Public Comment

Al Chops Ciancisetti – 198 Crown Street – Addressed the Board regarding erecting a flag pole near the Bristol Eastern football field, for a soldier who fought in Afghanistan and lost a leg. Mr. Ciancisetti will need to attend an Operations Committee Meeting for further discussion of this request. He also wanted to express his disapproval of privatization.

Sharon Peterson – 72 Kimberly Lane – Addressed the Board regarding the café. She is here this evening as Cafeteria Worker and tax payer. She is disappointed that they would privatize and allow the tax payer to pick up the bill for arbitration. She has been here for 20 years and she devastated that this decision would have been made so lightly. There are cost savings ideas that have been discussed, but they have not been brought to them. No one has considered that in the past 8 years, no increase has been made to the a-la-cart items. There are menu changes that the students would like to see, they are tired with the menu, so they would rather not eat. The price of breakfast is still 1.25 it has not been increased. She is asking that they reconsider this plan of giving it to company that has no ties to Bristol.

Tracy Beland – 33 Fall Mountain Rd – Addressed the Board regarding the café. She is here this evening as a taxpayer and Cafe lead at BEHS. The faces you see here are the faces that are dedicated and loyal, they are faces of those adopt children in need, that support the United Way. These are the women of the town of the children we are serving. These faces support your local business that run this city. Do not continue to make this a political circus. No one would want this; end this now. Stop making a mockery of the BOE and food services. The blogs that are untrue and hurtful, one comment said “illegal immigrants and high school drops could do this job” it is appalling that we are being thought of in such a manner. Let us be a part of the community. Put a stop to this.

Chad Lockhart – Addressed the Board regarding the café. He came before the Board as a union representative, taxpayer, father, and business owner. He does not believe that this should continue that the arbitration should be ended. He urged someone to take a stand and take a revote.

Arlene Capirchio – 55 Sheila Court – Addressed the Board regarding Common Core. She presented a book written by Holly Swanson, titled Training for Treason – The Harmful Agenda Behind Education for Sustainability. She read the back of book and encouraged everyone to try to stop this from coming into the schools.

Old Business

Commissioner Dolan addressed the audience regarding the decision to privatize the cafeteria. He stated that the decision was not personal and that it came down to money. He read a statement from the majority members of the Board regarding their position.

Commissioner Amara spoke about being good stewards of the city's money and proper use of money to properly educate our students.

Commissioner Fitzgerald addressed the audience about the cafeteria decision not being personal.

There was ongoing discussion from the Board and the audience regarding the privatization decision.

Commissioner O'Brien noted that Roberts Rules requires that a member of majority would need to make a motion to reconsider this matter. He also addressed an open letter from Councilman Cockayne that he found offensive, demeaning, condescending and erroneous; he thinks everyone should read it because it is a reflection of the type of leadership he would provide if he were elected.

Commissioner Vibert continued on Mr. O'Brien's topic and stated that some commissioners did respond to the letter that was written by Councilman Cockayne.

Superintendent's Report
Bristol Board of Education Meeting

District Leadership Cohort I: The first of four sessions was held on Tuesday October 29th. Twenty-three staff members attended. The focus of the Leadership Cohort is to develop an in-district pool of leader candidates.

2014-15 Budget: The budget development process and expectations have been reviewed with all department supervisors, school and central office administrators. The Superintendent will begin a detailed review of all budget submissions in early December.

2013 CABE/CAPSS Conference: the conference is scheduled for Friday and Saturday November 15th and 16th. Two Bristol Central students and two Bristol Eastern students have been invited to attend the Saturday conference sessions this year and will report back to the board at a later date.

Full Day Kindergarten (FDK) Update: The FDK Committee met on Monday October 28th and Monday November 4th. Meeting outcomes include a review of FDK survey responses, (<https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/HH7YJBY>) pursuit of current research (2007 to present), and the scheduling of two Community Information Sessions in November as follows: **Monday 11.12 at 7:00 PM Bristol Eastern Auditorium and Monday 11.25 at 7:00 PM Bristol Central Auditorium.** The Committee is scheduled to meet later this month to review a first draft of the FDK program proposal.

Annual New England Multi-Cultural Conference: The Superintendent attended the annual conference held at Central Connecticut State University on Wednesday October 16th. Information was provided regarding recruitment of multi-cultural certified staff in Connecticut urban districts.

October CAPT Scholars Recognition: Breakfasts were held at each of the high schools in honor of those students who scored highest (4-5) on the 2013 CAPT. Congratulations to all of these dedicated students and their families on this notable achievement.

CT Teacher of the Year Recognition: Corey Nagle, Bristol Teacher of the Year will be honored as a semi-finalist at the annual state reception and ceremony to be held at the Bushnell Theater on Tuesday 11.19.

Professional Development (11.5): The SBAC Pilot test was administered electronically to staff across the district. Feedback data will be collected and used to improve the SBAC student administration in early spring. In addition, Common Core implementation, school improvement planning and a continued K-12 focus on Literacy were also addressed.
