Dear Trustees.

Note - This document was co-created by President Dickinson and me, and we will be co-presenting this topic on Monday, July 13, 2020.

Given that we are in the final months of our current CPS Strategic Plan, this document outlines a proposal for the Board's consideration for renewing the plan. This potential process is intended to facilitate the outcome of updating the plan effectively setting the educational course and priorities of the district for the next five years. Appropriately, this proposal is inclusive and intentionally involves all of the key district stakeholders in multiple ways while prioritizing health and safety due to the coronavirus pandemic.

- Review areas of possible modification.
 - Focus Areas Add "Facilities" to Operations (Facilities and Operations)
 - Focus Areas Add "Budget and Finance" as new Focus Area
 - Edit the current Goal Statements to make them broader and more succinct.
 - o Convert the First-Year Objectives within the Strategic Focus Areas to **Priority Objectives**.
 - Word the Priority Objectives so that efforts to achieve them last the five years of the plan.
- Board members discuss these issues and may make recommendations or proposals if they wish or time permitting.

Monday, July 20 (Special Board meeting)

- Stakeholder virtual input via "Call to the Audience."
- Board members discuss the wording in detail; propose, discuss, and draft any changes to the Strategic Plan they feel will strengthen or improve the document.

Monday, July 27 (Full Board)

- Stakeholder virtual input via "Call to the Audience."
- Board members review and finalize any proposed revisions to the Strategic Plan.
- The Board puts out a 10-day call for public and stakeholder input regarding the proposed Board revisions (Tuesday, July 28-Thursday, August 6).
 - Call for input announced via Shoutpoint, email, social media, and the website;
 interested parties directed to contact the Superintendent
 - Superintendent collects and collates the public response, and prepares a presentation to the Board (Friday, August 7-Monday, August 10)

Monday August 10

- Stakeholder virtual input via "Call to the Audience."
- The Superintendent presents the public input to the Board.
- The Board reviews and considers the public input; the Board finalizes the Strategic Plan accordingly.
- The Board votes to ratify or support the 2020-25 CPS Strategic Plan.

This timeline allows the 2020-25 CPS Strategic Plan to be printed and ready for the "Back to School" Breakfast. In terms of timing, it makes the most sense to have the new Strategic Plan ready by this date so it can set the tone for the new school year.
