NOTICE OF CHANGE TO MEETING FORMAT FROM THE BOARD OF EDUCATION



PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, beginning Monday, July 19, 2021 all Board of Education meetings, to include Special meetings, Regular meetings, Work Sessions and Listening Times, will now be held in-person at the district Education Service Center at 4148 Winnetka Avenue North, New Hope, MN 55427.

Board of Education members, School District staff, and members of the public who attend meetings in-person will adhere to [Robbinsdale Area Schools COVID protocols](#) including masking guidelines. The Robbinsdale Area Schools COVID protocols are created from guidance from the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). At present, MDH and the CDC strongly recommends that all people present in school buildings and district offices wear a face covering, and that anyone who is not fully vaccinated continue to wear face coverings indoors in businesses, public settings, and when around people from other households, as well as outdoors when social distancing cannot be maintained. The face covering recommendation does not apply to those who are unable to tolerate wearing a face covering because of a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability.

Because all Board meetings are now in person and available for the public to attend, they will no longer be live streamed online. However, recordings will continue to be available through the [School Board](#) page on the district website under “Learn More,” then “Watch School Board Meeting Webcasts.”
