Start Times Recap

- The Board engaged in a comprehensive process to explore the benefits of changing school start times since the 2017-2018 school year.
 - The goal was to shift high schools to a later start time while minimizing additional transportation costs.
 - Through a bell time analysis, seven possible schedules were brought forward to the Board during the 2019-2020 school year.
 - In December 2020, the Board voted to change school start times, but did not determine when the change would happen.
 - The Board voted on April 19, 2021 to implement the change of school start times for the 2022-2023 school year.

 - Middle school students playing high school sports will not be released early for practice. They will be permitted to leave early on game days (as needed).
 - As of now, activity routes are scheduled to pick up at 5:30 p.m. for middle school and 5:45 p.m. for high schools.

Things to note

- **Coaching:**
 - There will be a significant impact to our current middle school coaching staff for the 2022-23 school year.
 - We have not seen any measurable impact to the high school coaching staff as result of bell-time changes.
- **Transportation:**
 - Due to supply chain issues; new activity vans have been difficult to order..
 - Some coaches have expressed interest in receiving their CDL to provide back-up transportation for activities.




