

NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE NACOGDOCHES INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, May 15, 2023, the Board of Trustees of the Nacogdoches Independent School District will hold a Special Meeting at 12:00 PM in the Nacogdoches Independent School District Board Room located in the E.J. Campbell District Support Center Annex, 420 South Shawnee Street, Nacogdoches, Nacogdoches County, Texas. The subjects to be discussed are listed on the agenda, which is attached to and made a part of this notice.

Public comment procedures related to this meeting are as follows:

Those wishing to address the Board during public comment need to email your request or a completed request form including the agenda item number or topic by 11:00 a.m. the day of the meeting to the District at administration@nacisd.org. During the meeting, when it comes time for public comment, those that have registered will be called to the podium to comment. The time limit will be 3 minutes per person. The open portions of this meeting will be recorded and made available to the public upon request.

If during the course of the meeting covered by the notice, the Board of Trustees should determine that a closed or executive meeting or session of the Board of Trustees is required, then such closed or executive meeting or session as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Title V, Subchapter D, will be held by the Board of Trustees at the date, hour and place given in this Notice, or as soon after the commencement of the meeting covered by this Notice as the Board of Trustees may conveniently meet in such closed or executive meeting or session concerning any and all purposes permitted by the Act, including, but not limited to the following sections and purposes:

Texas Government Code Section:

1. 551.071 An executive session will be held for the purpose of having private consultation with the Board's attorney for the purpose of discussing pending or contemplated litigation or a settlement offer, where the duty of counsel to his client, pursuant to the Code of Professional Responsibility of the State Bar of Texas, clearly conflicts with the Act;
2. 551.072 Deliberation of the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in negotiations with a third person;
3. 551.073 Deliberation of a negotiated contract for a prospective gift or donation to the governmental body if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in negotiations with a third person;
4. 551.074 Deliberate the appointment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public office or employee; or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee;
5. 551.076 Deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices;

6. 551.082 Deliberate a case involving the discipline of public school child or complaint or charge brought against an employee of the School District by another employee and the complaint or charge directly results in a need for a hearing;
7. 551.0821 Deliberate a matter regarding a student or students where personally identifiable information about students will necessarily be revealed by the deliberation;
8. 551.083 Deliberate the standards, guidelines, terms or conditions the board will follow, or instruct its representatives to follow, in a consultation with a representative of an employee group;
9. 551.084 Exclusion of a witness from a hearing.

Texas Education Code Section:

§ 39.030 Discussion or adoption of individual assessment instruments or assessment instrument items and matters involving the security of the instruments in their preparation, administration and grading.

Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the School District with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action, final decision, or final vote shall be either:

- (a) In the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) At a subsequent public meeting of the School District upon notice thereof, as the School District shall determine.
