SECTION I: Requirements

If a school system believes it is best for the health and safety of students and staff to continue to restrict access to oncampus instruction beyond the first four weeks of their 2020-21 instructional calendar, they must submit a board approved waiver request to TEA to extend that transition window, up to four additional weeks. The board must take action to authorize this waiver by specific vote, and cannot otherwise delegate the waiver application to the superintendent. La Vega ISD continues to collaborate with the McLennan County Health District to identify the appropriate conditions for increasing the number of students attending in-person, while not compromising the ability to maintain social-distancing. The seven-day rolling positivity rate in McLennan County vacillates between 11%-19%. Currently, the District is able to accommodate most, if not all, families requesting in-person instruction and maintain the 6-feet social distancing. In order to keep students; staff of age most vulnerable to COVID-19; and students and staff with existing health conditions, the targeted positivity rate of 5% or lower is the goal.
