1. Collaboration Strategies Informed by Winona Health

A couple weeks ago, I met with the leadership team at Winona Health to learn more about the operational strategies that have contributed to their success. Their insights continue to guide our planning, particularly around:

- Strengthening cross-agency communication
- Streamlining referral pathways
- Leveraging telehealth to expand access for rural students

These strategies are shaping our next steps as we build a sustainable SBHC model.

2. Ongoing Outreach to Indian Health Services (IHS)

I continue to seek appropriate representatives within Indian Health Services to support our integration efforts. At this time, I have outreach emails sent to several individuals who were referred to me through recent conversations.

This remains a significant barrier, and any additional guidance or contacts you may be able to provide would be extremely helpful. Establishing this partnership is essential to ensuring culturally responsive care for our Native American student population.

3. Telehealth Expansion with TYTO Care

Essentia Health has initiated a contract with TYTO Care to support enhanced telehealth capabilities. This includes tools that allow vitals and diagnostic-quality photos to be transmitted directly to the provider through MyChart.

Essentia's IT Department is currently in the testing phase. Once finalized, this will greatly improve the quality and efficiency of remote visits for students.

4. Multipurpose Facilities Grant – Status Update

At this time, I have not received any updates regarding the progress of our Multipurpose Facilities Grant plan but will continue monitoring for updates and will share information as this progresses.

5. Healthcare Exploration Pathway – Student Engagement and Certification Progress

The Healthcare Exploration Pathway class continues to be a strong point of student engagement and career readiness. Recent highlights include:

- Collaboration with School Nurse Nicole to support CPR certification for 10 students, currently in progress
- High engagement driven by guest speakers and hands-on activities
- Upcoming guest speaker specializing in forensic photography, which aligns with student interest in forensic nursing and healthcare imaging

These experiences are helping students build confidence, explore healthcare careers, and connect classroom learning with real-world practice.

- Monitor TYTO Care integration progress with Essentia Health
- Prepare for potential next steps pending the Multipurpose Grant decision
- Apply lessons learned from Winona Health to strengthen our operational model
