ORDER CALLING A BOND ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS §
COUNTY OF NUECES §
CALALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT §

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Calallen Independent School District (the "District") deems it advisable to call the bond election hereinafter ordered (the "Election"); and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Order was adopted was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of the meeting was given, all as required by the Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF CALALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

1. The Election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on November 6, 2007 in the District. The voters residing in the Nueces County Election Precincts shown in Exhibit A shall vote at the polling places shown in Exhibit A.

2. Early voting shall be conducted for all voters by personal appearance and mail at the designated early voting polling places and during the hours set forth in Exhibit A hereto. During the period early voting is required or permitted by law, being October 22, 2007 through November 2, 2007, the early voting clerks shall keep the early voting place open during such hours for early voting by personal appearance. District employees may serve as deputy early voting clerks, and the presiding judge of the early voting ballot board may appoint other deputy early voting clerks to assist in the conduct of early voting as necessary.

3. The appointment of the presiding election judges, alternate judges, early voting clerks, the Presiding Judge of the early ballot board and other election officials for the election shall be made by the Board in the manner prescribed by the Texas Election Code (the "Code"). Election clerks may be appointed by presiding judges for each election day polling place. An early voting ballot board shall be created to process early voting results from the election and the Board shall appoint the presiding judge of the early voting ballot board.

4. All resident, qualified electors of the District shall be entitled to vote at the election.

5. A substantial copy of this Order shall serve as proper Notice of the election, and the President of the Board of Trustees shall cause the Notice to be published one time, not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day prior to the date set for the election, in a newspaper published in the District or, if none is published in the District, in a newspaper of general circulation in the District. In addition, not later than the 21st day prior to the date set for the election, the President of the Board of Trustees shall cause the Notice to be posted on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the Board of Trustees.

6. At the election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Calallen Independent School District be authorized to issue the bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$43,665,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, equipping and renovating school facilities in the District, with the bonds to mature, bear interest, and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Calallen Independent School District be authorized to issue the bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$450,000, for the purpose of refunding all or a portion of the District's existing Tax and Revenue Notes, Series 2002, issued pursuant to Section 45.108, Texas Education Code, with said bonds to mature, bear interest, and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds?

7. The official ballots for the election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:

8. In all respects, the election shall be conducted in accordance with the Code. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act ("HAVA") and the Code, at each polling place there shall be at least one voting system that is equipped for disabled individuals, and each such voting system shall be a system that has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as compliant with HAVA and the Code.
