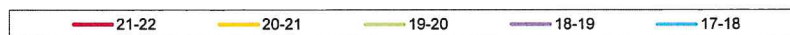

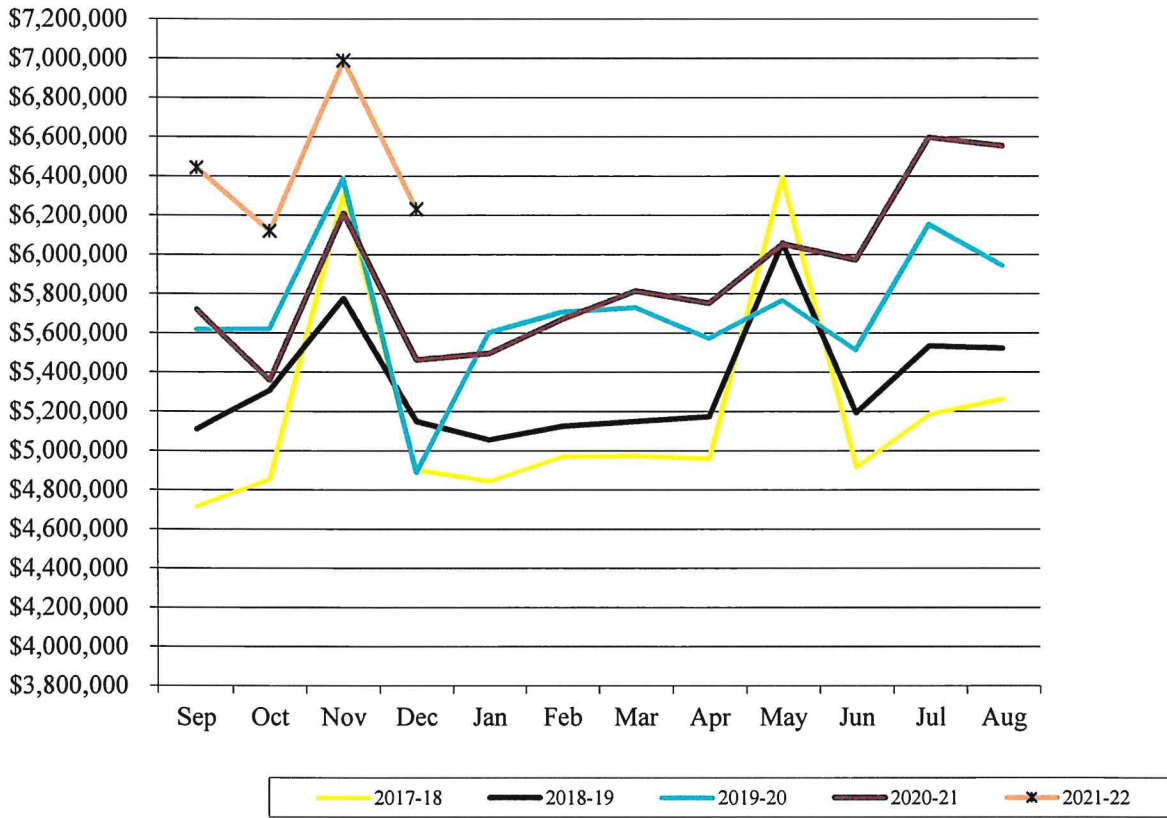

IV. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mr. Rindal moved and Mrs. Ladderud seconded approval of the agenda as presented. Mrs. Ladderud moved to amend the agenda by adding ACTION ITEM Michael & Susan Dell Foundation Grant Application; Mr. Rindal seconded the motion; the motion carried unanimously.

Student Representative Report: Walla Walla High School Student Representative Ms. Rachel Clark was unable to attend this month.

Board of Directors Report: The Board members shared of events and activities in which they participated or attended since the last Board meeting, reminding community members there are many sports and music events taking place at the high school, where attendance is free.

Superintendent's Report: Dr. Smith conveyed how proud he was of the students for attending and addressing the board during the public comment period of the board meeting, noted updates have been made to procedures for library materials review, provided a bond project update and noted December enrollment is 5506 FTE.

Monthly Financial Dashboard Report: Mrs. Taylor provided a review of revenues, expenditures and ending fund balance.

Summer SOL Data Review and Discussion: Dr. Smith and Mr. Cummings reviewed the 2021 Summer Sol program, which served 1519 students and was offered twice during the summer in two, four-week blocks at all school buildings. Mr. Cummings will return for a future board meeting update with detailed recommendations for Summer Sol 2022.

Student Recovery Plan Update: Dr. Smith provided a student recovery plan update, including the activities and supports for district students and a review of funding resources.

