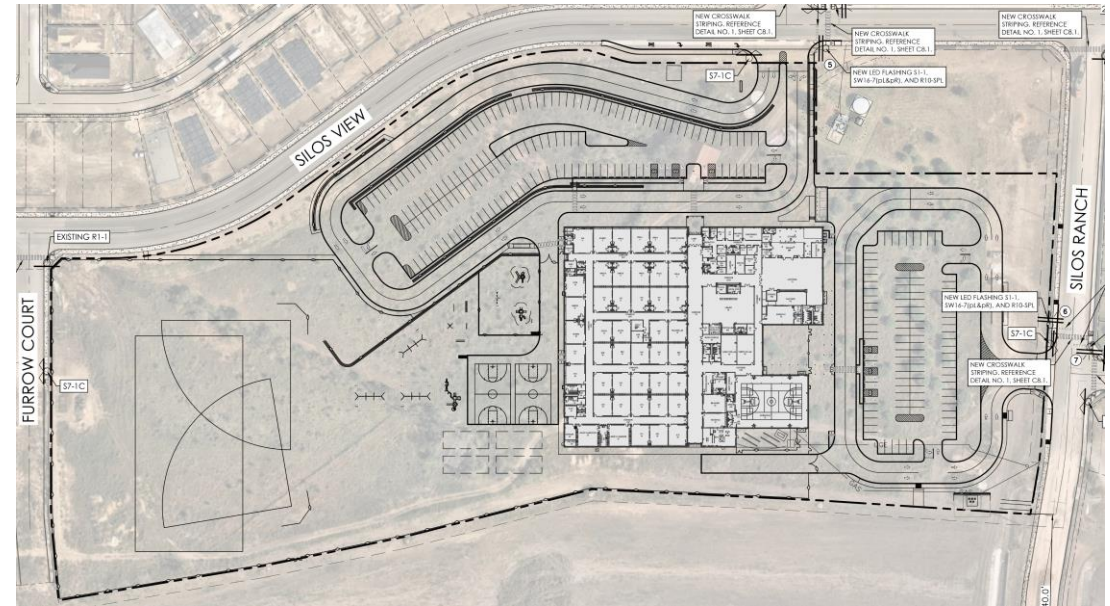

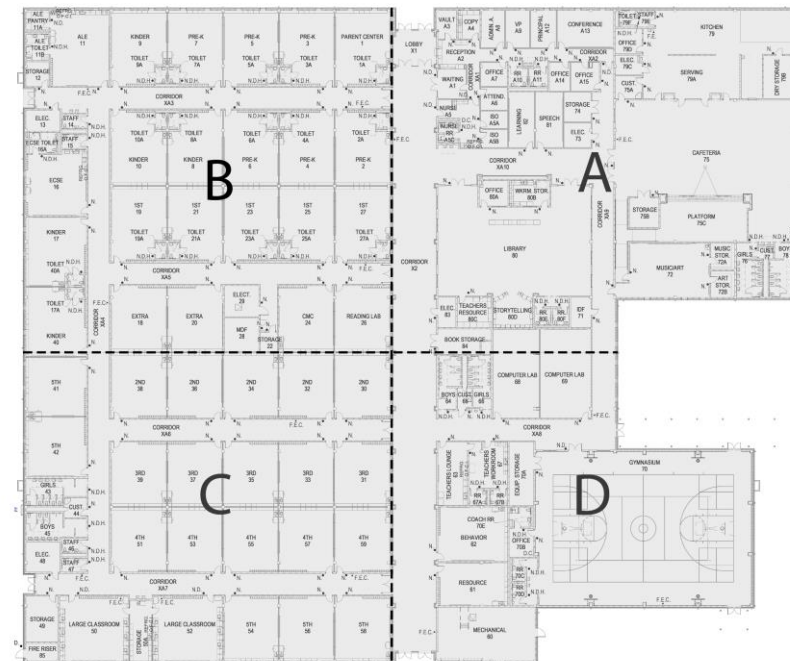

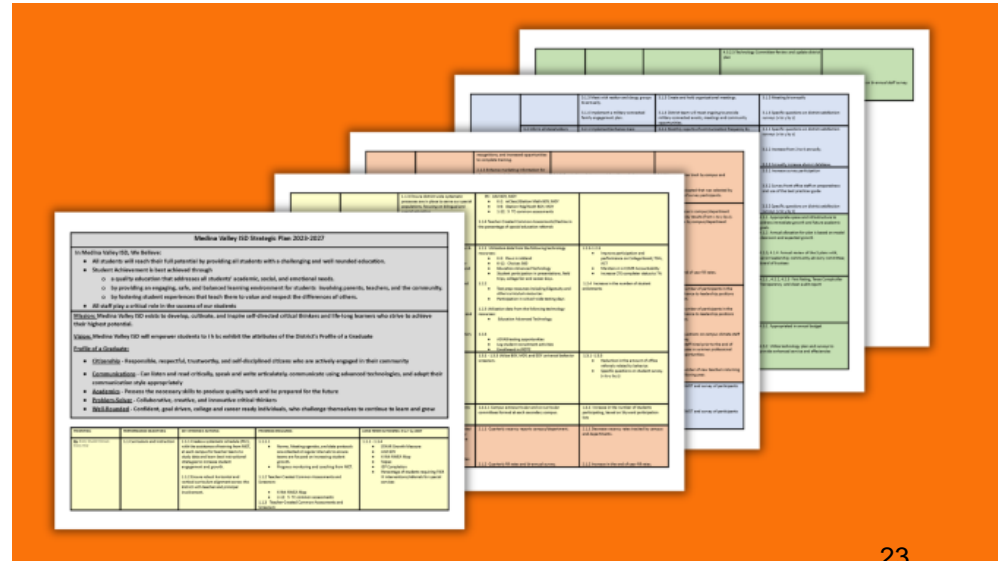

Medina Valley ISD currently serves 8,650+ students and has added more than 700 new students to our district since the end of last school year.

Over the last five years, our enrollment has increased by close to 54 percent, making us one of the fastest growing school districts in the state. District Demographic Data Termination has projected that by the 2028-29 school year, MVISD will have more than 13,000 students.

Our theme for this school year is "Let's Grow Together!" We want to continue to embrace our school district's growth, while also honoring our history.

Due to our continued growth, our 2023-24 Community Bond Advisory Committee has begun meeting and will continue to meet over the next few months to aid together a bond proposal to present to the school board for a May 2024 bond election.

 Spurring fast and steady growth, Medina Valley ISD broke ground on its second high school after opening more than six decades ago. The district held a groundbreaking ceremony November 9 on the future high school site near Portero Road and 801 County Road, District Superintendent Dr. Scott Cohen, Bartlett Coose (22) James Anderson and District Boardman Associate President Danyr Camp spoke about the special day for the district. "This is a big day for us and a big day for us to come," said Dr. Cohen. "I'm glad that this is just a very auspicious day, on top of being a very high performing school district - that's what we're all looking for these days."

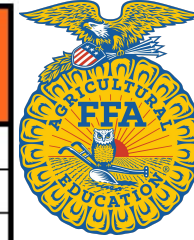
