- School board meetings are scheduled to conduct the business of the school district and are open for public viewing in accordance with MN Statute 13D.01, and are not open for public participation. The Frazee-Vergas School District understands and values public interest and has established a procedure for citizen and delegation requests. After the process has been appropriately followed, the citizen/delegation may have the opportunity to address the board. Please review the following Frazee-Vergas School District policies:
 1. Policy 203.5 School Board Meeting Agenda
 2. Policy 206 Public Participation in School Board Meetings/Complaints at School Board Meets and Data Privacy Considerations
- Placement of the “Citizen and Delegation Request” on the Agenda shall be immediately following completion of New Business.
- The following procedures shall be completed prior to being placed on the agenda under “Citizen and Delegation Requests”:
 1. The chain of authority has been properly followed in addressing the concern/issue and the appropriate authorities have had adequate time to respond.
 - **Example: Teacher → Principal → Superintendent → School Board**
 2. After following the chain of authority in addressing a concern/issue and a citizen is not satisfied with the decision of staff and/or administration, the citizen/delegation shall: 1) submit the Citizen and Delegation Request form to the superintendent of schools one (1) week in advance of the regularly scheduled school board meeting; 2) the Citizen and Delegation Request form shall document the concern/issue and identify the individuals involved in addressing the concern/issue.
 3. Upon meeting the appropriate procedure, a citizen/delegation may be given three (3) minutes to address the board at the next regularly scheduled board meeting.
 4. If two or more people are present to address the School Board with regard to the same topic, please select a spokesperson to address the School Board.
- The School Board will not act on a speaker’s topic at that meeting in order to allow the board time to research and consider the speaker’s topic.
- In accordance with MN Statute 13D.05 the following cannot be discussed in an open meeting:

The Agreement:

Ketter's Septic Service agrees to perform services for the School District at a rate of **\$75** per hour per piece of equipment, with the exception of the pay loader which will be compensated at a rate of **\$95** per hour.

This agreement does not establish a minimum or maximum number of hours for contracted services. Ketter's Septic Service will perform services as needed by the Board of Education.

Due to the nature of the operation of the School District, Ketter's Septic Service will make every effort to have snow removed in the designated/assigned areas before the opening of school (the purpose of this is to avoid disturbance to traffic and parking).

Ketter's Septic Service shall submit an invoice for payment to the District for services rendered. The invoice shall detail the equipment utilized, the rate for utilization of said equipment, and hours of service for said equipment. The invoice shall have a sum for all services provided. The School District will provide payment of contracted services via the regular monthly payment cycle in accordance and compliance with School District financial regulations.

This agreement may be terminated with a 30-day written notice by either party.

This agreement is effective for the school year of 2008-2009.

