RESOLUTION TO CONSIDER DESIGNATION AS DISTRICT OF INNOVATION

WHEREAS Education Code 12A.001 provides that a district is eligible for designation as a district of innovation if the district's most recent performance rating under Section 39.054 reflects at least acceptable performance, and that consideration of designation as a district of innovation may be initiated by a resolution adopted by the board of trustees of the district; and

WHEREAS the Rio Vista School District's most recent performance rating under Education Code 39.054 reflects at least acceptable performance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Rio Vista Independent School District by adoption of this resolution initiates the process under Education Code Chapter 12A to become a District of Innovation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after this resolution is signed by the Board, a public hearing shall be held within 30 days to consider whether the District should develop a local innovation plan for the designation of the District as a district of innovation and that within 30 days of the public hearing the Board of Trustees of Rio Vista Independent School District shall appoint an innovation plan committee to develop a local innovation plan or decline to pursue designation as a district of innovation.

Budget Process for 2022-23

At our Administrative Retreat April 24th-26th, we discussed the importance of tying purchases into our campus and district improvement plans. We brainstormed various overarching goals and narrowed them to three focal points: student engagement, climate and culture, and growth and achievement.

Meetings were held with each principal and director to plan their budgets. We wanted to plan based on a zero-based budget model, so they were asked to bring informational lists on the resources/expenses their campus or department would need to be successful. This is a different approach from before, when they were given an allotted amount. This method required additional communication with their staff so they could have a better understanding of 1-what do we have that we want to continue, 2-what do we have that we no longer need and 3-what additional items need to be purchased.

- Using grants to fund eligible purchases before we use general funds was discussed.
- Staff development/travel for training had not been expended much in the last years with COVID, this was an area that we increased for next year.
- Wish list items were discussed and some were added to the budget as a need vs a wish list, due to safety reasons or academic need.
- Elementary teachers are required to attend the Reading Academies, this is a required training and we are nearing the end of the grace period for implementation. This is an extra \$4,200. We also need to train at least one teacher in the dyslexia program, \$1,000
- Principals and directors were asked if there were any expenses we could have every other year, instead of every year.
- There was a little bit of a buffer put in each budget for incidentals that might come up.

We collectively eliminated \$103,500 by using this approach. These funds can be used for additional staff that have been added.


