Current Performance of Durham:

- All routes are running and have been consistently even with the flu, Covid, and absenteeism. Backup drivers are available and being used on a daily basis.
- All athletics, activities, and field trips have been covered since the school year started..
- Special Ed bus drivers are being added as drivers pass their license exams.
- Summer transportation for 2022 was fully covered.

To resolve past liquidated damages for missing routes in the 2021-2022 school year and establishing bus route rates based on the revised transportation system that we are using at Robbinsdale Area Schools in a new 2 year contract with Durham Transportation Services we are recommending the following:

1. Agree to settlement:
 - Payment of \$652,058.82 in whatever form the District would prefer (cash/offsets/other)
 - Set rate of \$391.25 per general education route per day (32.8% increase from current rates) retroactive to August 1, 2022 for the 2022-2023 school year
 - Set rate of \$437.00 per general education route per day (11.7% increase from 2022-2023 rates) for the 2023-2024 school year
2. Agree to the contract extensions and new rates for this school year and the 2023-2024 school year
3. Both documents will be ready for signature and final approval on January 24th, 2023 at the Board Meeting

These are the areas that Durham is allocating the additional revenue to in order to ensure that Robbinsdale Area Schools is fully operational.

This would also include a \$2 per hour increase for Durham bus drivers and monitors for the 2023-2024 school year, above and beyond the increases listed here which are currently in place.

 - 50 Sign-Ons @ \$5,000
- Retention Bonus:
 - 55 Drivers @ \$2,500
 - 15 Monitors @ \$2,500
- 7-Hour Guarantee
 - All drivers and monitors that work an AM shift and a PM shift shall be guaranteed 7-hours
- Training Pay
 - All candidates in training, once hired with permits, will receive their full standard driver or monitor pay rate for training
 - Drivers receive a \$500 bonus for taking CDL prep class with us and obtain their CDL Permits successfully
- Removed one MX Tech
 - Used MX Tech wages to add a Full-Time Recruiter
- Every Driver Wage Scale Step receiving a \$5.49 raise
 - Current: \$20.51-\$25.00
 - New: \$26.00-\$30.49
- Every Monitor Wage Scale Step receiving a \$2.31 raise
 - Current Start: \$14.69
 - New Start: \$17.00




