### **Summary**

This public hearing is to comply with Chapter 38 of the Texas Education Code and Board Policy FFA Legal, this public hearing will disclose:

- All health-care services provided by the district and any expansions or changes of services, and
- Information concerning grant funds to be used – which includes VOCA grant funding,
- Administration has completed an RFP for service providers as it's been five years since the last RFP/RFQ for providers and therefore it was time to repeat the process. Therefore, the administration is seeking to “expand campus-based mental health services”, by definition in chapter 38 and will be asking the board to approve the presented mental health community partners presented in the RFP/RFQ recommendations in the Board Agenda item that is posted for the July Board Meeting to follow this public hearing.

### **Background**

Based on Chapter 38 requirements for a public hearing on changes to mental health services the Administration will provide a succinct presentation (public hearing) on the comprehensive health services available within the school district. This public hearing will include information about the health services and providers that will support whole child health and plans for supporting these services in the coming year.

To comply with Chapter 38 of the Texas Education Code and Board Policy FFA Legal, this public hearing will disclose:

- All health-care services provided by the district and any expansions or changes of services,
- Whether federal law permits or requires any health-care service provided to be kept confidential from parents,
- Whether a child's medical records will be accessible to their parent,
- Information concerning grant funds to be used – which includes the Resolution for VOCA grant funding,
- The titles of persons who will have access to the medical records of a student,
- The security measures used to protect the privacy of students' medical records, and
- The Legal and Local policies related to these requirements and services, which are FFAE and FFA.






# Mental Health Needs


