A group of Armstrong High School students competed in the [Young Economic Summit \(YES\) competition](#) September 19-21, 2022 in Germany.

Seniors Rachel Olson, Natalie Storlie, and Carly and Grant Redelsheimer make up one of three U.S. teams that received an all-expenses paid trip to Hamburg, Germany, for the YES competition. The Armstrong team was selected to participate last spring based on their research about economic incentives to improve public policy responses to future pandemics.

On September 20, the group presented on their topic ([learn more](#)), and defended it by answering questions from experts, including the head of tax policy for the German Ministry of Finance.

The students collaborated with experts from German universities and research organizations to develop solutions to their chosen issue. They competed against teams from the United States, Germany, and the United Kingdom.

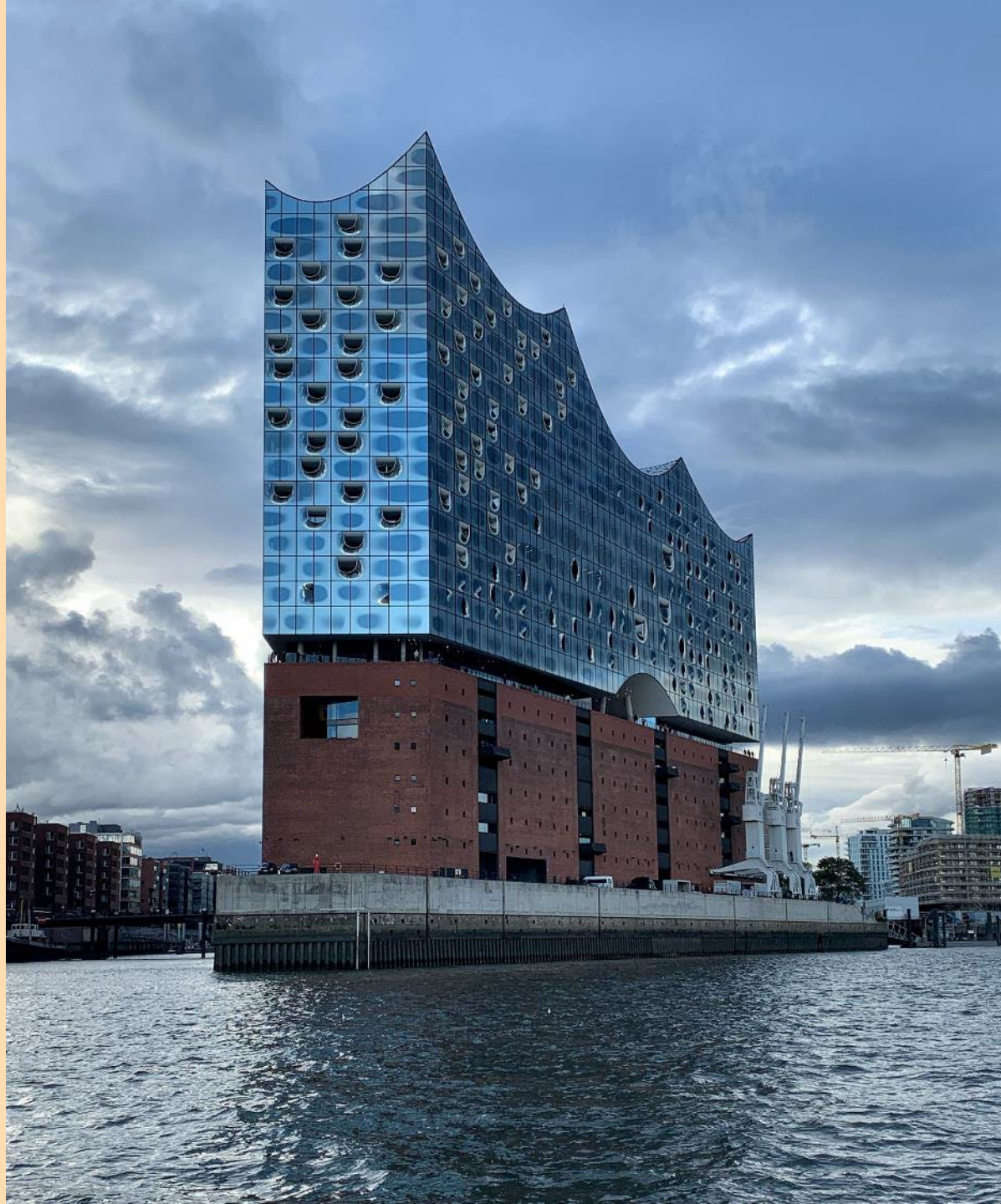

**Description:**

Anthony Williams will request approval of a resolution to support the Form A Grant Application to the Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) Foundation. Foundation grants support Minnesota’s high school youth and help to offset costs for students who qualify for reduced activity fees.

Student activity data gathered from the 2021-2022 school year in response to the application showed 240 students from Armstrong High School and 372 students from Cooper High School received free/reduced lunch benefits resulting in reduced activity fees. The total counts represent an unduplicated number of students who participated in high school activities.

The MSHSL Foundation is a nonprofit association. The Foundation awards grants to assist, recognize, promote, and fund extra-curricular participation by high school students in athletic and fine arts programs. Grants are awarded based upon gender balance, school size, and geographic location to the extent possible.

**Recommended Action:**

It is recommended that the School Board of the District approves the resolution to support the Form A Grant Application to the MSHSL Foundation.



## Facility Grant – Resolution of the School Board, Robbinsdale Area Schools

WHEREAS, the Hennepin County Board of Commissioners, via the Hennepin Youth Sports Program, provides for capital funds to assist local government units of Hennepin County for the development of sports or recreational facilities, and

WHEREAS, Robbinsdale Area Schools (local government unit, hereinafter LGU) desires to develop a number of athletic facilities at Cooper and Armstrong High Schools (hereinafter PROJECT).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ROBBINSDALE AREA SCHOOLS (authorizing entity) of the LGU:

I. The estimate of the total cost of developing PROJECT shall be approximately \$375,000. The LGU is requesting \$300,000 from the Hennepin Youth Sports Program and will assume responsibility for providing matching funds of approximately \$75,000.

II. Robbinsdale Area Schools (LGU or other entity as allowed by LGU) is the owner of the property where the PROJECT is located. Robbinsdale Area Schools will own the property where PROJECT is located for at least the functional life of the facility, which is estimated to be a minimum of 20 years. The PROJECT may not be converted to a non-public or non-recreational uses within this time period without the approval of Hennepin County.

III. Robbinsdale Area Schools (LGU or other entity as allowed by LGU) agrees to assume one hundred (100) percent of operational and maintenance costs for PROJECT. Robbinsdale Area Schools (same entity) will operate PROJECT for its intended purpose as stated in the PROJECT application for the functional life of the facility.

IV. LGU agrees to enter into necessary and required agreements with Hennepin County for the specific purpose of developing PROJECT and managing its long-term operation.

V. That Ukee Dozier, Executive Director of Finance, is authorized and directed to execute the application for the Hennepin Youth Sports Program grant.
