Princeton 2020 School Board Positions

BOARD POSITIONS

The board needs to elect a Chairperson, Vice Chair, Clerk and Treasurer. Each of these positions is for one year. The duties are:

1. CHAIR-2020 Position held by _____

- a. The Chair when present shall preside at all meetings of the school board, countersign all orders upon the treasurer for claims allowed by the school board, represent the school district in all actions and perform all duties a chair usually performs.
- b. In case of absence, inability, or refusal of the clerk to draw orders for the payment of money authorized by a vote of the majority of the school board to be paid, the chair may draw the orders, or the office of the clerk may be declared vacant by the chair and treasurer and filled by appointment.

2. VICE CHAIR-2020 Position held by _____

The vice-chair shall perform the duties of the chair in the event of the chair's temporary absence.

3. CLERK-2020 Position held by _____;

Acting Clerk-Position held by _____ (the Acting Clerk serves as the replacement for the Clerk if the Clerk is unavailable)

- a. The Clerk shall keep a record of all meetings in the books provided.
- b. Within three days after an election, the clerk shall notify all persons elected of their election.
- c. The clerk shall sign all orders upon the treasurer for the payment of money for bills allowed by the school board or salaries of officers and for teacher's wages and all claims, to be countersigned by the chair.
- d. The clerk shall perform the duties of the chair in the event of the chair's and the vice-chair's temporary absences.

4. TREASURER-2020 Position held by _____

- a. The treasurer signs documents as needed.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COMBINED POLLING PLACES
FOR MULTIPLE PRECINCTS AND
DESIGNATING HOURS DURING WHICH THE POLLING
PLACES WILL REMAIN OPEN FOR VOTING
FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS NOT HELD
ON THE DAY OF A STATEWIDE ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No.477, State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the precincts and polling places for school district elections are those precincts or parts of precincts located within the boundaries of the school district which have been established by the cities or towns located in whole or in part within the school district. The board hereby confirms those precincts and polling places so established by those municipalities.
2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the board may establish a combined polling place for several precincts for school district elections not held on the day of a statewide election. **Each combined polling place must be a polling place that has been designated by a county or municipality.** The following combined polling places are established to serve the precincts specified for all school district special and general elections not held on the same day as a statewide election:

3. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.09, the polling places will remain open for voting for school district elections not held on the same day as a statewide election between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m.
4. The clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the county auditors of each of the counties in which the school district is located, in whole or in part, within thirty (30) days after its adoption.
5. As required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 204B.16, Subdivision 1a, the clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give written notice of new polling place locations to each affected household with at least one registered voter in the school district whose school district polling place location has been changed. The notice must be a nonforwardable notice mailed at least twenty-five (25) days before the date of the first election to which it will apply. A notice that is returned as undeliverable must be forwarded immediately to the appropriate county auditor, who shall change the registrant's status to "challenged" in the statewide registration system.
