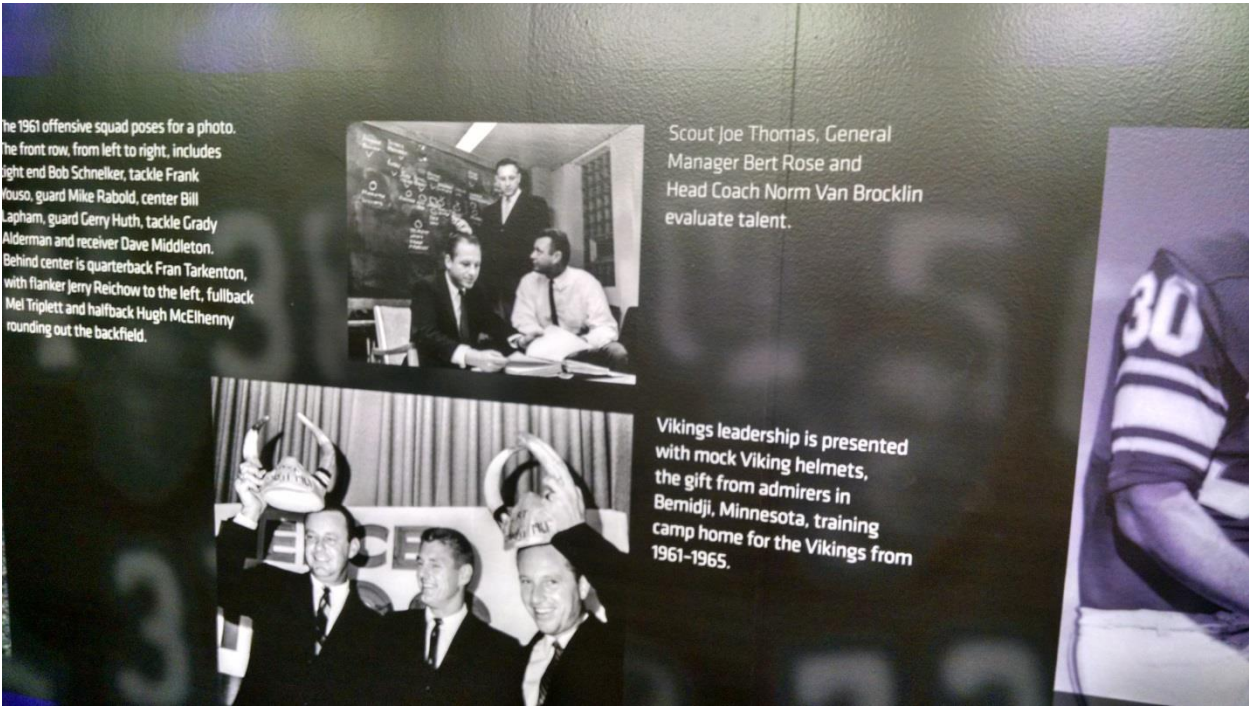
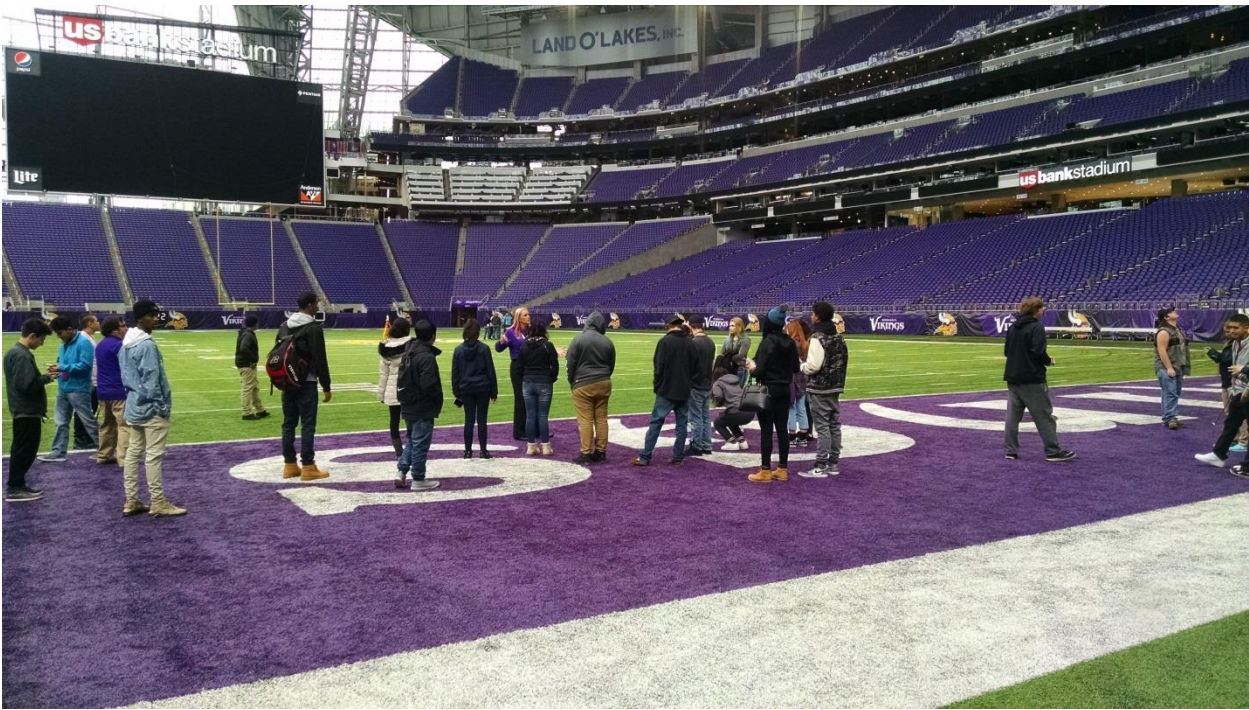

