Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.

1. ADDENDUM TO AUGUST 16, 2012 REGULAR BOARD MEETING AGENDA DUE TO AN EMERGENCY/URGENT PUBLIC NECESSITY PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE 551.045
 - A. Revise/waive Board Policy FFAC (LOCAL) to the extent necessary to allow for the application of insect repellent to students without written permission from a medical professional under certain circumstances.
 1. Dallas County Health officials have declared a state of public health emergency due to the spread of the West Nile virus. Health officials recommend that individuals who engage in outdoor activities should use insect repellent containing DEET. Because our students will be engaged in outdoor activities, the Administration recommends that the Board waive or revise Board Policy FFAC (LOCAL) to permit our students to use insect repellent immediately.