- Building 3 (Commons), Kitchen equipment is being attached to plumbing, gas and electric and being set up for use. Finishes in the kitchen area are nearing completion, with flooring in the serving area being prepped for install. Storefront doors, overhead doors and other windows installation continued. Commons area lighting and flooring completes as was the large fan. The logo was applied to the upper wall. A TCO was obtained for the commons portion only for use by the school for the students to have spaces to be outside the weather. Finishes in the student store were worked on and cabinets were on site to be installed. HVAC in the area ready for testing and balancing and to be started and used on a permanent basis. Loading dock was installed with the backup generator in place and ready for startup.
- Building 5, North area underground plumbing installed and inspected, backfilled and ready for concrete pour back, shoring in place for structural work that is to be done overhead to proceed after pour back is complete. West area framing ongoing with demo of stair to the mezzanine being accomplished, electrical rough in on going as is the framing and masonry repairs to set the new windows in place. East area framing continuing, insulation being installed and rough in of HVAC, electrical and plumbing, prep and framing for the installation of windows and windows began to be installed, all prep for drywall installation. South dry wall installation with mudding and taping on going, restrooms prepped for finished, windows began to be installed. Throughout the building at various openings new masonry was placed. Temp heating was put in place. Mezzanine work continued with HVAC, electrical and plumbing work along with framing especially in the north area. Courtyard eaves were cut back and roofing work continued.
- Building 7 (Auditorium) HVAC installation on going, acoustic insulation installed in the black box ,door frame into the hallway from the black box was installed, interior framing ongoing in the green room, preparations for the new HVAC unit above the ticket booth ongoing in this area, underground work in the hallways, Theater grid was coordinated with the fire sprinkler system.
- Building 6 (Fitness area) The Exterior siding was worked on. The new main entry work continued to prepare it for painting, bollard locations were cut and prepped for completion when the weather allows, doorway was cut in the wrestling room and work is beginning on the former main entry.
- The court yard between buildings 3,4 and 6 were graded and initial concrete slabs were poured in the area, the ramps and stairways tied in from building 4 to the lower courtyard near the seat wall.
- Building 1 (Vo Ag) boiler replacement work began, temporary heating was put into place, abatement of the flooring in the halls, classrooms, staff rooms and other areas was complete.
- The design team worked with Jackson to complete and return submittals and answer construction question as they arose in order to facilitate that the project continues to be able to keep up with the schedule.
- Across the site, Jackson continued to move fences and provide pathways to ensure campus and student safety.
- Wenaha, Jackson, and the School district worked on coordinating efforts to ensure the upcoming phases can be initiated while also accommodating staff and moving activities for next remodel/update activities.

- Main entry walk-off carpet went in. Access controls and trophy case in process to finish early January.
- West existing and new classrooms teachers were able to move in over break and begin school in their new classrooms January 3rd.
- Music and CTE also saw the new Wenger music storage installed and staff move in for the new year.
- Kitchen is nearly complete with final finishes and inspections in early January.
- Commons new projector and screen were installed, and lunch tables moved in for lunch to be served when students came back January 3rd.
- Aux gym wood flooring completed, and bleachers installed.
- Main Gym also had wood flooring completed and bleachers installed. Staff moved into new locker room offices over the holiday break.
- Administration area saw final finishes and staff move in over the break.
- Site work this month has been limited due to weather. Concrete steps and sidewalks were installed. While the new asphalt path for student access went in at the West side from the current student drop off area.
- Pioneer team is working on final finishes still due to weather delays and supply chain. Still pending is glass to go in balance of doors and windows and siding arriving for install in January.
- Area 6 Science and Art has kicked off with demolition. Work will continue with safety fencing and barrier walls allowing Jackson to finish the interior phase for a summer move into this area.

Lincoln

- CMU block work began at Black box theatre but was delayed finishing due to weather.
- Interior of existing building saw electrical, mechanical and fire sprinkler rough in on all levels.
- Ceiling areas, new insulation began on the third floor.
- Structural work finished up on East side of existing building at all three levels. New walls began to be framed for new restrooms and staff breakroom on the third level, and a new classroom will be framed on the second level in this area.
- A new access ramp to upper west classrooms began to be framed and other framing continued throughout the building.
- The new fitness area saw preparations for structural columns to be installed in January, and the clay art at gym entrance had a protective barrier installed to keep it intact during construction.
- WWPS, Wenaha, Architects West and Chervenell continue to work together coordinating the Lincoln remodel and any challenges that come up. The team effort has allowed for the project to move along and stay on schedule.

