Contributions I feel I will make to the CISD Board: In 2009 I was hired as Corporation Counsel for Calhoun County and subsequently became Executive Director of Legal and Community Affairs for Oaklawn Hospital. For the past 12 years I have been involved in multiple aspects of education, economic development and healthcare in Calhoun County. In 2010 I was elected to the Marshall School Board and have been involved with many projects including the annexation of Albion Public Schools in 2016, serving on the Bond Steering Committee for the implementation of our 2010 bond, serving for several years on the CASBMA (and three times as Chair), and numerous other local and county-wide boards. I was appointed to the Michigan Indigent Defense Commission by Governor Snyder and worked closely with state level officials in negotiating the contracts associated with the creation of the Marshall Regional Law Enforcement Center and through annexation. **RESOLUTION OF THE UNION CITY COMMUNITY SCHOOLS  
BOARD OF EDUCATION**

WHEREAS, the biennial election of the Board of the Calhoun Intermediate School District will be held on Monday, June 7, 2021, at a meeting of representatives from constituent school boards.

WHEREAS, Section 614(2) of the Revised School Code requires a constituent school board to designate its representative and identify the intermediate school board candidate the board supports for each position to be filled on the board by a resolution adopted not earlier than 21 days prior to the date of the election, [*Note- May 17, 2021, is the earliest date that a constituent school board may designative its representative and identify the candidate that the board supports*] and

WHEREAS, Section 614(2) prescribes the method for passage of a resolution including the requirement of considering the resolution at not less than one public meeting before adopting the resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Board previously considered the resolution at an open meeting conducted in a manner prescribed under the Open Meetings Act on May 17, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board designates \_\_\_\_\_ as its representative to serve on the 2021 electoral body responsible for electing members to the Calhoun Intermediate School District Board of Education and \_\_\_\_\_ as alternate representative in the event the designated representative is unable to attend.
2. The Board supports candidate Richard C. Lindsey, Jr. for a position on the Calhoun Intermediate School District Board of Education for a term of six years.
3. The Board directs its representative \_\_\_\_\_ to vote for candidate Richard C. Lindsey, Jr. at least on the first ballot taken at the June 7, 2021 election.
4. The Board authorizes and directs its secretary to file this resolution with the secretary of the Calhoun Intermediate School Board.
