**Administrative Recommendation:**

That the Wichita Falls Independent School District Board of Trustees approve the grant as submitted by Jackie Wheat, Director of Federal and State Programs and as recommended by Michael S. Kuhrt, Superintendent of Schools.

**Explanation:**

As part of the TEA requirements for federal grants, the 21-22 Texas Education Homeless Children and Youth grant (TEHCY) must be submitted to the board and allow for comments prior to submission. The grant application states we are applying for assistance in training our staff on the recognition and identification of students experiencing homelessness; provide educational supplies and standardized dress as needed; provide weekly tutorials for students experiencing homelessness; coordinate and provide monthly educational events on topics such as math, literacy, and college readiness; in case of emergency, grant funds are budgeted to cover clothing, grocery and hygiene items; and a portion of the grant is set aside to cover the District Homeless Liaison's salary.
