Attached please find the results of an analysis of ISAT scores for District 103 and the ten other districts identified by the Citizens' Advisory Committee for Finance as comparable to our own district.

The first attachment, "Exhibit 1" includes the ISAT scores in reading, math, and science for District 103 for the past five years, from the 2006-07 school year through the 2011-12 school year. Scores provided reflect the percentage of students who scored in the "meets or exceeds" categories, and then the percentage of those who scored in the "exceeds" category.

The next attachment, "Exhibit 2" provides a comparison of 2012 ISAT scores for District 103 and ten other, comparable districts. You will see the percentage of students scoring in the "meets and exceeds" categories in reading, math and science, as well as the percentage of students scoring in the "exceeds" category for each district. You will also see how District 103 ranks, in comparison with the other districts, at each grade level. This information provides yet further proof that we provide our community with an excellent education for our students.

The next attachment, "Exhibit 3," provides a year-by-year comparison of all eleven districts of the percentage of students at each grade level scoring in the "exceeds" category. The attachment, "Exhibit 4", demonstrates how the percentage of students scoring in the "exceeds" category in each grade level has changed over the course of five years.

Finally, I have also provided a comparison between District 103 and ten other districts of various factors that may influence student success and performance.

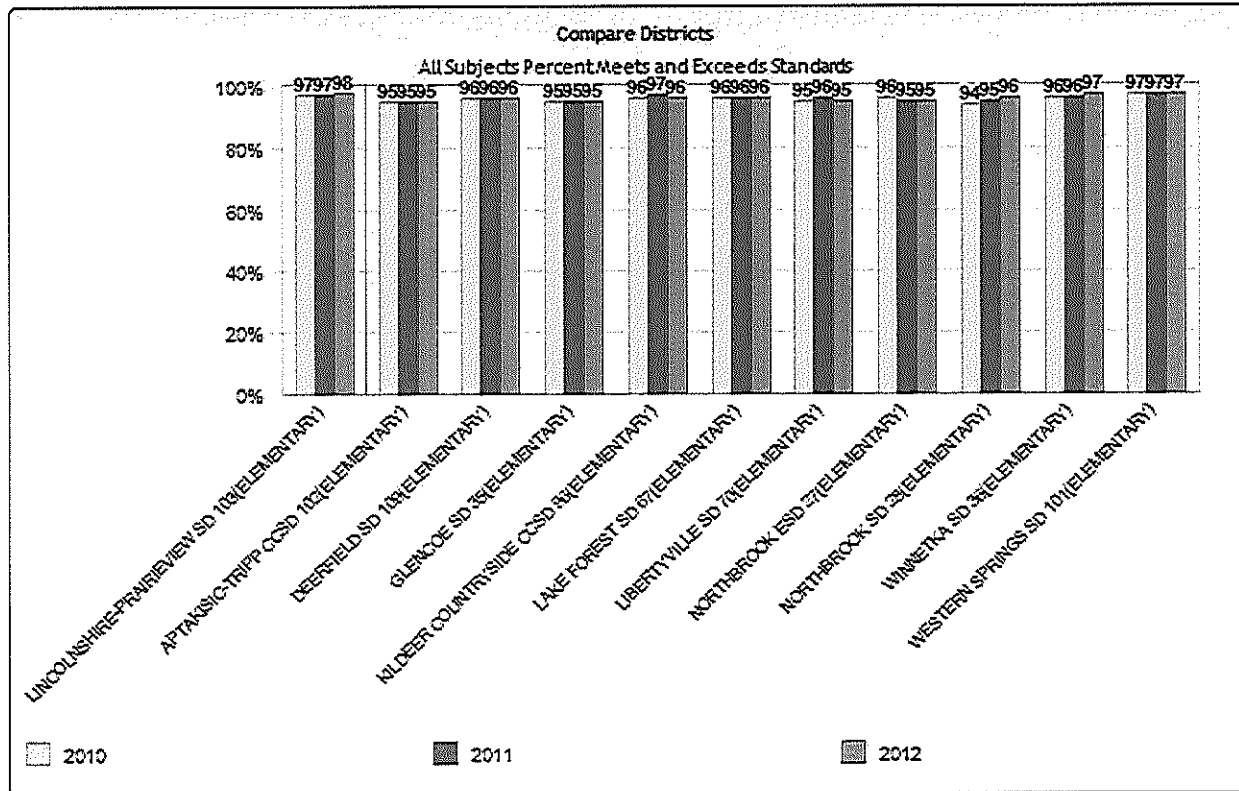

Attached please find the scores from the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) tests taken by students in September, 2012. The first page shows a comparison between how District 103 students performed on the test when compared to students nationally. As expected, District 103 students continue to perform above the national norms.