Special Education
January 2, 2018

- With a grant from the Minnesota Department of Education, using federal funding CFDA 84.027A, Special Education – Grants to States, three Community Participation Days are sponsored by Regional Low Incidence Projects – Region 11 and offered to students in the metro area. On December 7, 2017, Sheri Frisque, Teacher of the Blind/Visually Impaired and Sarah Johnson, Certified Orientation and Mobility Instructor brought eight high school students from our 917 member districts and joined an additional 16 students from the metro area to attend the **Community Participation Day for High School Students with Visual Impairments**. The students enjoyed a day of bowling, senior recognition, and pizza at Memory Lanes in Minneapolis. All students were required to complete pre and post tests on the rules and terminology of bowling and received prizes, of course! This annual event is always an exciting opportunity to (re)connect with other students with visual impairments from the area. Students swap ideas and tech tips that they find beneficial and just hang out. The next **Community Participation Day for Elementary School Students with Visual Impairments will be February 1, 2017**. This event will be a Felted Geos Activity at the Textile Center in Minneapolis.
- The students in Melinda Vancamp’s class at the Youth Transition Program (YTP) had the opportunity to grow their own crystals. This hands-on experience helped them to engage in learning the properties of minerals in the minerals and rocks unit of study. Students learned that minerals are defined/identified by their properties and by how they are formed. This includes: forming from inorganic processes, having a chemical structure and crystal composition. The purpose for doing the crystal growing project with students was to show them how crystal structures form as crystals then go on to form minerals. It was a two-week project and students had the opportunity to grow, observe and monitor their own crystal forming. Students surpassed expectations with their patience and curiosity. The students loved the project and were excited to see their crystals grow each day and with the end result. Their crystals ultimately came out unique and beautiful.