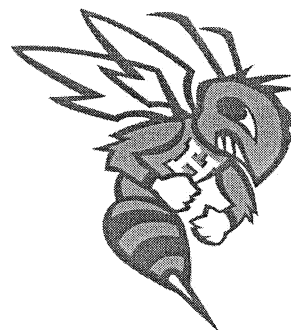



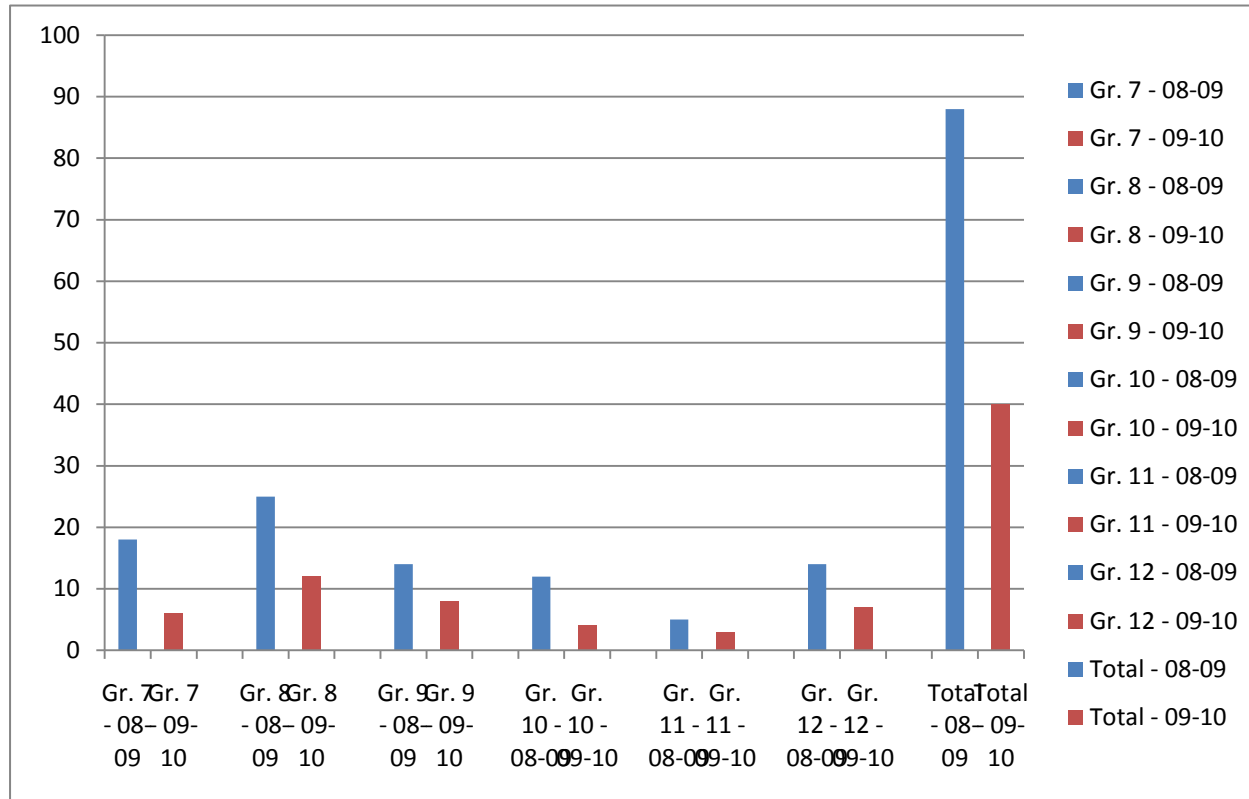

2.1 Enrollment on October 1st was 898 students (based on seat enrollment). This is two students less than enrollment on the first day of school and is one student less than the district's projected 2009-2010 K-12 enrollment of 899. Please keep in mind that it is early and this number is very soft and likely to fluctuate due to student transitions.

Frazee-Vergas School Board Procedures for Filling Vacated Seat

MN Statute requires that the School Board fill a vacated School Board seat in a reasonable period of time (MSBA considers 90 days to be reasonable). The following procedures shall be used to fill a vacated School Board seat:

1. The School Board shall fill a vacancy by appointment at a regular or special School Board meeting. Pursuant to M.S. 123B.09, if the vacancy occurs before the first day to file affidavits of candidacy for the next school district general election and more than two years remain in the unexpired term, a special election shall be held in conjunction with the school district general election. The appointed person shall serve until the qualification of the successor elected to fill the unexpired part of the term at that special election. If the vacancy occurs on or after the first day to file affidavits of candidacy for the school district general election, or when less than two years remain in the unexpired term, there shall be no special election to fill the vacancy and the appointed person shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term and until a successor is elected and qualifies at the school district election.
2. If less than 24 months of a term remains, then the School Board shall:
 - a. Contact former school board members to fill the vacated seat and remaining term.
 - i. Must be a resident of the Frazee-Vergas School District
3. If no eligible and previous School Board members accept the invitation to fill the vacated seat then the School Board shall open the position up through the application process:
 - a. Nominees must be at least 21 years of age, a resident of District 23 for at least 30 days, and an eligible voter.
 - b. The individual that receives the most votes shall be elected and sworn into office at the next School Board meeting and shall serve the remainder of the term.
 - c. Vacated school board seat shall be posted on the District Web site and the District Newspaper.
 - d. The application period shall be open for no less than 10 business days.
 - e. The School Board shall review applications.
 - f. The School Board shall rank and tabulate finalist(s) to be interviewed.
 - i. Applicants shall be ranked in order of preference with one indicating first choice, two indicating second choice, etc.
 - g. The School Board may conduct interviews of finalist(s) and make a recommendation for appointment.
 - i. Each board member shall cast one vote.
 1. Voting will be conducted by roll call.
 2. If there is a tie vote the School Board may discuss the candidates or ask more questions.
