

The new program – known as the Emergency Connectivity Fund Program (or ECF Program) – provides a total of \$7.17 billion in funding to specifically address remote connectivity issues for students and teachers. In doing so, the program seeks to close the homework gap by providing funding for things like Chromebooks, laptops, tablet computers, and Wi-Fi hotspots, for off-campus use by students and staff.