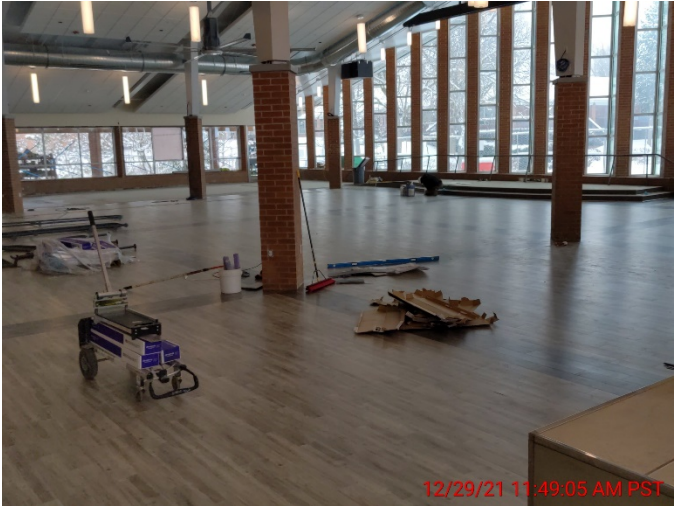

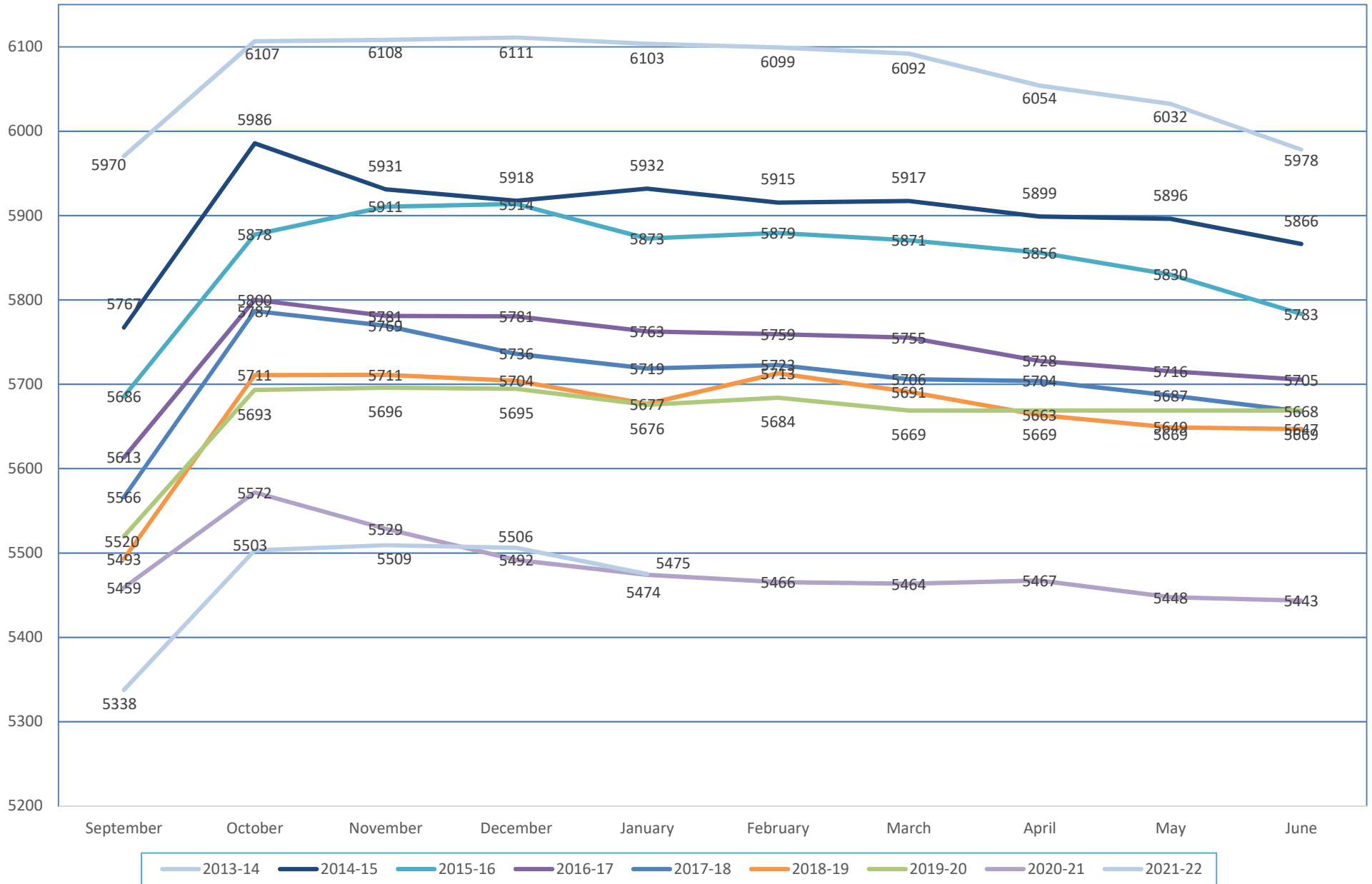
