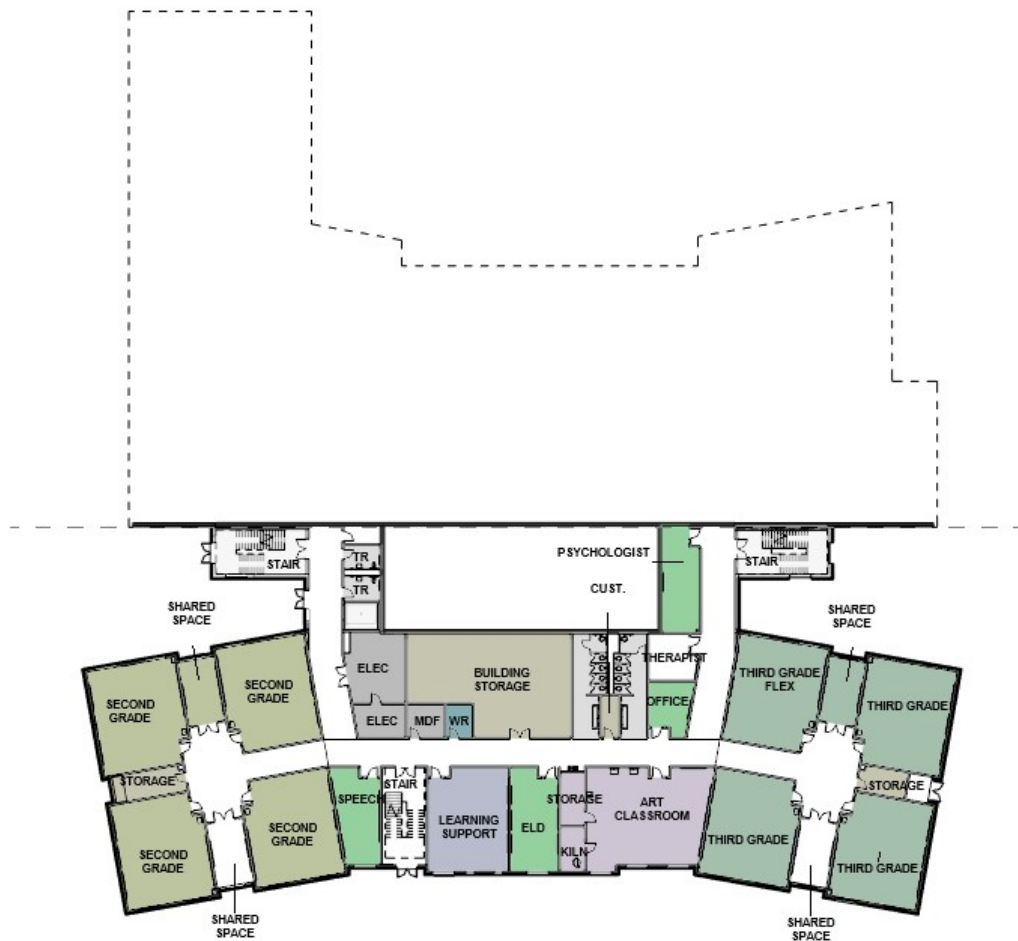
SITE PLAN - EXISTING

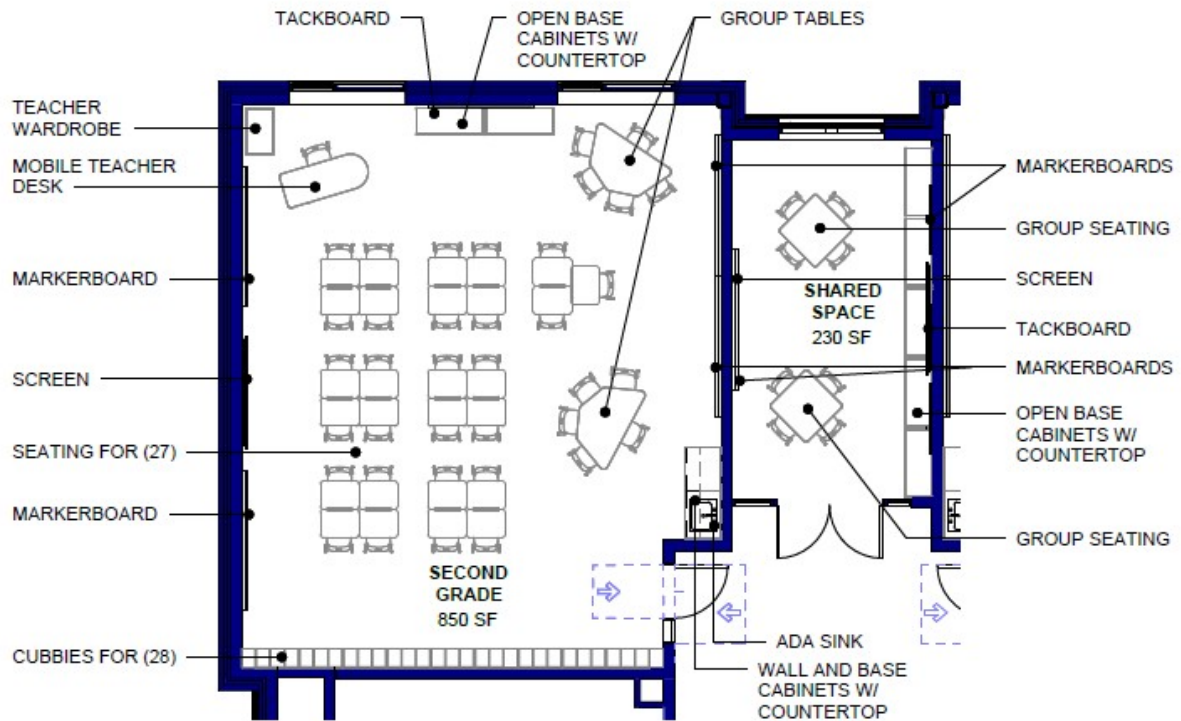


Interior Rendering of Cafeteria

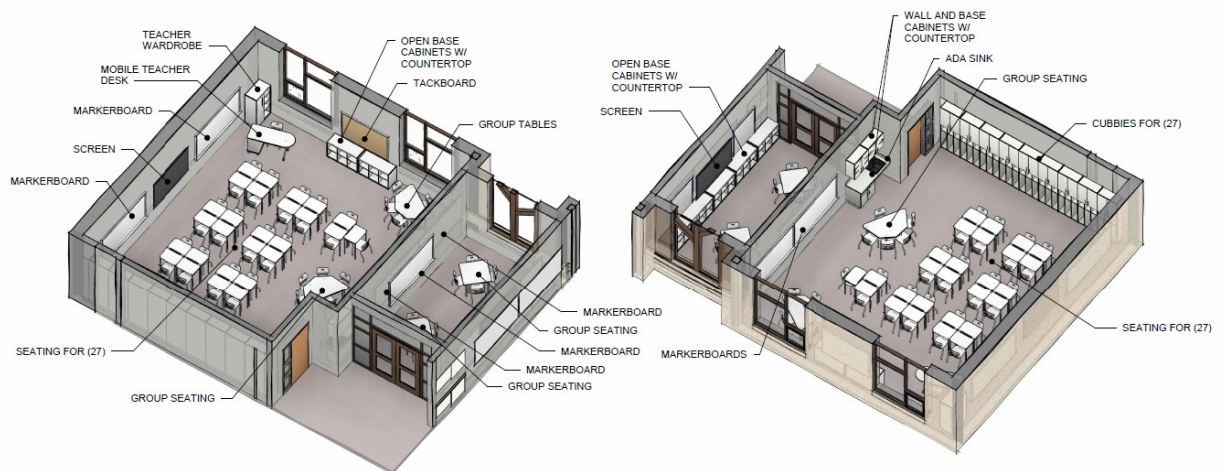


Interior Rendering of Main Lobby

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF LANCASTER**ANALYSIS OF FINANCING ALTERNATIVES**

We have analyzed four alternative methods of financing the proposed construction of the New Consolidated Elementary School (the "Project"). We also estimated the direct costs of financing as required by the Department of Education regulations issued November 4, 1978.

ANALYSIS OF ALTERNATIVES

The four alternatives of financing that we examined are:

1. Cash or a short-term loan.
2. General obligation bond issue.
3. A local authority issue.
4. A financing through the State Public School Building Authority (SPSBA).

