Key Legislative Dates

- March 17: First Chamber Work Session posting deadline
- April 4: First Chamber Deadline
- Late March - early April: Co-Chairs Budget Framework Released
- May 5: Second Chamber Work Session posting deadline
- May 17: Revenue Forecast
- May 19: Second Chamber deadline
- Late May - early June: Budget bills begin to move
- June 15: Target Sine Die
- June 25: Constitutional sine die

Advocacy Opportunities

- May 3: Final Joint Ways and Means hearing on the State budget in Salem, OR
 - In person and remote testimony accepted
 - Letters of support accepted
- Mid to late May: PTA rally
- May Joint Ways and Means hearings

PPS Bills

- **House Bill 3227: Modifications to the Custodians' Civil Service Law**
 - Public Hearing held on February 27
 - Bill voted out of House Business and Labor Committee on March 29
 - Passed the House floor on April 13
 - Now sitting in the Senate Education Committee
 - Meeting with legislators now
- **House Bill 3221: Local Option Levy limit**
 - Work session held on February 27 to move the bill to House Revenue Committee
 - Public hearing held on April 19
 - Now meeting with Revenue Committee members, ask for Board Directors to sign on to HB 3221 letter

<u>HB 2240</u>	Exempts from health care interpreter requirements individuals providing services as employees of school-based settings	Senate Education hearing held on 4.25.23
