551-074 Discussing personnel or to hear complaints against personnel

551-075 To confer with employees of the school district to receive information or to ask questions.

551-082 Considering discipline of a public school child, or complaint or charge against personnel

551-083 Considering the standards, guidelines, terms or conditions, the board will follow, or will instruct its representative to follow, in consultation with representatives of employee groups.

551-084 Excluding witnesses from a hearing.

Should any final action, decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the school Board with regard to any a matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action, or final vote shall be either:

(a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or

(b) at a subsequent public meeting of the School Board upon notice thereof; as the School Board shall determine