Analysis of the School District's financial statements for recent years, and of the financing projections prepared in connection with this Project, discussions with the School District's Administration indicated that financing the entire project with cash is not feasible. The School District does not have the funds necessary to pay enough cash for its share of the Project, nor does it appear that the School District would be able to raise the required amounts from its anticipated cash flow to meet the proposed construction schedule.

We then analyzed in detail the three alternatives which would require the School District to incur long-term debt. For each alternative we estimated a bond issue size and calculated the average annual debt service requirements. We then constructed a repayment schedule taking into consideration the District's current outstanding debt. Financing costs for the local authority and SPSBA were slightly higher, which resulted in a larger bond issue and higher average annual payments. Bonds issued through either a local authority or the SPSBA would be classified as revenue bonds instead of general obligation bonds. Interest rates on revenue bonds are higher than interest rates that would be received on general obligation bonds. This would result in higher annual debt service payments for the School District. The General Obligation alternative offers the School District the advantage of lower interest rates, more favorable refunding provisions and maintains more control with the local school board. Based on these analyses and past performance, the least costly alternative for financing the Project is the General Obligation Bond Issue.

STATE REIMBURSEMENT

The District anticipates no Pennsylvania State Reimbursement for this issue due to the PlanCon moratorium that is currently in place.

DEBT SERVICE AND TOTAL MILLAGE IMPACT

Table IIA is a summary of the projected debt service and approximate millage impact anticipated by the completion of the Project. The School District is funding the Project with a portion of the proceeds generated from the Series of 2025B general obligation bond issue. Table IIB depicts the amortization schedule for the portion of the 2025B Bonds required for this Project.

It is anticipated that the required funds for the School District's share of the debt service requirements will be derived from using existing debt related mills currently in the 2026/27 budget, plus an aggregate annual general fund increase as required over the next several years as the Project is completed.

Based upon the estimated future value of 1 collected mill being \$3,686,198, a summary millage impact and debt service analysis is shown on Table IIA.

INDIRECT COSTS

To determine the indirect costs associated with this project, budgetary expenditures for contracted services, supplies, utilities, materials, transportation, and building operations were analyzed. Due to the consolidation of two aging facilities into one modern, efficiently designed school, indirect cost drivers such as maintenance, utilities, and insurance shift significantly. The non-personnel efficiencies gained from operating a single facility—combined with improved building systems, reduced custodial and grounds contract requirements, and a streamlined operational footprint—result in notable decreases across multiple indirect cost categories.

Custodial & Grounds **(\$210,000)**

Reduction of 3 Full-time custodians and ground keeping services at one facility due to consolidation.

Utilities/Fuel **(\$65,000)**

Utility costs are projected to decrease as a result of consolidating two existing buildings into a single, more efficient facility. Although the new building has a larger overall square footage, its improved building envelope and upgraded mechanical systems are expected to reduce total energy consumption compared to operating two separate structures. The estimated utility cost reflects this net reduction.

Materials, Supplies and Equipment **(\$25,000)**

A reduction is realized due to operational efficiencies associated with consolidating two schools into one facility. Teaching materials, supplies, and equipment will be consolidated from two buildings into the new building. No additional costs are anticipated unless any program changes are made and/or if significant growth in student enrollment occurs.

Building Operation & Maintenance **(\$50,000)**

A reduction is realized through the consolidation of two aging facilities into a single modern building with more efficient systems and streamlined operations. The new facility's improved infrastructure reduces overall maintenance demands and associated costs. Remaining expenses reflect routine maintenance, preventative maintenance, and custodial supplies required for ongoing building operations.

Pupil Transportation **\$56,000**

Transportation costs reflect the addition of one 72-passenger bus required to support the consolidated school configuration. However, the majority of students who currently walk will remain within the established walking zone of the combined facility, resulting in no significant increase in overall pupil transportation expenses.

Insurance Premium **(\$20,000)**

A decrease in insurance premium is realized through the consolidation of two buildings and contents into a single facility. While the new building includes additional square footage and upgraded systems, its improved construction and reduced overall risk profile result in a lower net premium requirement.