Individual progress reports were mailed home to parents in October, 2012. A sample of this report is included for your information. This report shows parents how a student is performing nationally, and also gives specific information with respect to goal areas in math and reading. One real benefit of the report is that it shows all of the students' scores from third grade through eighth grade. This makes it easy for both parents and teachers to measure growth through the years.

Finally, you will also see a report that shows student growth from Fall 2011 to Fall 2012 in both mathematics and reading. In every grade level, you will note that student scores have improved from between five to twelve points. The growth reports begin with third grade, since students first take the MAP tests in second grade. The yellow columns indicate the mean of growth that our students have shown from Fall 2011 to Fall 2012, while the red line shows the mean growth targets. The targeted growth is devised on a national level and is supplied by NWEA as a measure against which we can compare local growth. You will note that with the exception of sixth grade mathematics, the mean of growth in each grade level for both mathematics and reading exceeded the mean of growth targets. This report also provides the number of students at each grade level who met their growth target, as well as the percentage of students at that grade level who met their growth target.

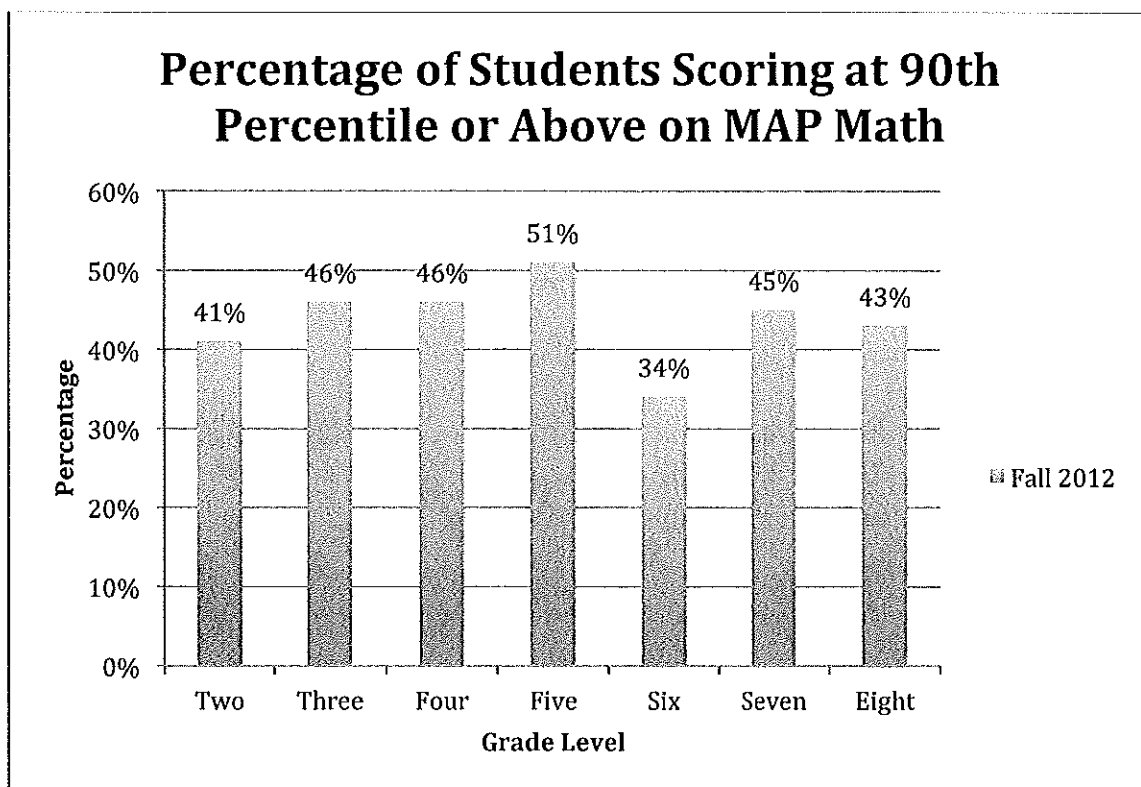