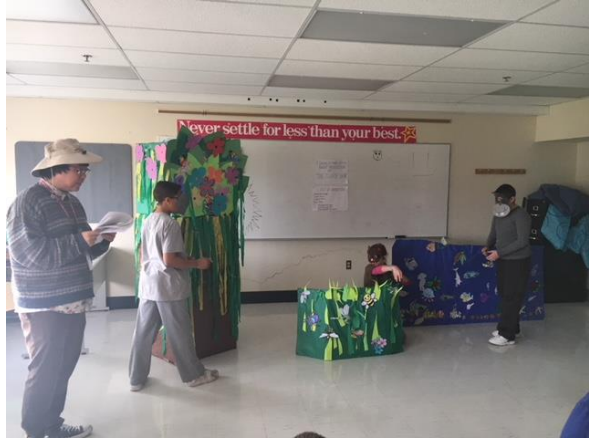
- On December 8, 2017 students in our program at Alliance Education Center invited parents and guardians in to decorate winter cookies and enjoy hot chocolate together. The kids were so excited to share this experience with loved ones and their trusted school staff.
- The student council at AEC has started up a superstar student program where students will be recognized for great acts of kindness throughout the school such as being helpful, positive, and being safe to everyone around them. Students chosen will be awarded with a special lunch treat throughout the month. Students also continue to take part in community outreach projects such as feed my starving children and volunteering with our younger students in the building.
- Alliance Education Center has 35 students/families who utilize our mobile pantry program. Each student is able to "shop" on a mobile bus that comes to the school twice a month and provides both perishable and non-perishable items. The students have a blast picking out food for their families and get sent home with three to four bags full of food.
- The "6th Annual TESA Holiday Showcase" held on Friday December 15th in the Dakota Room and it was a resounding success. The event gave students the opportunity to display a variety of classroom projects, accomplishments and community service projects, as well as group and individual talents. Many families and several board members attended this event. There was great deal enthusiasm of the part of students, staff and members of the audience. Students and families were able to socialize and enjoy holiday treats upon after the successful event.
- Earlier this month the 40 & 8 Club, also known as **La Societe des Quarante Hommes at Huit Chevaux**, made a \$2500 donation to the TESA Program to be used for the Spring Formal. This generous donation is \$1000 more than previous donations. For over 30 plus years, the 40 & 8 Club has been donating to the ISD 917 TESA Program for special programming events. The 40 & 8 have a tradition of promoting the well-being of veterans, widows and their children, and actively participate in selected charitable endeavors including programs that promote child welfare. The ISD 917 TESA Program has continues to be honored by this gracious club.
- During December, Brenda Szoka's Cedar SUN class collected donations of small toys, school supplies, music instruments, clothing and personal items. The students then sorted the items by age and sex. The class also wrote personalize letters and decorated the outside of the shoe boxes. The class was able to make seven boxes. These boxes were then donated to Operation Christmas Child. This organization delivers these gift shoe boxes to children ages 2-14 in need all across the globe. Last year the shoe boxes we made went to Madagascar.

On Friday, December 8th, Brenda's class volunteered at Operation Christmas Child's processing center in Lakeville. The team of five students and five staff worked together as a team on an assembly line. They inspected the shoe boxes for cash donations and inappropriate items. They then filled boxes with other items if needed, taped the boxes shut and used the scanner to record the bar code to track where the box is being shipped to. Two students also worked on sorting and packing the boxes into the shipping cartons. The boxes that the students worked on are being sent to South Africa. The students worked hard and did a great job.

For being superheroes, the class then went to Arby's for lunch where they worked on their ordering and money skills.



- The production team of Sather, Stevens, Stiff and Knight (i.e. Brenda Sather and staff) guided the students in one of the TEA elementary classrooms in writing and producing the play "Tug of War". Besides writing and acting in the play, the students also made their masks and helped with the props and scenes. The students put in a lot of hard work and enjoyed the whole process.







WHEREAS, the special education cross-subsidy continues to be a major obstacle for Minnesota School Districts to grapple with, due to the growing number of students receiving special education, more specialized services and rising costs associated with those services and inadequate funding; and

WHEREAS, the state special education funding system has not kept pace with the rising cost of mandated services and supports for students with special needs; and,

WHEREAS, the cross-subsidy for school districts for FY2016 is \$679 million; a 5.6 percent increase from FY2015; and

WHEREAS, between rising need and insufficient state and federal aid, the amount of funding school districts as a whole in Minnesota will be forced to pay for special education costs will reach an average of \$815 per student in FY17;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the State of Minnesota calls upon the Congress of the United States to pass appropriate legislation in order to increase funding for federal special education mandates to meet the urgent financial special education needs of our cities and towns;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Senate cause a copy of this resolution to be

delivered to all United States Representatives and Senators representing Minnesota in the Congress of the United States.
