**Recommendation**

The Board of Trustees will canvass, or review the votes cast in, the May 4, 2024 election for Trustee, Positions 2 and 6 and declare the results.

Canvassing the election is a ministerial duty of the Board as required by Texas Election Code, Chapter 67. Fort Bend County conducted the elections pursuant to the Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Services with Fort Bend ISD as required by law and approved by the Board of Trustees on March 25, 2024. Mr. John Oldham, Fort Bend County Elections Administrator, provides the certified statement of the votes cast in the trustee election held on May 4, 2024.

The canvass provides tabulation reports that will demonstrate the following results in the trustee election:

- Adam Schoof was elected as Trustee, Position 2
- Kristin Tassin was elected as Trustee, Position 6

*Note: The certified statement of votes cast, and tabulation reports are not expected from the County until the Monday of the Board meeting since the deadline to cure defective mail in ballots is 5:00pm on Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup>.*

The Board President will prepare and present Certificates of Election to the elected persons after the oath of office has been taken.
