Whereas, Minnesota Statute 124D.03 provides that a board of education may, by resolution, limit the enrollment of nonresident pupils in its schools or programs to a number not less than one percent of the total enrollment at each grade level in the district, and

Whereas, Robbinsdale Area Schools enrolls the number of non resident students that meet or exceed one percent of the total enrollment at each grade level in the district,

Now, therefore, it resolved that the superintendent or designee may close a grade, building or program for nonresident students as necessary due to space limitations.

Now, be it further resolved that the superintendent or designee may also limit the nonresident elementary enrollment so that 22-23 class sizes remain within the following range.

Call to Order and Roll Call of the Business Meeting

Chair Bassett called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. Directors present: Helen Bassett, Sharon Brooks Green, Greta Evans-Becker, Mike Herring, Sam Sant, and John Vento; and David Engstrom, Superintendent. Director(s) absent: David Boone. There was a quorum; meeting was called to order.

Acceptance of the Organizational Meeting Agenda

MOTION: Director Sant moved approval of the agenda and Director Vento seconded the motion. Upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor thereof: Directors Bassett, Brooks Green, Evans-Becker, Herring, Sant, and Vento. And the following voted against the same: none. Motion passed.

School Board Chair's Special Report

Chair Bassett gave a special report regarding the professional development the Board has participated in over the past couple of years, based on best practices in school board governance - promoted by the Minnesota School Board Association (MSBA).

Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Engstrom spoke about the recent shooting at an Intermediate District 287 school, grateful that none of our students were there at the time - and our thoughts are with all involved. Our communications team offered crisis communications assistance in the wake of this event. Director Sant provided information about a GoFundMe page to help the family of Jamari Rice, the student killed in this incident - as well as funeral information.

Assistant Superintendent Voight provided a COVID health and safety update, noting a significant decline in positive cases. District has received and ordered a large supply of KN95 masks for distribution to staff, and rapid test kits available in nurses offices at the schools. Vault tests are also available. Three test sites will be available soon for students in the district at Armstrong High School, Robbinsdale Spanish Immersion School and Northport Elementary.

Amy O'Hern, Executive Director of Human Resources, said staff absence numbers are trending down and substitute fill rates are trending up since the return from distance learning. She reported that 89% of our staff are fully vaccinated now, and buildings are working to get the rest to either vaccinate, test weekly or provide documentation for religious exemption.

Jeff Connell, Executive Director of Facilities, Operations and Transportation, reported that the transportation team is still recruiting bus drivers, and we continue to use the contracted vendors for some routes and activities. The biggest struggle now has been driver absenteeism.

Superintendent Engstrom closed his report talking about Black History Month, and is pleased that our district is always committed to doing better in regard to equitable learning experiences for all students.

Nice to speak with you today, thanks for the quick follow-up note.

The intent was to have the roofing work scope 07-H furnish the structural steel and metal fabrications per section 05 5000 as it applies to the work on the roof. Keynote 1 on the roofing drawings (example A6.00B) calls out the new stairs. Work scope 07H calls for roof specialties, including access ladders to be furnished and installed.

I understand where there could be some misunderstanding between the phrases access ladders and stairs. We would not be able to accept a modification to your bid to add for the omitted work. We were able to confirm the second low bidder did include the stairs as a part of their metals package. Our recommendation would be to allow Palmer West to drop their bid without penalty.

This will go before the Board as a part of the award letter for their 2/22/2022 meeting.
