Practical Application

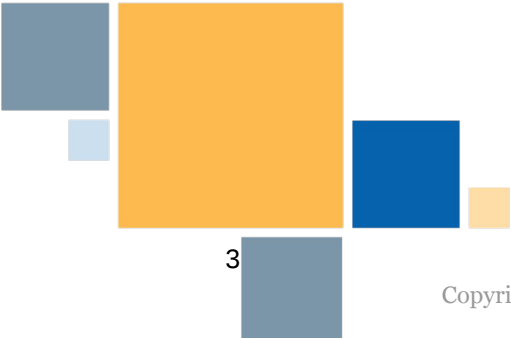

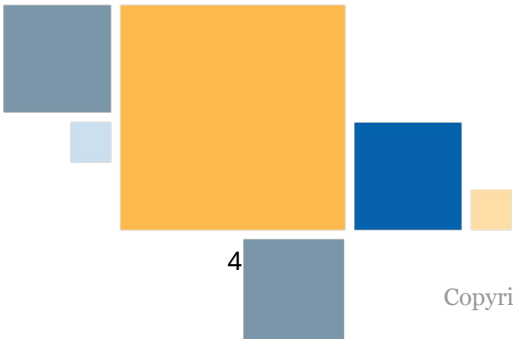

Grounded in Texas Education Code.
