Recommended Student Outcomes

Goal #1: Reading on Grade Level

Baseline: 72% **Target:** 90%

Population: Early Childhood Students (Prek-2)

Timeline: 3 years

By end of school year 2023, students reading on grade level at the end of second grade will improve from 72% to 90%.

Goal #2: Student Achievement

Baseline: 49 (B) **Target:** 60 (A)

Population: All Students

Timeline: 3 years

By the end of school year 2023, Canutillo's Student Achievement goal will improve from 49 (81%) to 60 (90%) pts.

Goal #3: Closing the Gaps

Baseline: 91 (A) **Target:** 95 (A)

Population: Sub-populations

Timeline: 3 years

By the end of school year 2023, the district will improve Closing the Gaps score from 91 to 95.

Goal #4: Advanced Placement Exams

Baseline: 13% **Target:** 20%

Population: All Students

Timeline: 3 years

By the end of school year 2023, the district will improve students meeting the criterion score on an Advanced Placement exam in any subject from 13% to 20%.

Goal #5: Dual Course Credits

Baseline: 38% **Target:** 50%

Population: All Students

Timeline: 3 years

By the end of school year 2023, the district will improve students earning credit for at least 3 hours in English Language Arts or Mathematics or 9 hours in any subject from 38% to 50%.

Goal #6: Industry-Based Certifications

Baseline: 20% **Target:** 50%

Population: All Students

Timeline: 5 years

By the end of the school year 2023, the district will improve students who graduate with an industry-based certification from 20% to 50%.
