MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONAL POLICIES
NON-SERVICE ANIMALS

EMG
(LOCAL)

No animals, except those used in the instructional program or used as service animals, shall be allowed in District buildings, on District premises (such as playgrounds, walkways, parking lots, and the like), or at any athletic event. This policy in no way regulates the use or presence of trained law enforcement dogs.

If a teacher or student wishes to use a live animal for instructional purposes in a District facility or on a campus, the teacher or student shall request prior approval from the principal.

The owner is responsible for any damage or injury caused by the animal. Canutillo ISD is not liable for damages caused by unauthorized animals.

For the safety of students, staff, and community members, no animals on district property (whether pets or service animals) may be approached, touched, or petted. The district assumes no liability for any injury or incident resulting from interaction with animals.

No animals, except for service animals, shall be transported on school buses.
